AG General Overview

- **Major Functions/Programs:**

- The Attorney General is the legal counsel for State departments, agencies, boards, commissions, and the Legislature. Opinions of the Attorney General are binding on State government until overturned by court decisions. The Attorney General defends the State in court and also brings actions and intervenes in cases on the State's behalf. The Attorney General also has supervisory powers over local prosecuting attorneys.

- **Criminal Justice Bureau**

- **Divisions:** Criminal Investigations, Criminal Trials and Appeals, Financial Crimes, & Health Care Fraud
- Prosecuting Attorneys Coordinating Council – Provides training and support to local prosecutors

- **Divisions:** Alcohol & Gambling Enforcement, Children & Youth Services, Civil Rights & Elections, Corporate Oversight, Health, Education & Family Services, Labor, Licensing & Regulation, & Public Service

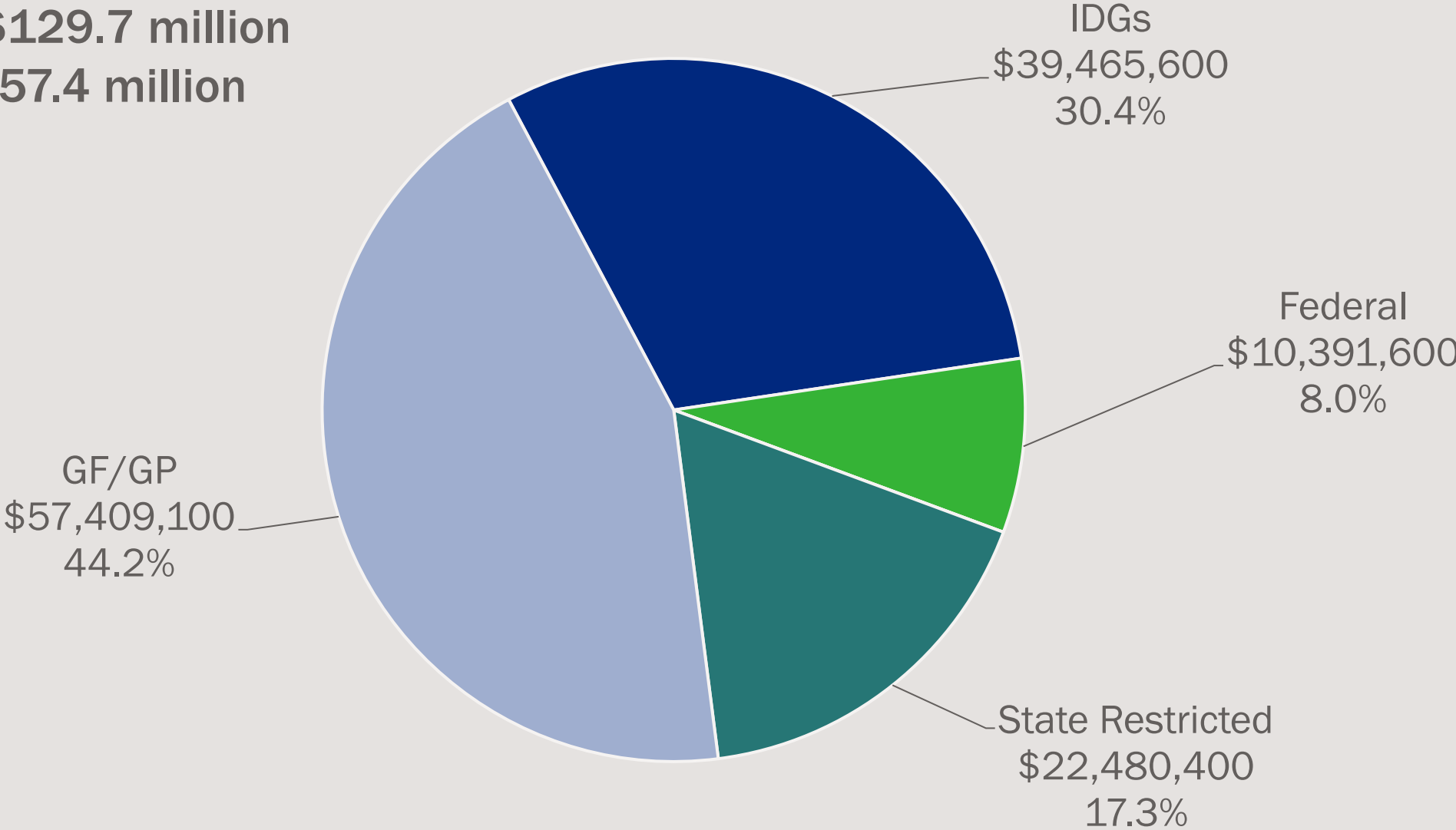

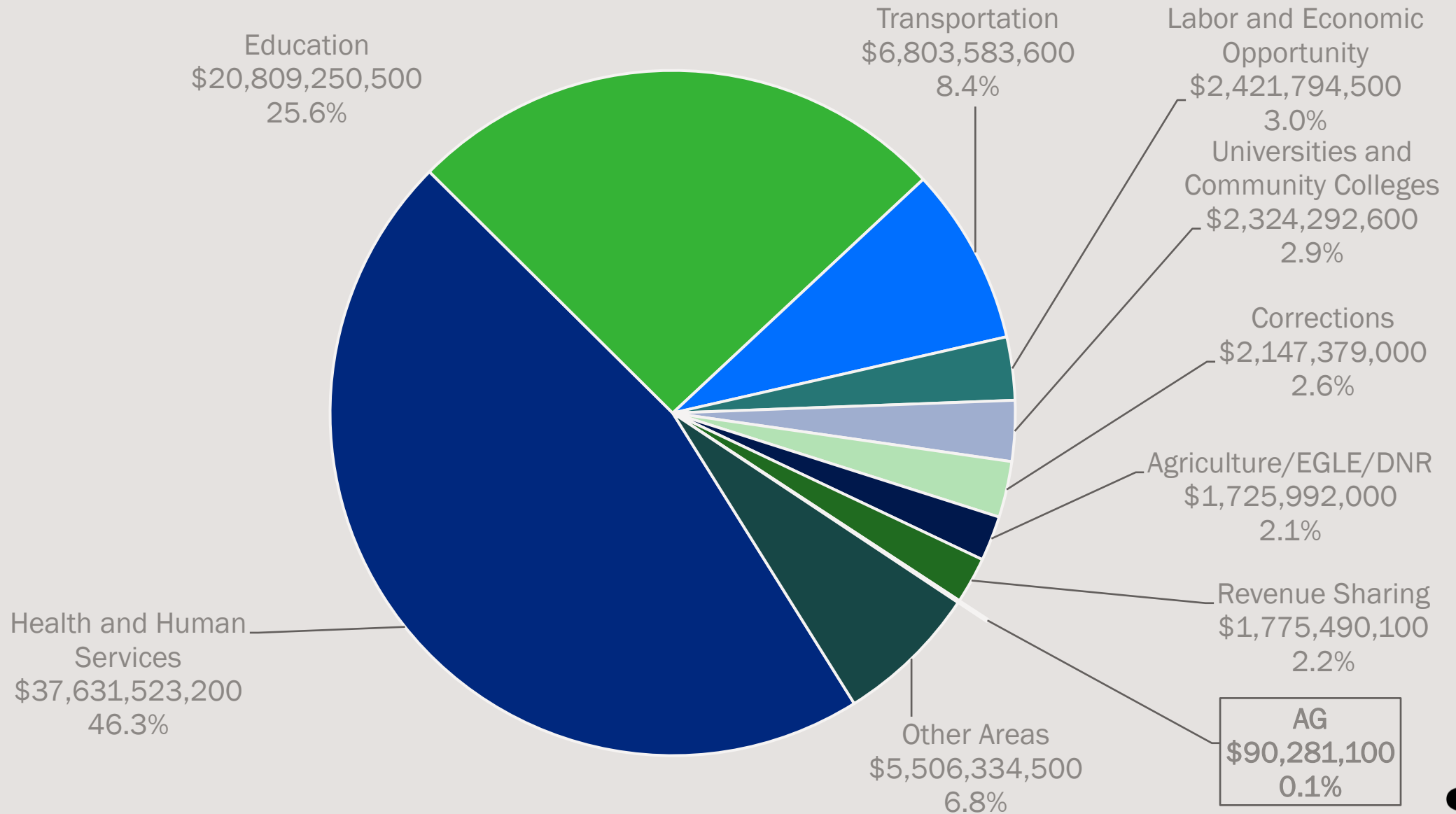

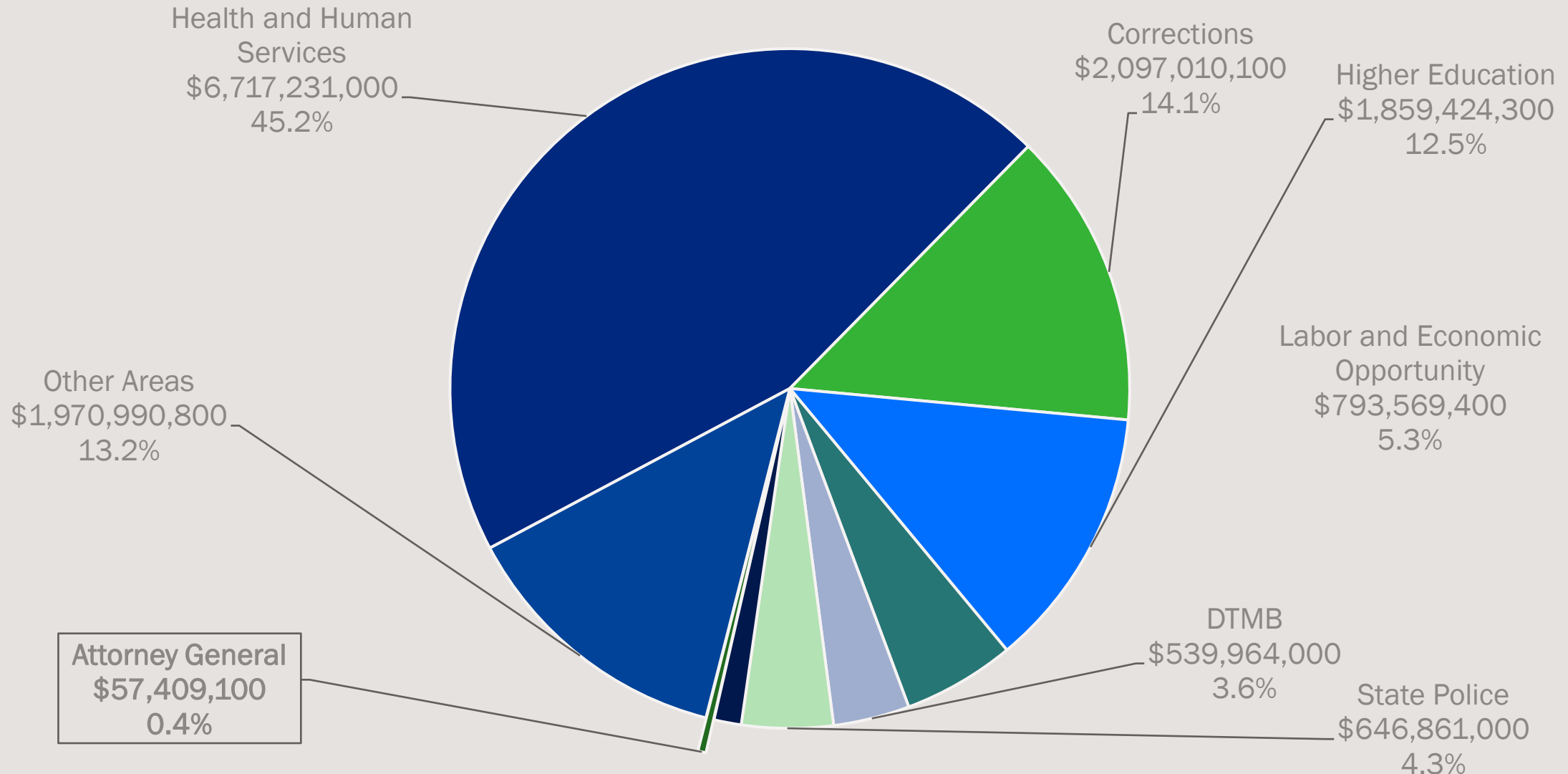


AG's Slice of the Adjusted Gross Michigan Budget: Accounts for 0.1% of the \$81.2 Billion State Adjusted Gross Spending

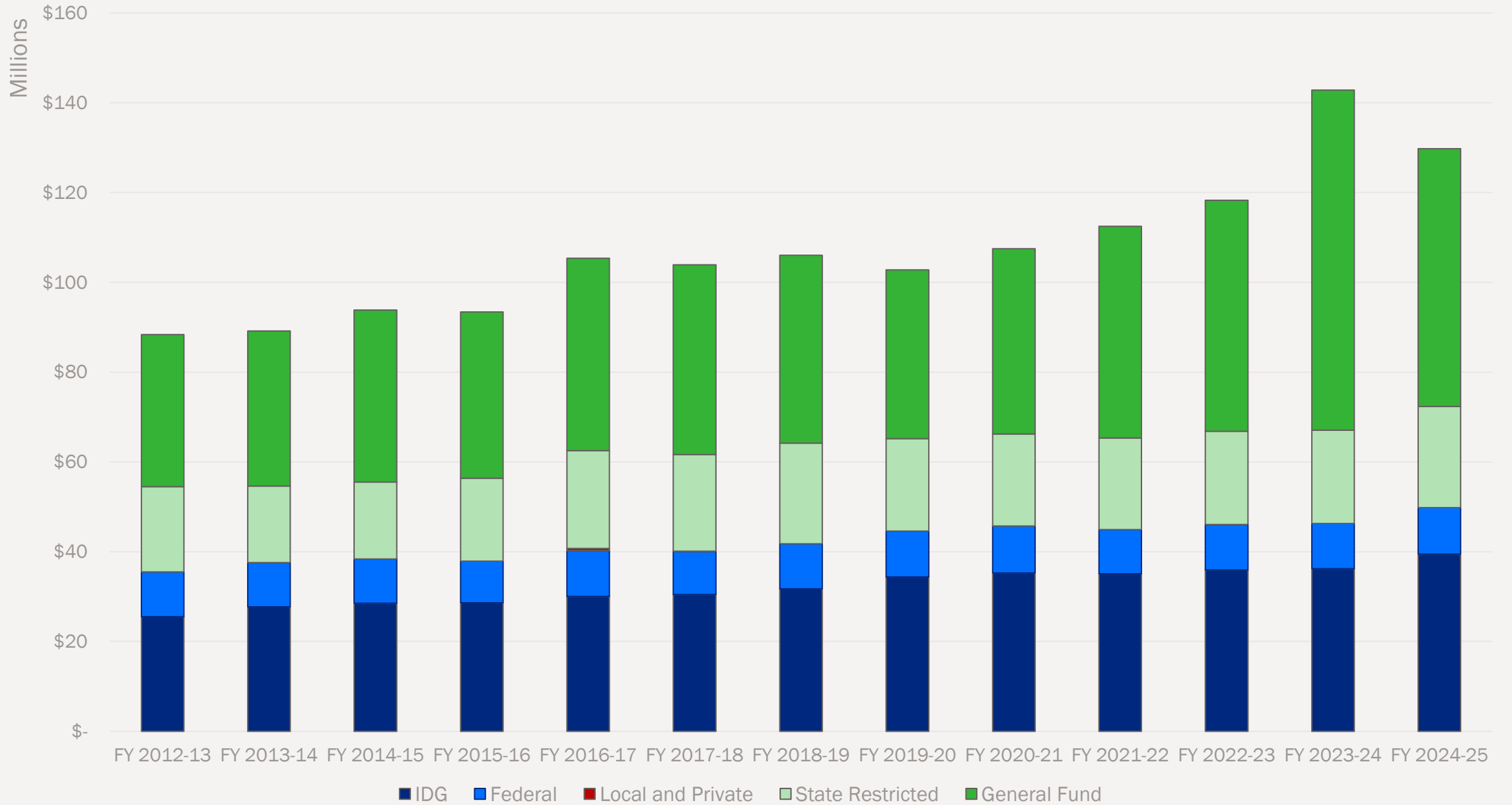


AG's Slice of Michigan GF/GP Budget:

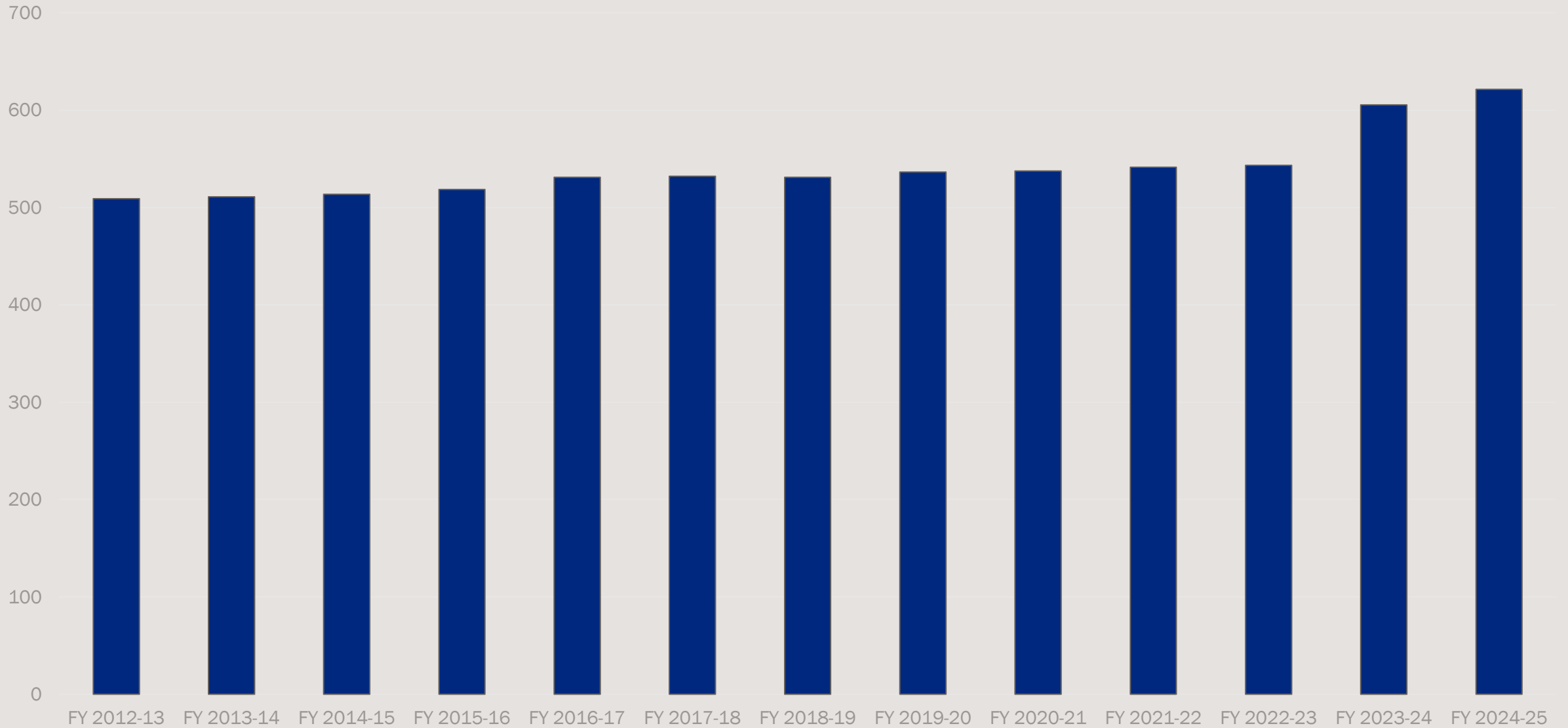
Accounts for 0.4% of the \$14.99 Billion GF/GP in the State budget
