Legislature General Overview

- **Major Functions/Programs:**

- **Legislative Council.** The Legislative Council is a bipartisan entity that consists of six senators appointed by the Senate Majority Leader and six representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House. Through the Legislative Service Bureau, the Council provides for bill drafting, research, and other services for members of the Legislature. The Council also provides budget oversight functions for the Legislative Corrections Ombudsman, Michigan Commission on Uniform State Laws, Michigan Law Revision Commission, and Michigan Sentencing Commission.
- **Senate Operations.** This division provides funding for Senate members, their staffs, the Office of the Secretary of the Senate, and central staffs for the Democrats and Republicans.
- **House Operations.** This division provides funding for House members, their staffs, the House Clerk's Office, the House Business Office, the Legislative Analysis Section, and central staffs for the Republicans and Democrats.

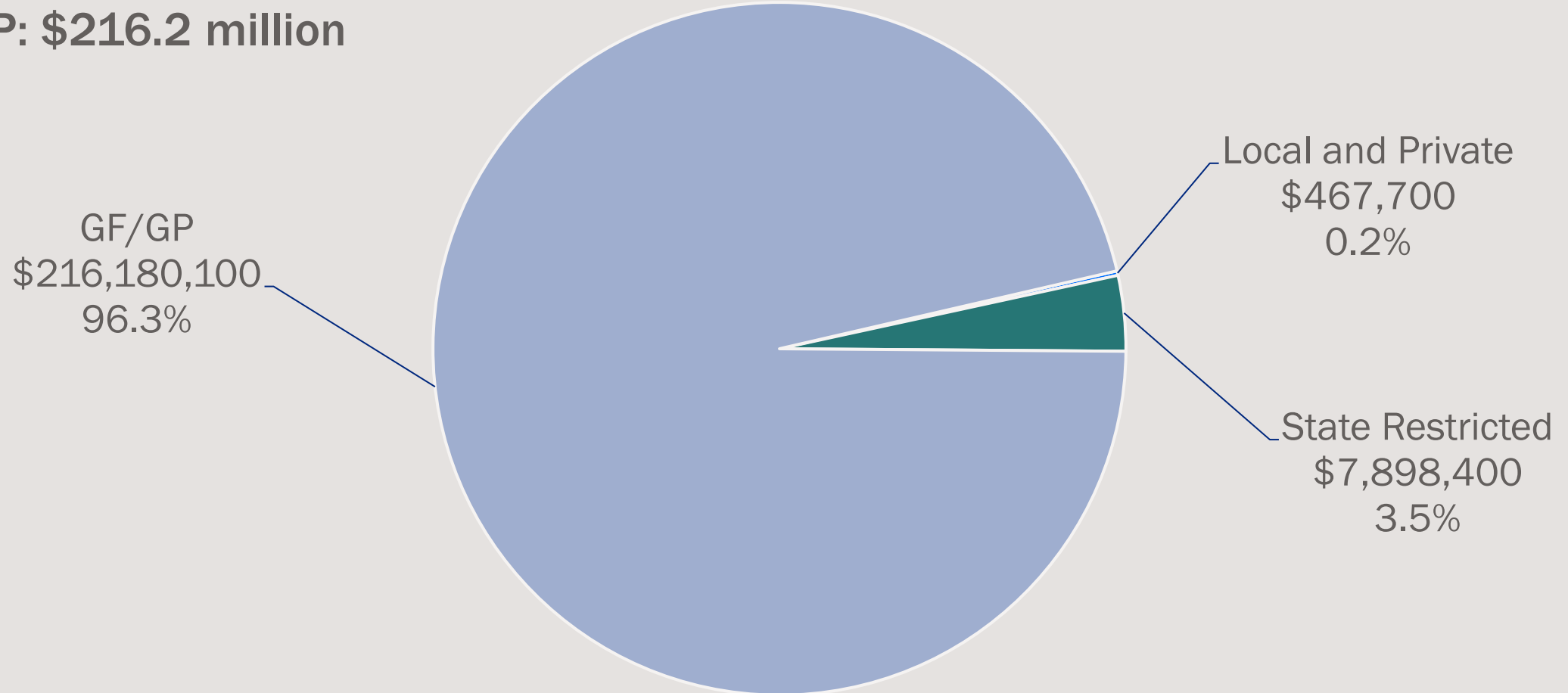
Legislature General Overview

- **Major Functions/Programs - continued:**
 - **Senate Fiscal Agency.** This nonpartisan agency provides technical assistance to the Senate Appropriations Committee and other members of the Senate. The Senate Fiscal Agency also includes a Legislative Analysis Unit that provides bill analyses for all legislation before the Senate. The Agency is governed by a five-member board consisting of the Chairperson of the Appropriations Committee, the Senate Majority and Minority Leaders, and two members of the Appropriations Committee appointed by the Chairperson of the Appropriations Committee.
 - **House Fiscal Agency.** This nonpartisan agency provides technical assistance to the House Appropriations Committee and other members of the House. The Agency is governed by a six-member governing committee consisting of the Speaker of the House, the Minority Leader, the Chairperson of the Appropriations Committee, the Minority Vice-Chairperson of the Appropriations Committee, the Majority Floor Leader and the Minority Floor Leader.
 - **Property Management.** This division includes funding for the operation and maintenance of the State Capitol, the Binsfeld Senate Building, and the House Office Building.

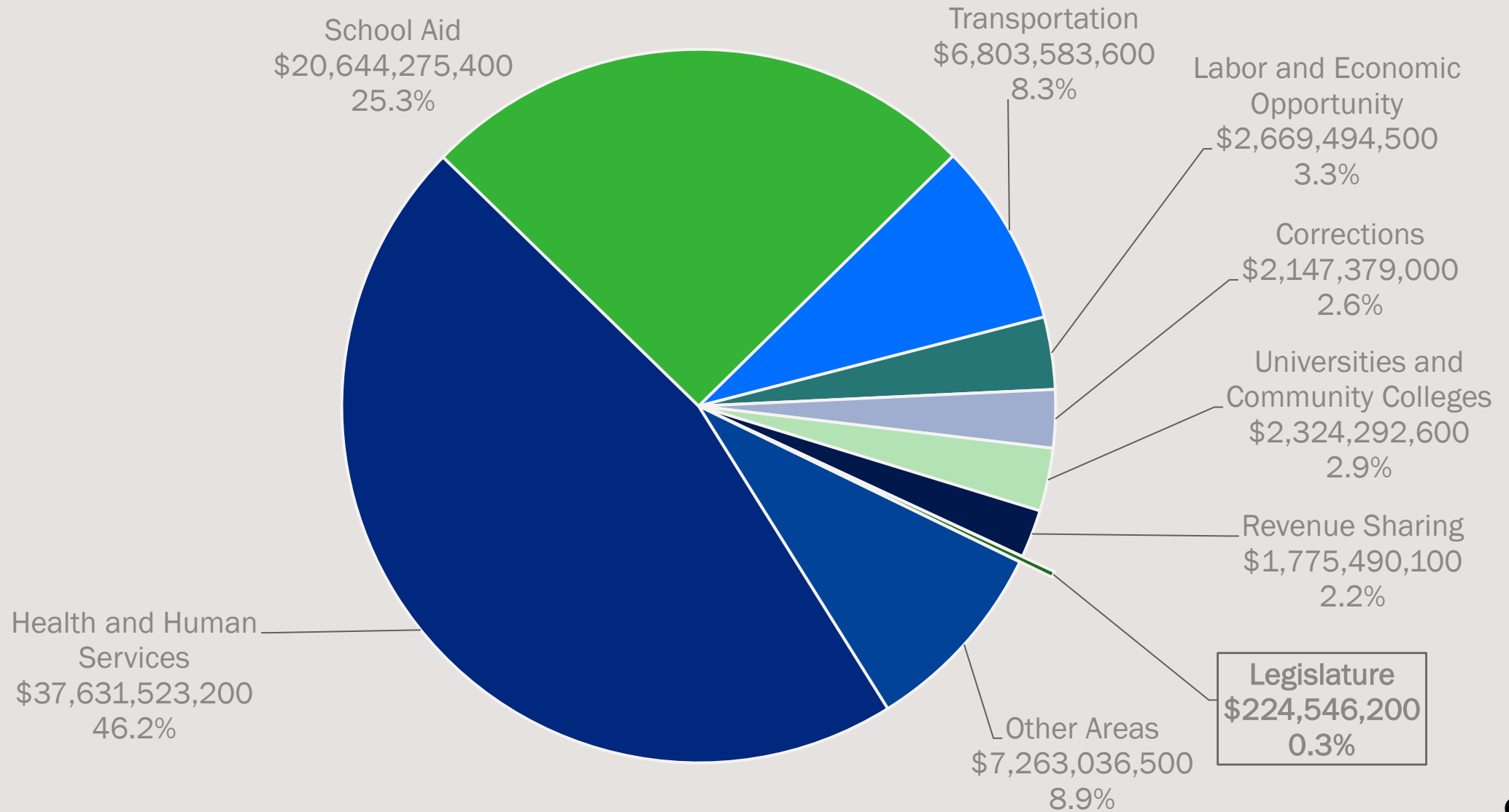

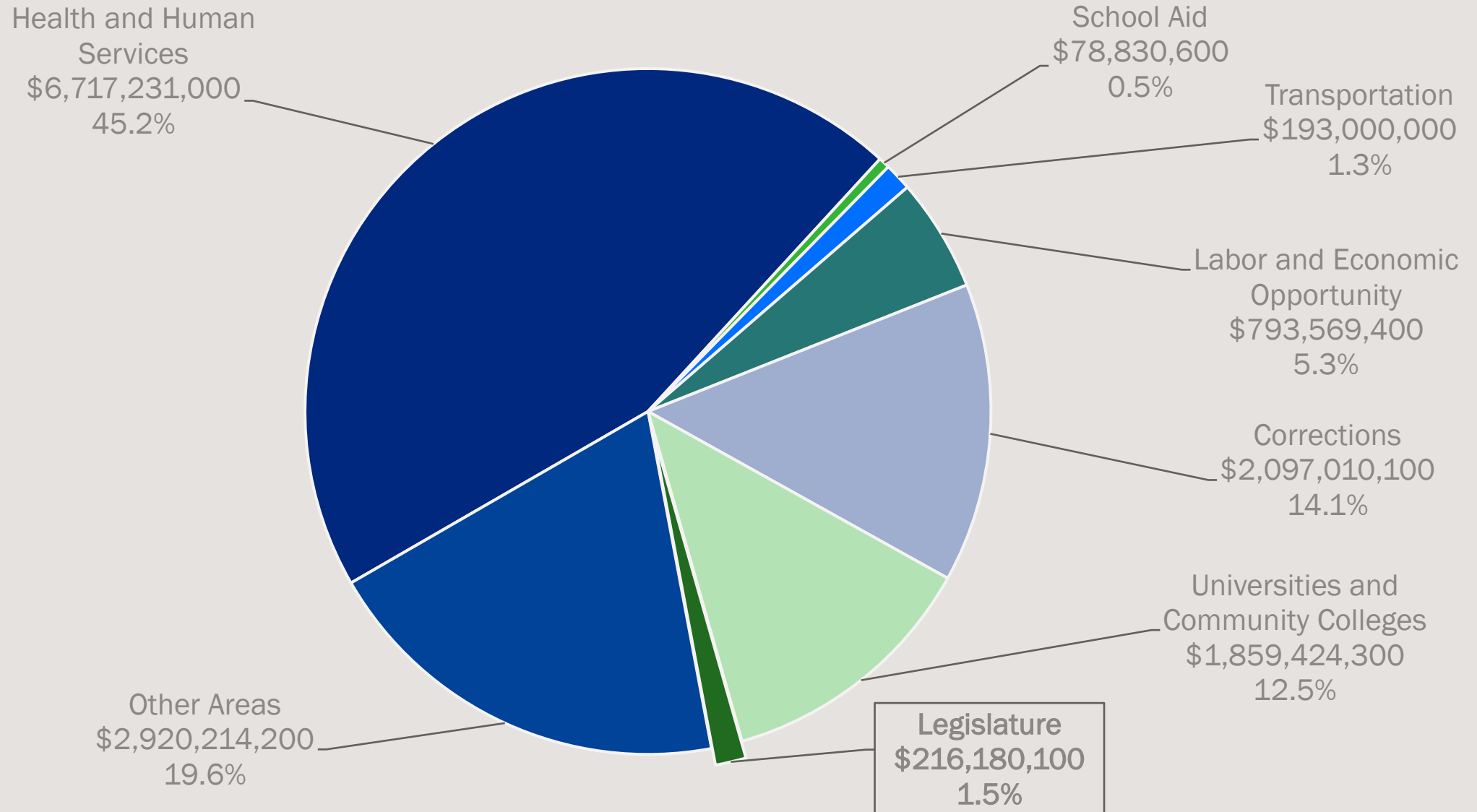


Legislature's Slice of Michigan Adjusted Gross Budget: Accounts for 0.3% of the \$81.5 Billion State Budget

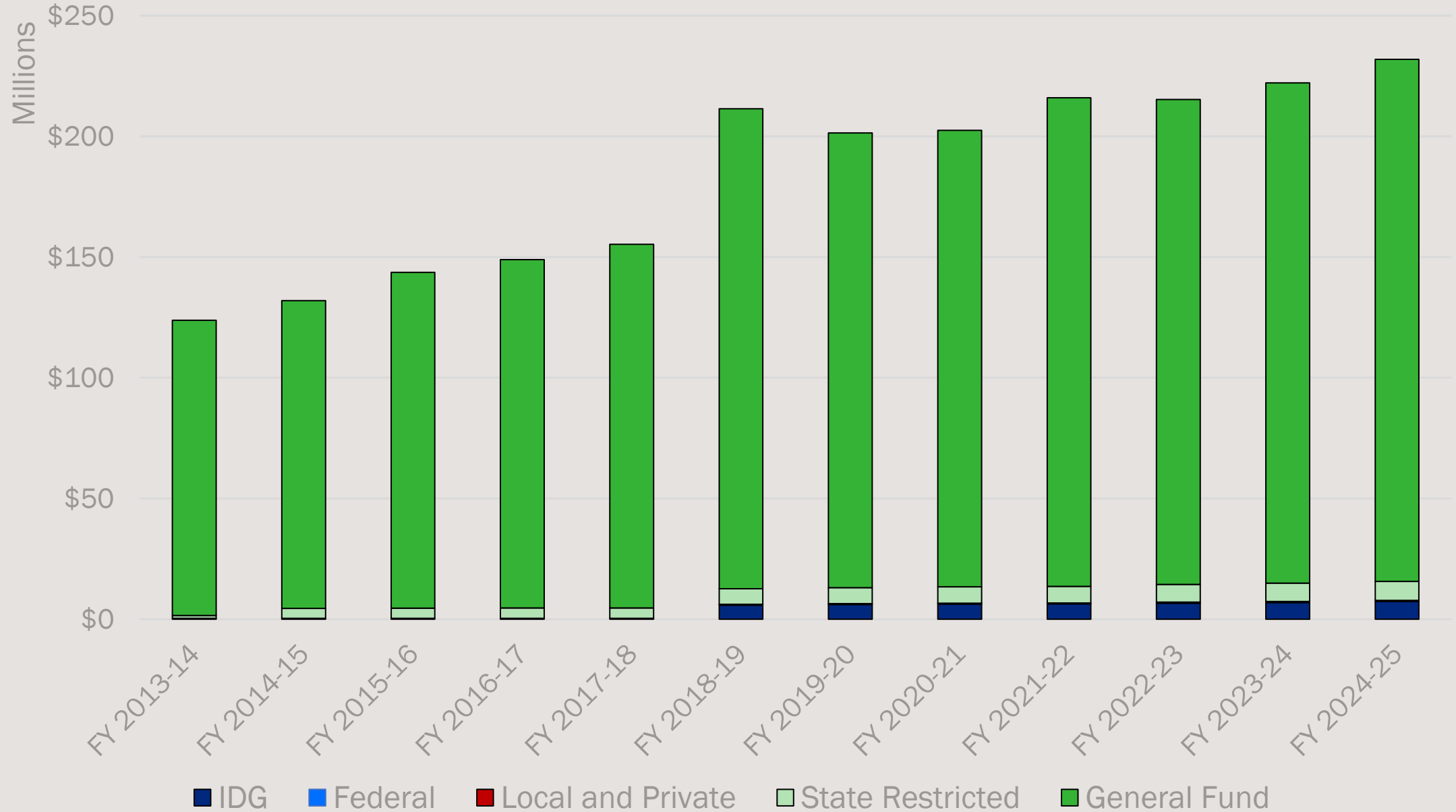


Legislature's Slice of Michigan GF/GP Budget:

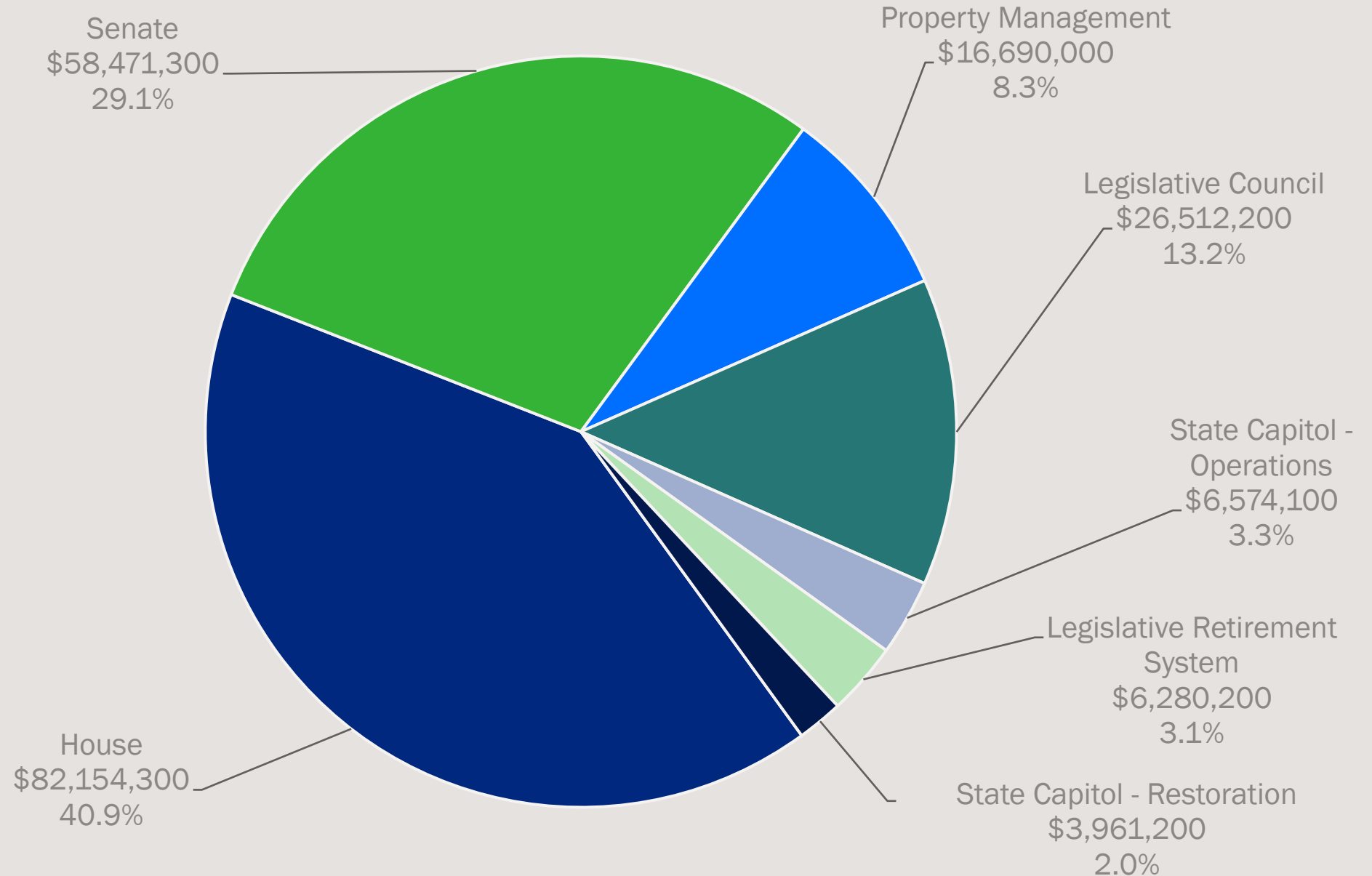
Accounts for 1.5% of the \$14.9 Billion State Budget
