



Michigan Total Agriculture Production by Commodity Group

Calendar year 2021, size of rectangle is in proportion to total **\$9.6 billion** production value


Michigan agriculture production value where Michigan was the top producing state in 2021 are noted in **blue**.

Asparagus:	42.4%, 28.9 million pounds
Cucumbers:	31.7%, 551.1 million pounds
Squash:	23.4%, 181.4 million pounds
Begonias:	19.6%, 5.8 million baskets, pots, and flats
Petunias:	17.8%, 8.8 million baskets, pots, and flats
Hardy Chrysanthemums:	16.5%, 10.3 million pots
Impatiens:	16.2%, 3.2 million baskets, pots, and flats
Geraniums:	12.7%, 4.5 million baskets, pots, and flats
Marigolds:	12.1%, 2.1 million baskets, pots, and flats
Cranberry beans:	11.8%, 3.4 million pounds
