


# Michigan Foster Care and Juvenile Justice Child Caring Institutions (CCI)

<sup>1</sup>Mental health behavioral health stabilization: Provides intensive and frequent services with corresponding interventions designed to stabilize and treat the conditions of mental health/behavioral instability.  
<sup>2</sup>Other specialized treatment: Includes substance use treatment and rehabilitation services, youth with sexually problematic behavior services, and crisis stabilization.  
<sup>3</sup>Mother/baby: A therapeutic 24-hour-a-day structured program with an intensive array of services to meet the short-term and longer-term needs of pregnant and parenting youth in the Michigan child welfare system.  
<sup>4</sup>Developmental disability/cognitively impaired: individualized services for individuals with mild to moderate IQs (45 to 69), and intellectually impaired youth, with or without substance use or dependence symptoms. Includes an impairment of general intellectual functioning or adaptive behavior, cerebral palsy, epilepsy, or autism or a condition of a person found to be closely related to significant cognitive impairment.
