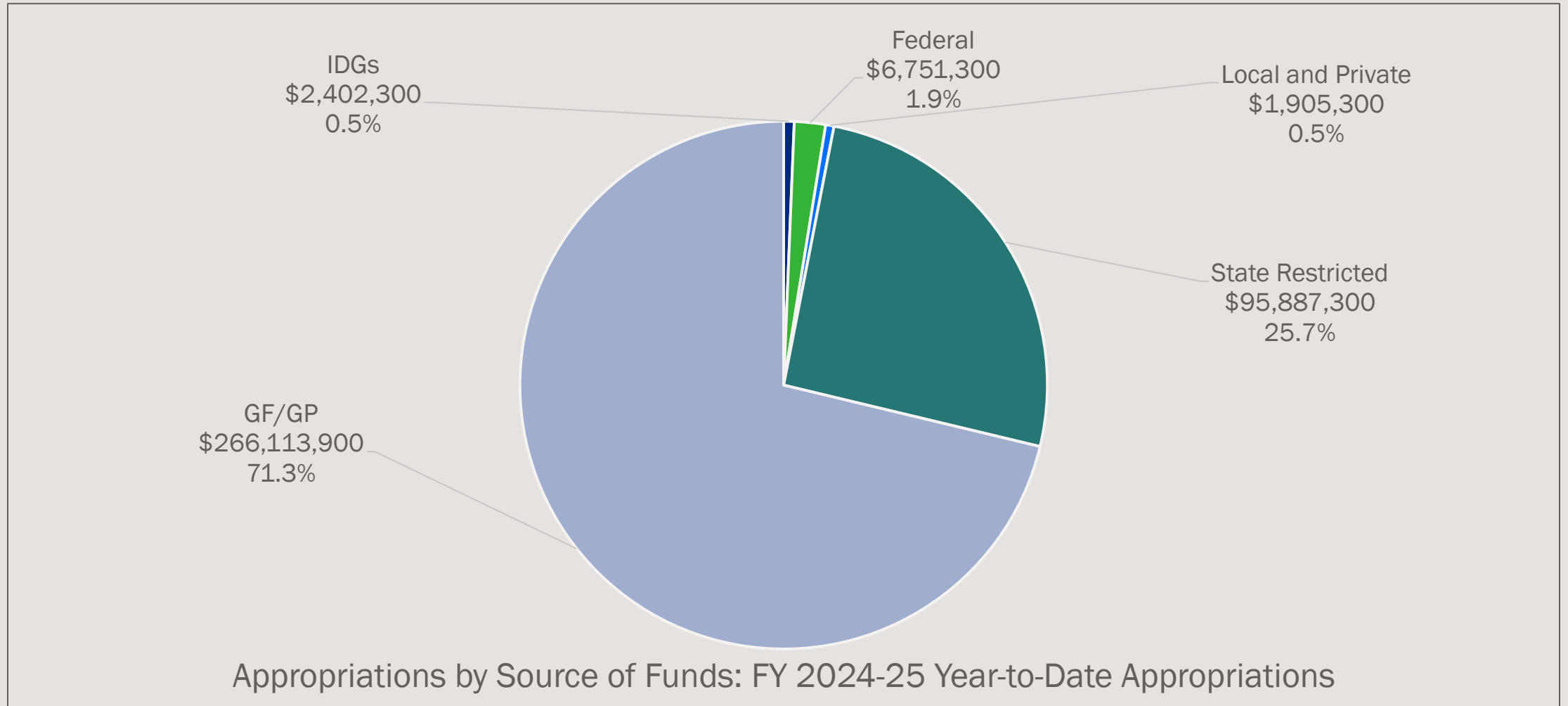

Judiciary General Overview

- Major Functions/Programs:
 - The Judiciary budget provides funding for three separate, independent entities:
 - State courts, including trial courts, the Court of Appeals, and the State Supreme Court. Funding for the courts includes all the administrative costs, FTE salaries, judicial salaries, IT costs, property management costs, and court equity payments.
 - The Judicial Tenure Commission, which independently reviews judicial conduct and makes disciplinary recommendations to the State Supreme Court,
 - The State Appellate Defender Office, which provides legal representation to the convicted.

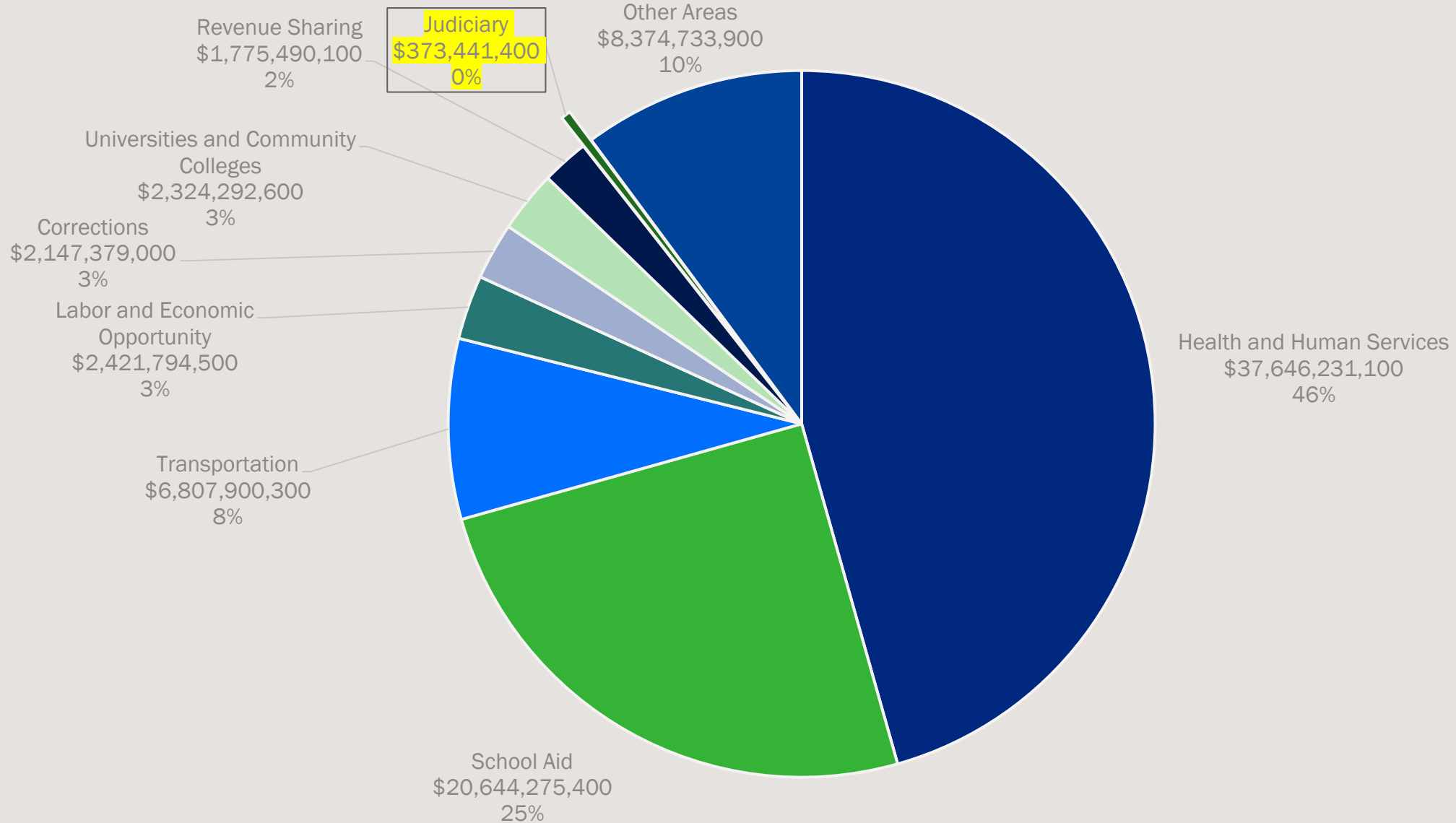

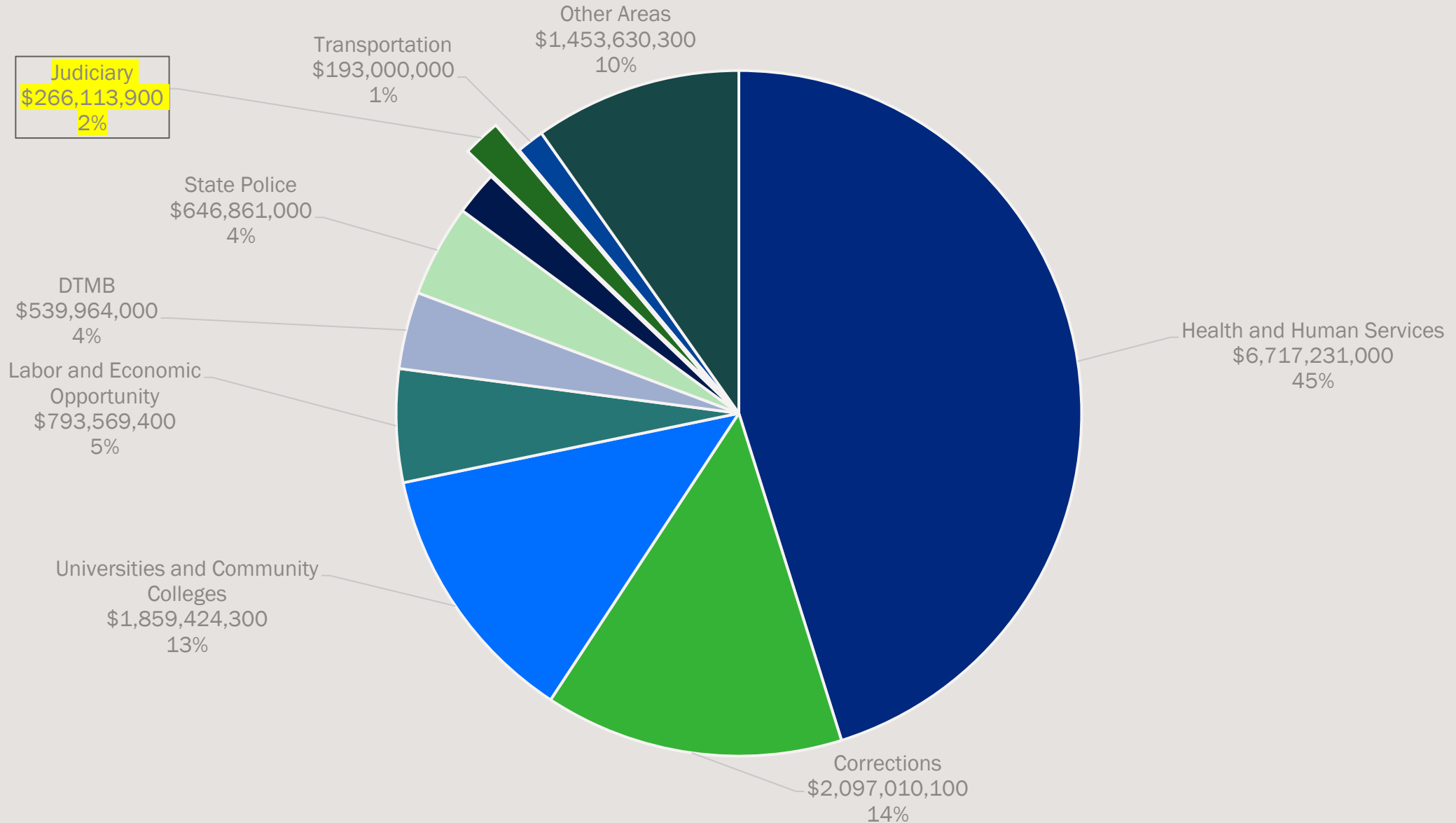
Year-to-Date as of 12/31/2024



Judiciary's Slice of the Michigan Budget: Accounts for 0.4% of the \$82.5 B State budget



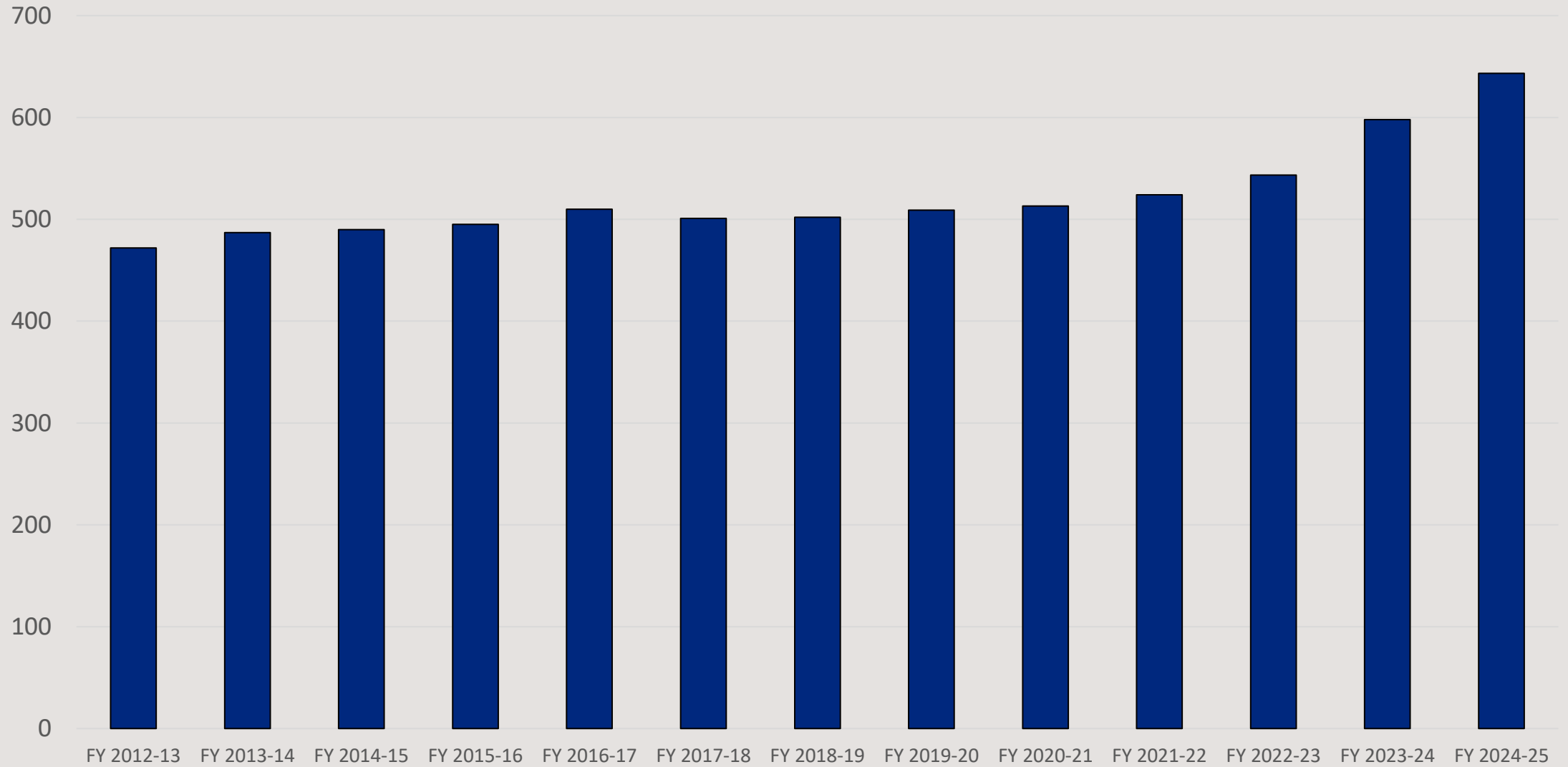
Judiciary's Slice of Michigan GF/GP Budget: Accounts for 1.6% of the \$15.2 B GF/GP in the State budget
