


# Trend in Michigan Statewide Juvenile Arrests

Data from calendar year 2017, 2019, and 2021



Note: In 2019, the "Raise the Age" bill package was passed, raising the maximum age limit on juvenile status from up to 17 years to up to 18 years. As such, the data from 2017 was modified to include 17-year-olds. "Other crimes" includes all other crimes not defined as violent or property crimes by the Federal Bureau of Investigation's (FBI) index crime reports. As of the most recent report, the FBI does not include arson in the definition of property crime.
