


# Michigan Agriculture Total Cash Receipts\*

\*Note: Cash receipts for agricultural commodities are defined as the gross income from sales of crops, livestock, and livestock products during a calendar year. The USDA, Economic Research Service (ERS) uses USDA, National Agricultural Statistics Service (NASS) estimates to develop state level cash receipts. Floriculture includes fresh cut flowers, potted flowering plants, foliage plants, annual bedding and garden plants, potted herbaceous perennials, cut cultivated florist greens, and seeds. Miscellaneous includes field crops, fruits, vegetables, and specialty crops not listed separately.
