


State of Michigan Mental Health Facilities

Mental Health Facilities – Quick Facts



Caro Regional Mental Health Center

- First opened its doors in 1914.
- Average population of 145 patients.
- Authorized 542.3 Full-Time Equivalent (FTEs) positions; actual FTEs 394.3.



Hawthorn Center

- First opened its doors in 1956.
- Average population of 55 patients.
- Authorized 292.0 FTEs positions; actual FTEs 231.3.



Walter P. Reuther Psychiatric Hospital

- First opened its doors in 1979.
- Average population of 160 patients.
- Authorized 417.4 FTEs positions; actual FTEs 393.8.



Center for Forensic Psychiatry

- First opened its doors in 2005.
- Average population of 240 patients.
- Authorized 627.1 FTEs positions; actual FTEs 566.0.



Kalamazoo Psychiatric Hospital

- First opened its doors in 1859.
- Average population of 170 patients.
- Authorized 564.8 FTEs positions; actual FTEs 418.7.
