Executive Summary

This publication compiles enrollment data reported by the 15 public universities in Michigan and organizes the information by residency and geographic origin. Statute requires that Michigan universities annually report specific financial and institutional data to the State, and the data are then catalogued in the Higher Education Institutional Data Inventory (HEIDI). All enrollment information contained in this report was pulled from HEIDI on August 20, 2013. Population numbers and statistics came from the 2010 U.S. Census.

This report provides a five-year overview of geographic and institutional enrollment patterns at Michigan public universities, beginning in 2008 and ending in 2012 (the most current year with accessible data). For additional historical information, please refer to previous *Study of Michigan Public University Enrollment Patterns: By County and Institution* publications that are available on the Senate Fiscal Agency (SFA) website.

All reported enrollment data reflect the unduplicated headcount numbers from the fall of the stated year. The numbers include those who may attend part-time, but they do not include distance learners (those taking only internet classes). Residency is determined on a tuition basis; thus, those who pay in-State tuition are termed Michigan residents, while those paying out-of-State tuition are not considered residents.

In order to provide a comprehensive and detailed picture of university enrollment, the report is divided into four sections. The first section provides an overview of Michigan population statistics and general enrollment data, presenting the information by county. The section also highlights statewide patterns and suggests how Michigan's changing population has affected enrollment. Section 2 narrows the focus and presents in more detail enrollment patterns in each of Michigan's 83 counties. Section 3 reports enrollment patterns for each of Michigan's 15 public universities, and identifies both overarching trends and university-specific patterns. Finally, Section 4 identifies the top five foreign countries of origin for Michigan international students, and delineates trends in enrollment from each spotlighted nation.

All maps in this report are formatted in color; for optimal viewing, a full-color version of this report is available on the SFA website.

SECTION 1: Michigan Population and Enrollment Statistics

Summary

This section provides an overview of population changes both in the State of Michigan as a whole and in individual Michigan counties for the years 2008 through 2012. Also, this section compares population data to university enrollment data for fall 2012. The 2010 population data are from the 2010 Census. Other years reflect the July 1 population estimates available as of August 15, 2013. All enrollment data were obtained from the Higher Education Institutional Data Inventory (HEIDI) database on August 20, 2013.

The introductory section, Michigan Population and Enrollment at a Glance (Tables 1.1 through 1.4), distills the information presented later in Table 1.5 and Table 1.6 into an easily comparable compilation of fast facts. It also provides a summary report of Michigan's population and enrollment patterns for the last five years, and explains the correlations between the different reported statistics. Map 1.1 serves as a reference, identifying all of the 83 Michigan counties by name. Chart 1.1 shows the change in the total population of Michigan from 2008-2012.

Table 1.5 shows in detail the population of each county, comparing the 2008 data to the 2012 data and showing the rate of change. Map 1.2 illustrates the 2012 population breakdown by county. Each darkening color shade represents a greater overall county population.

Table 1.6 compares the population of each county to its university enrollment, ultimately ranking each county by the percent of county population enrolled. Map 1.3 illustrates the State 2012 enrollment patterns by county. Each darkening color shade represents a greater overall number of students enrolled in Michigan public universities from that county.

Table 1.7 ranks each county by the number of students graduating from public high schools. The number reported includes those students given either a diploma or a certificate of completion—it does not include individuals receiving General Education Development diplomas (GEDs). Also, the database calculates the number of students graduating per county, not by residency, but by the location of the operating district.

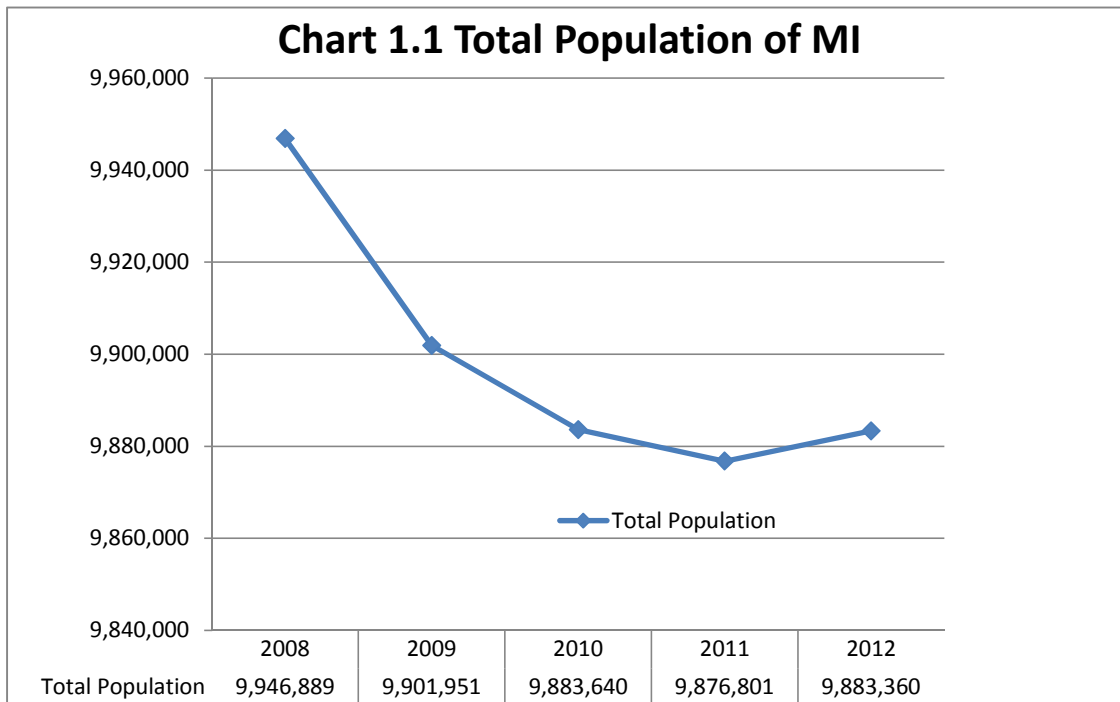

From 2008 to 2012, 63 Michigan counties experienced a negative rate of change, resulting in a statewide average rate of change of negative 0.64%. Ontonagon County reported the greatest percentage decrease (7.35%), while Keweenaw County reported the greatest percentage increase (4.53%). From 2011 to 2012, Michigan had its first year-to-year increase in population since 2003-2004. [Chart 1.1](#) shows the overall population of Michigan from 2008 to 2012, and plots the data over time. [Table 1.1](#) presents those counties with the greatest and least population and their respective rates of change from 2008.

Table 1.2 represents those counties with the greatest and least percentages of "college age" (18- to 24-year-old) individuals compared to their total county population. Table 1.3 reflects those counties with the highest and lowest raw headcount of students enrolled in Michigan universities. Table 1.4 divides the number of people enrolled in a county by the total county population, reporting the counties with the top and bottom percentages. One might expect that Table 1.2 and Table 1.4 would show greater correspondence, as counties with a greater proportion of college-age individuals would have a larger population pool likely to enroll in college. When the data for all the counties are compared, however, the standard deviation and confidence interval both indicate no correlation between the percentage of 18- to 24-year-olds in a county and that county's overall percentage of enrolled residents. The enrollment of older adults, out-of-state enrollment, and community college enrollment likely account for the deviation. A county's proximity to an institution of higher learning, however, did affect the enrollment percentage, as four of the top five counties for enrollment percentage all contain a State university within their borders.

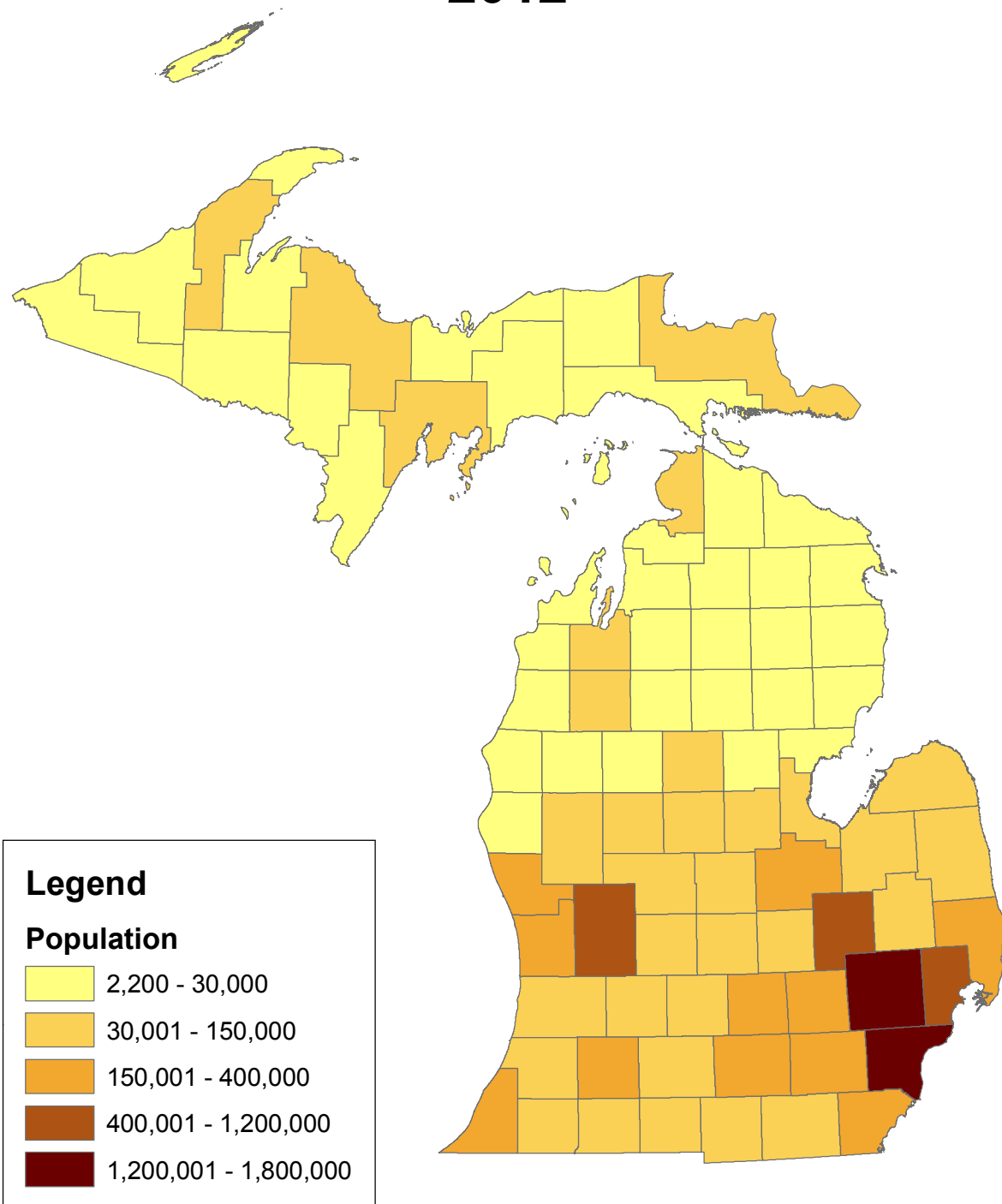

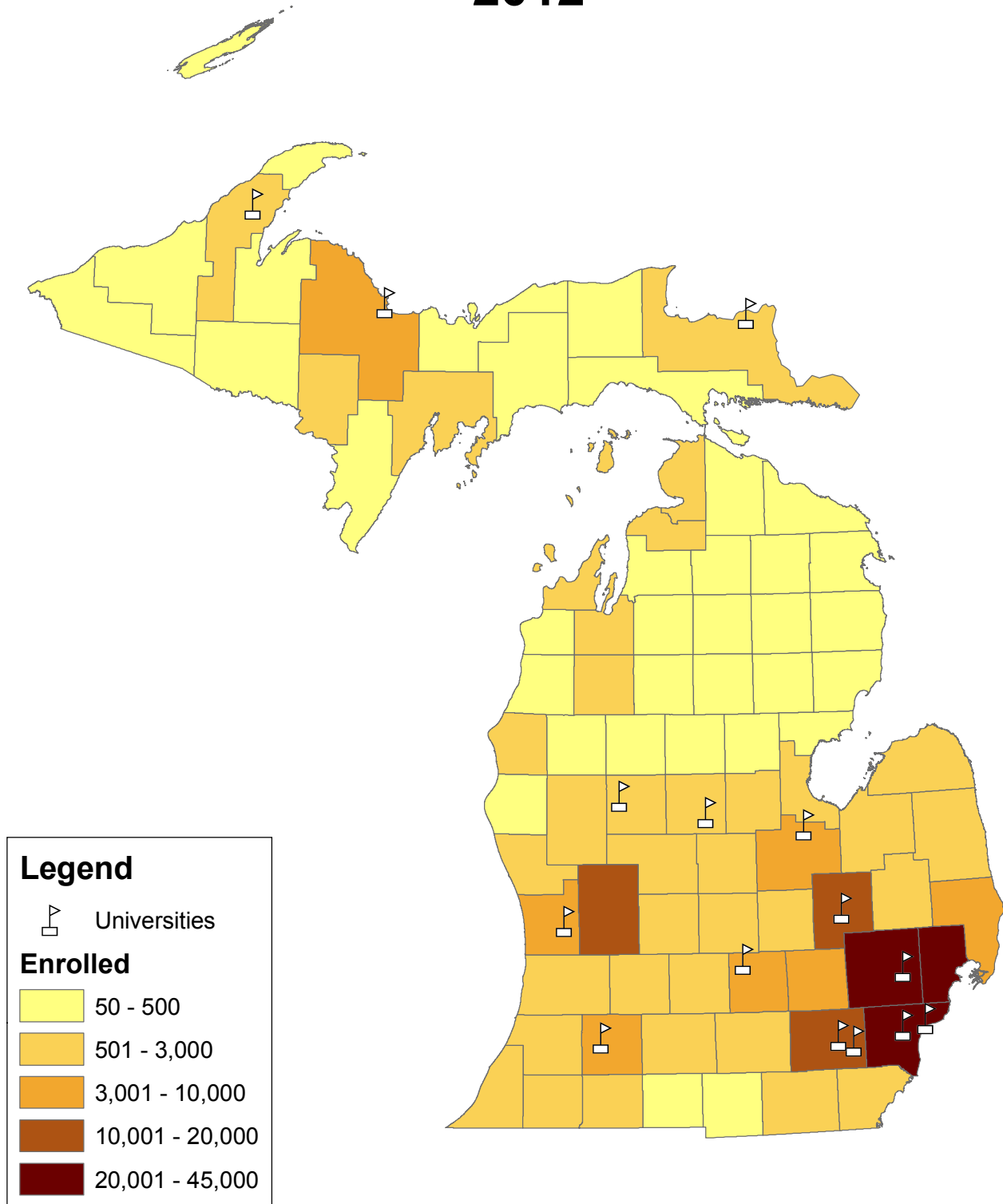

SECTION 2: County Reports

Summary

This section reports enrollment information at the county level in more detail than the tables in Section 1. Specifically, this section breaks down the enrollment of each county by institution, allowing one to see the public university that students from each county attend. The data in this section demonstrate that a majority of the students tend to enroll in universities located in or near their county of residence. For example, Marquette County students overwhelmingly enroll in Northern Michigan University, whereas students from Kalamazoo County largely attend Western Michigan University.

Each individual county report contains the tables and chart described below.

Table A shows the county population for the past five years (2008 to 2012), the percentage of Michigan population each county represents, and the percentage of the county population that enrolled in a State university for those years. This number is generated by using the total headcount reported in Table B. This information puts the enrollment headcount from each county into perspective by reporting enrollment in proportion to the overall county population.

Table B breaks down the total enrollment figures for each county by specific public institution, thereby demonstrating enrollment patterns in each Michigan county. Since the table reports figures from 2008 to 2012, it shows changes in the enrollment patterns over the last five years.

Chart A takes the data from 2012 reported in Table B and presents it in pie chart format, allowing for easy comparison with other counties of interest. The charts abbreviate the universities as follows:

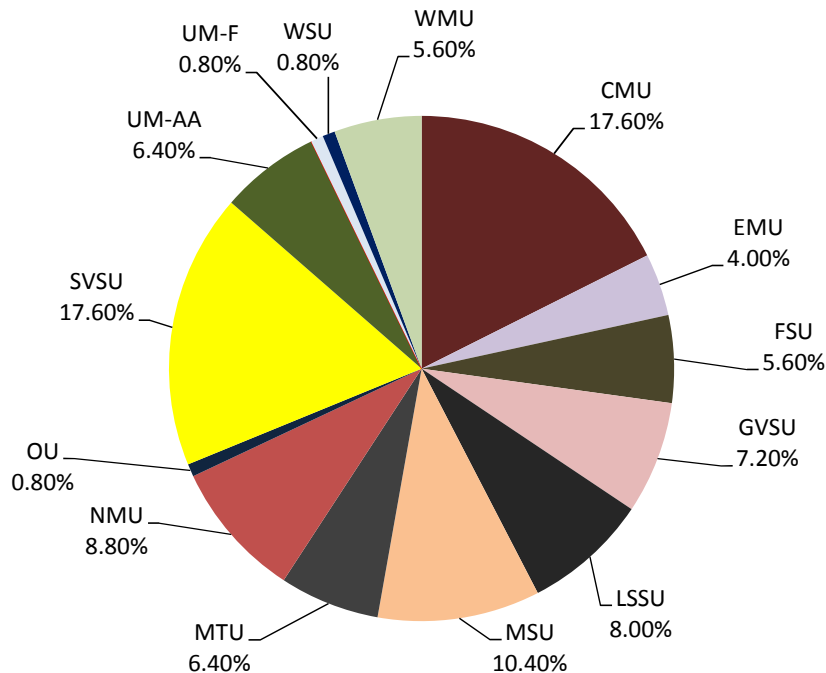

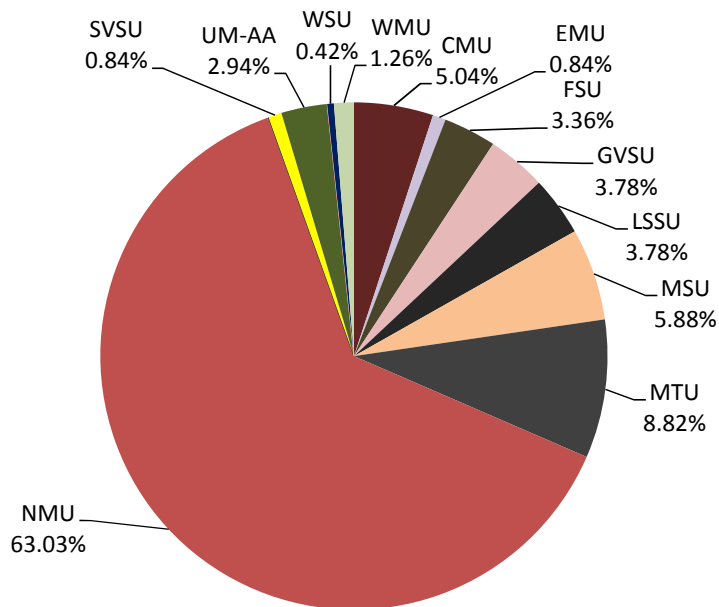

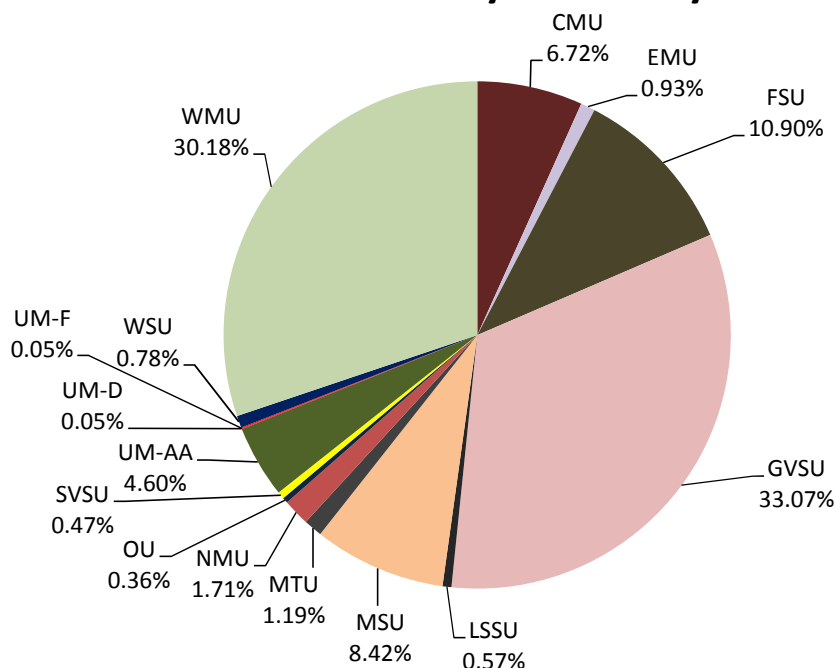

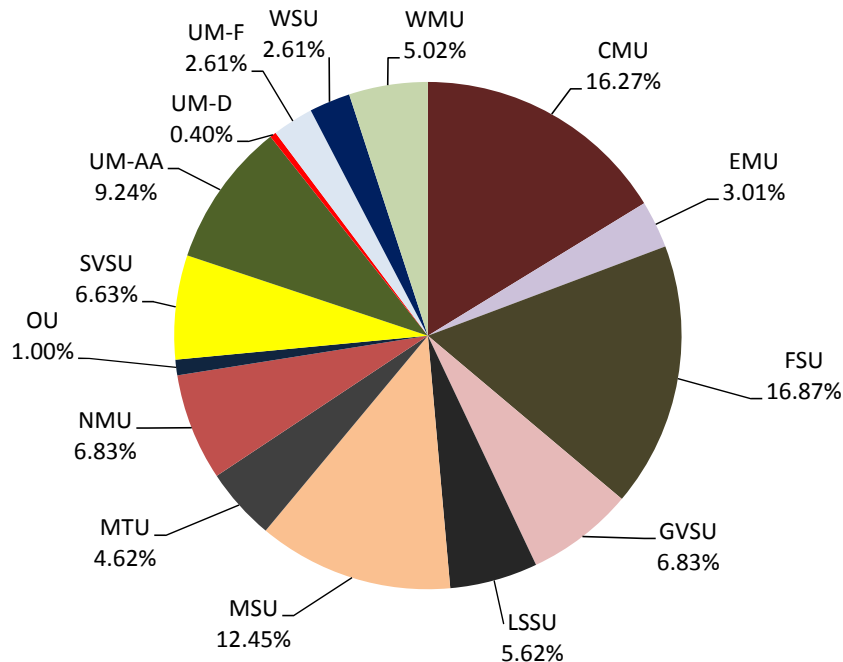

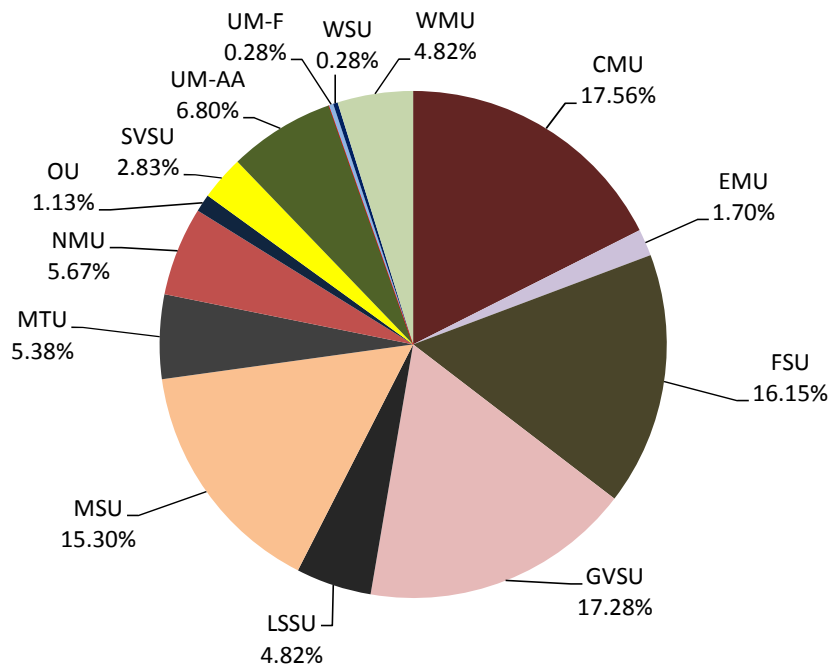

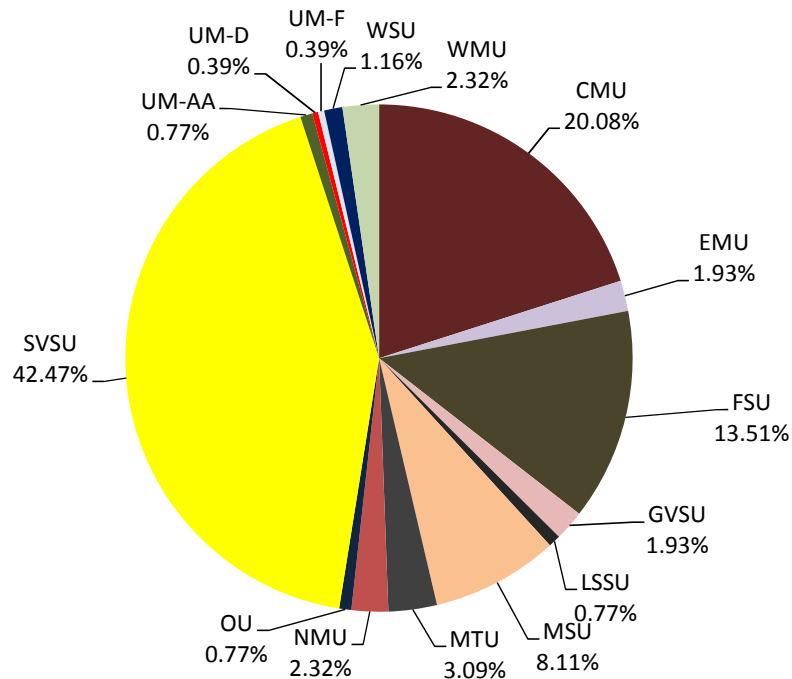

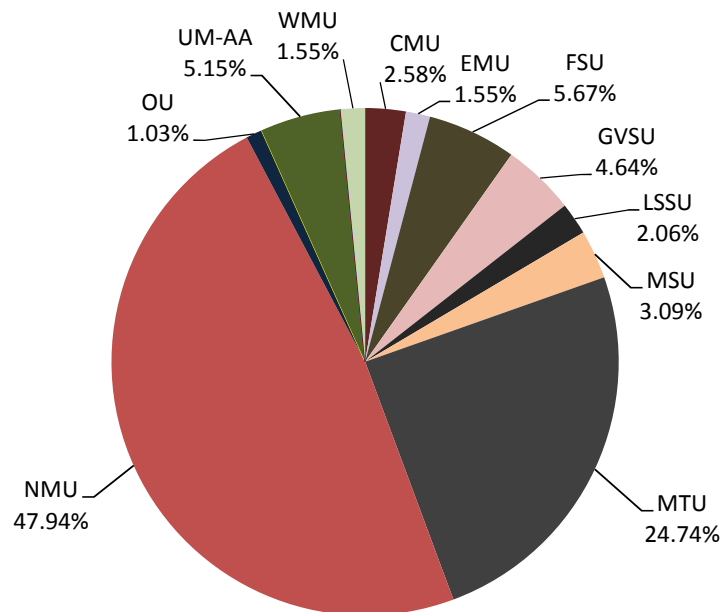

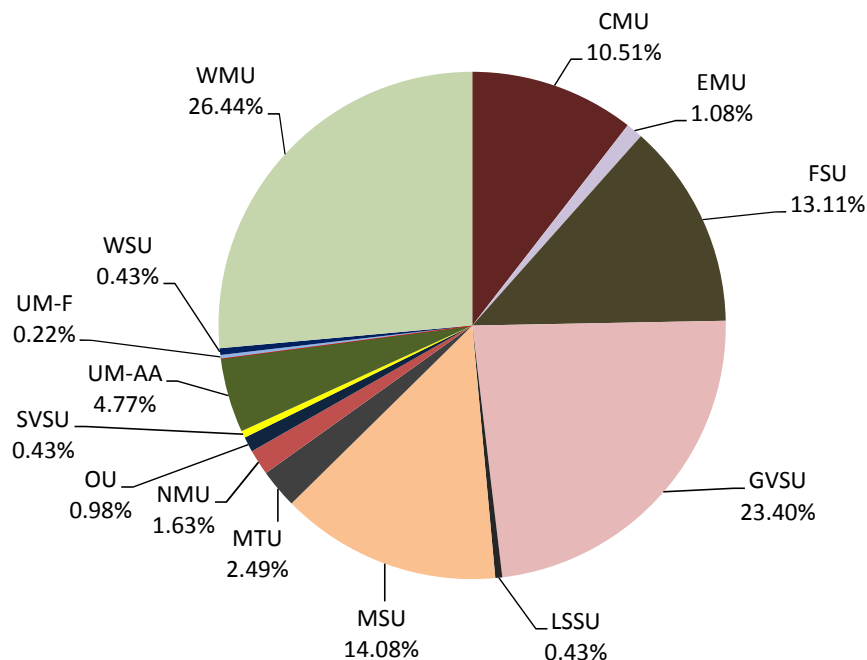

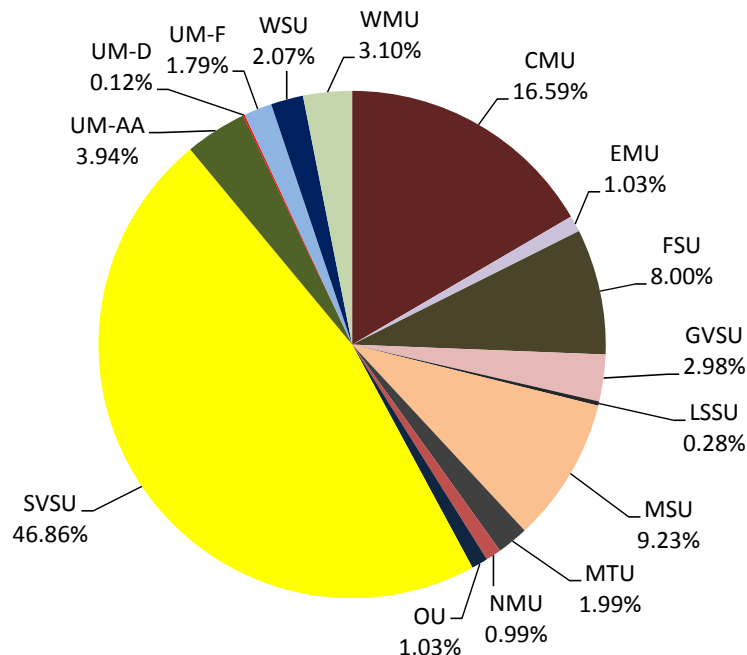

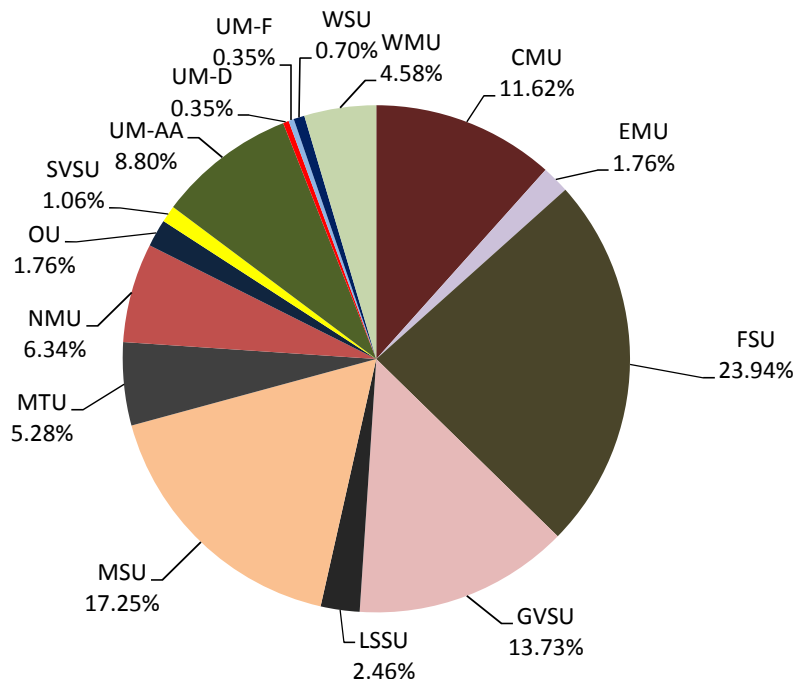

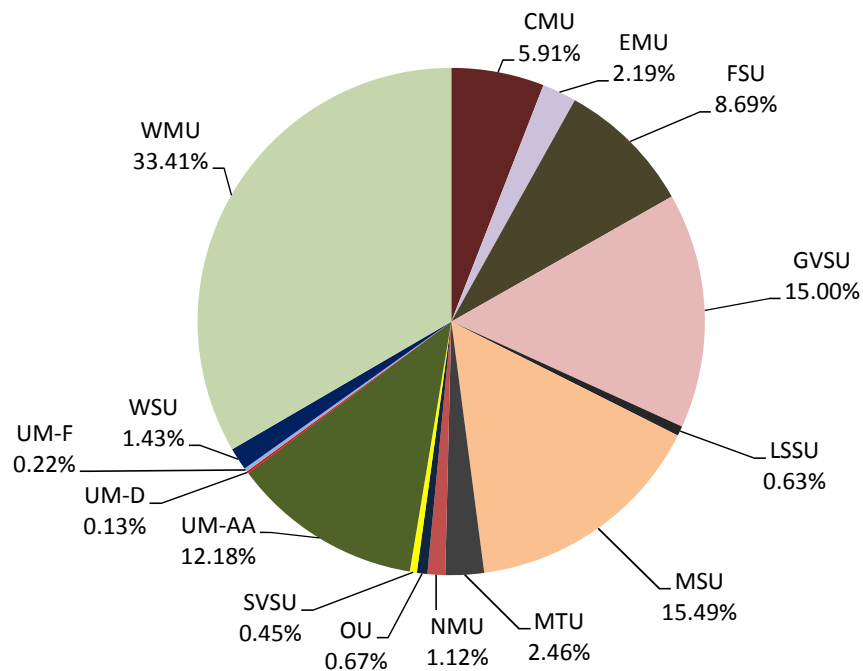

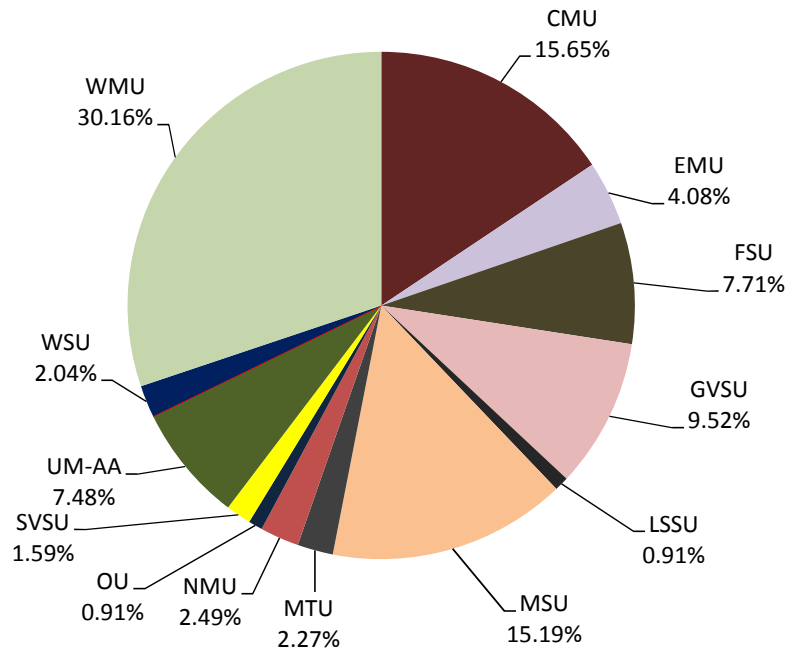

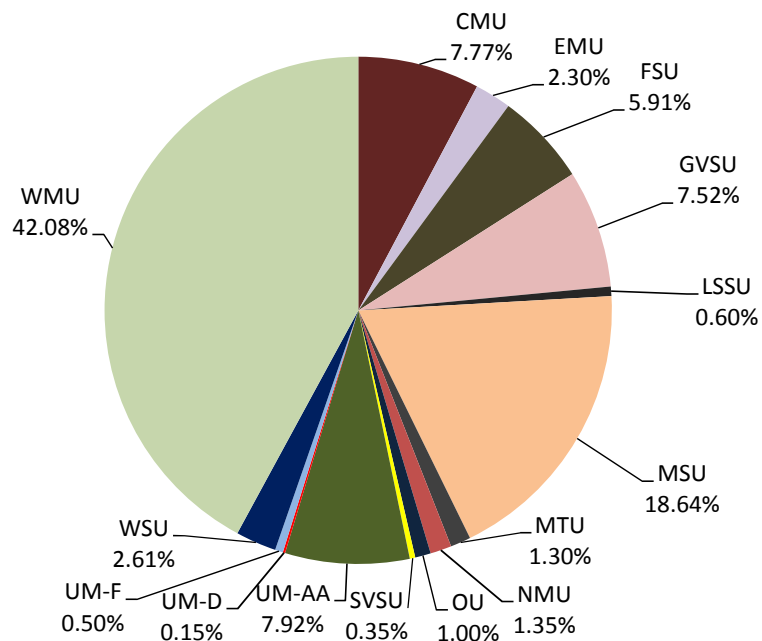

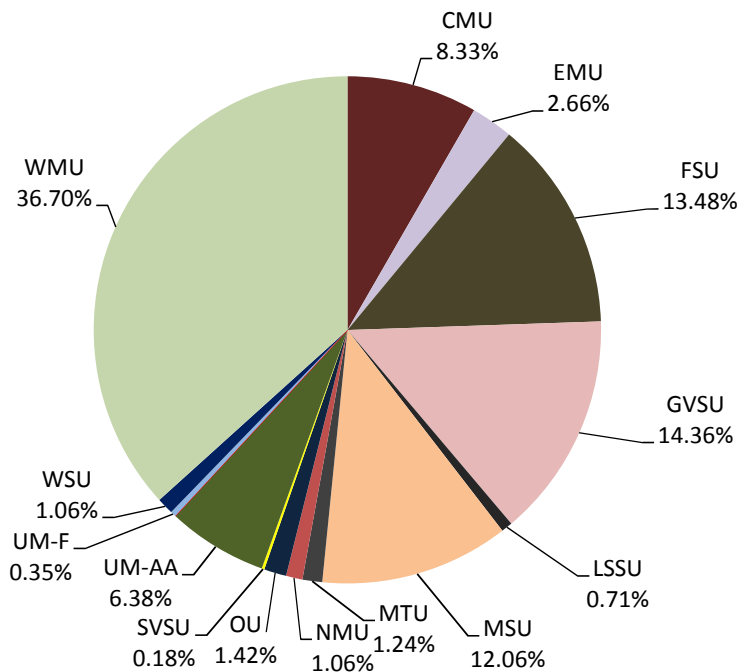

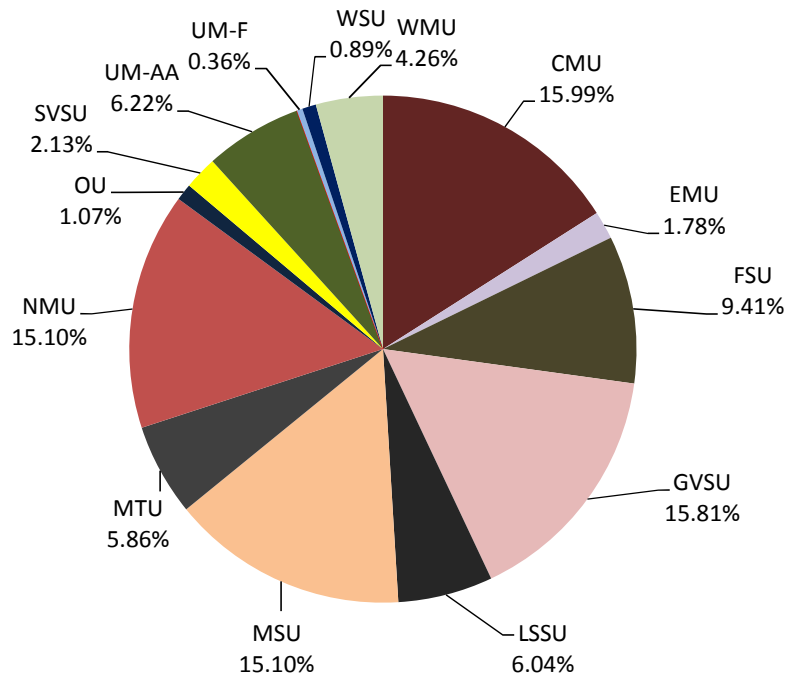

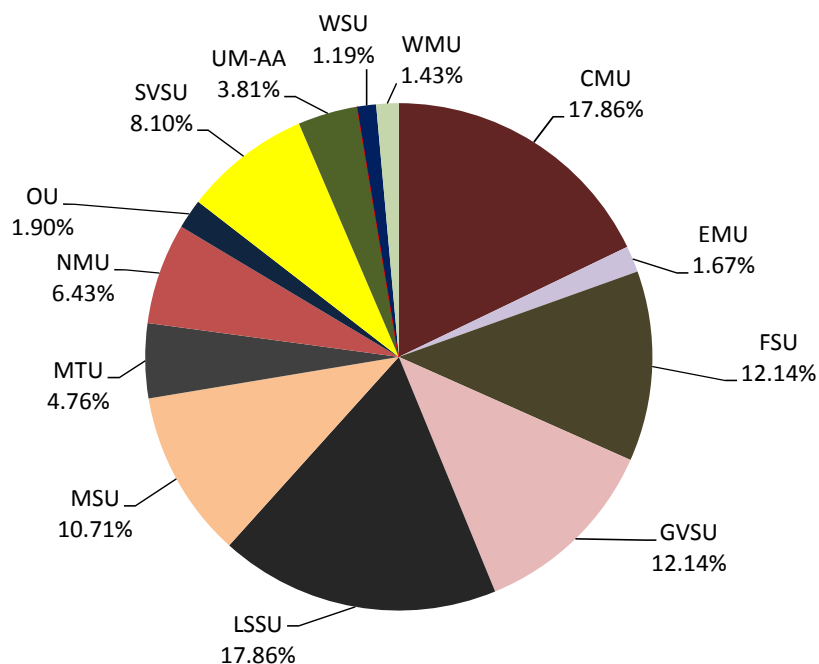

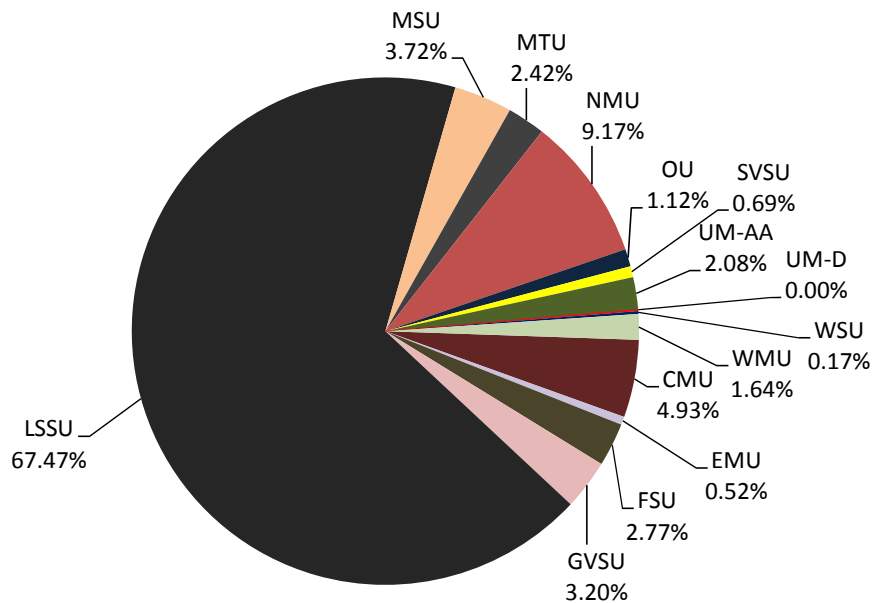

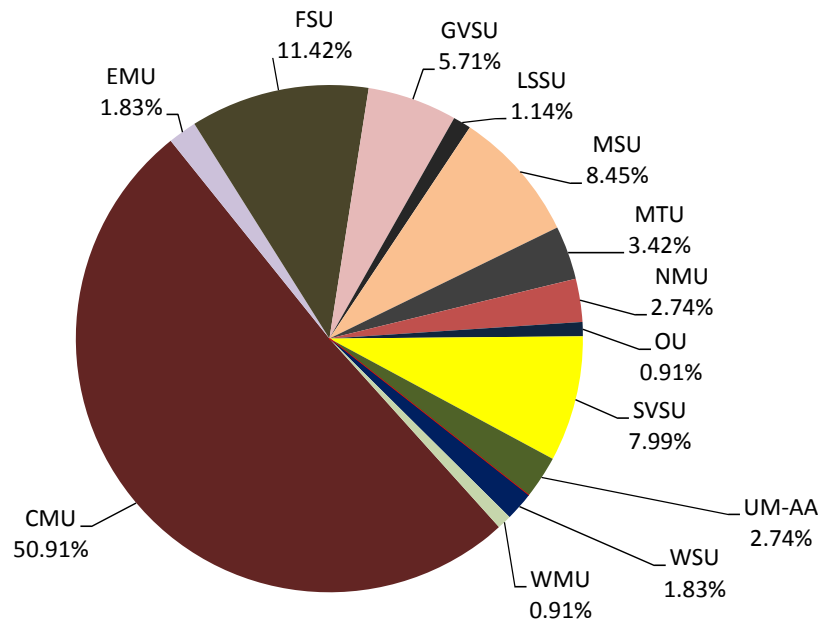

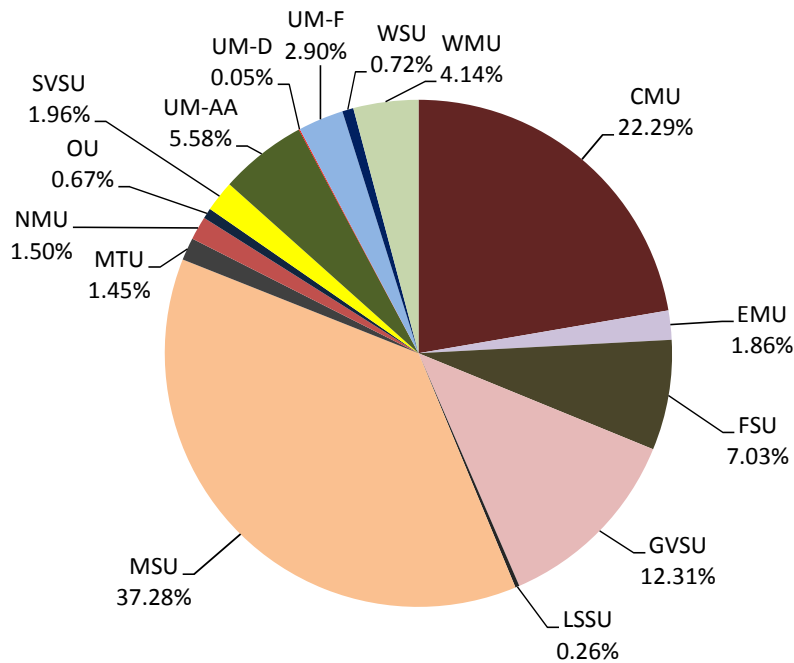

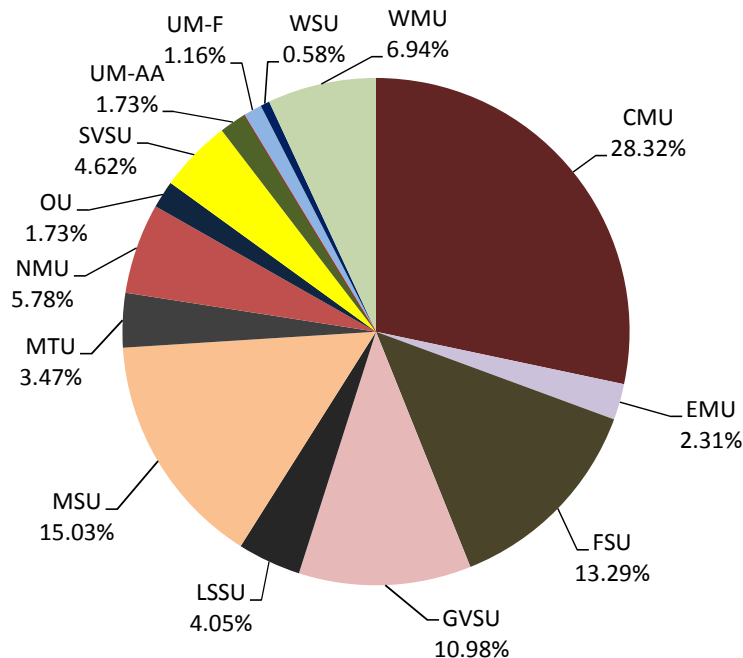

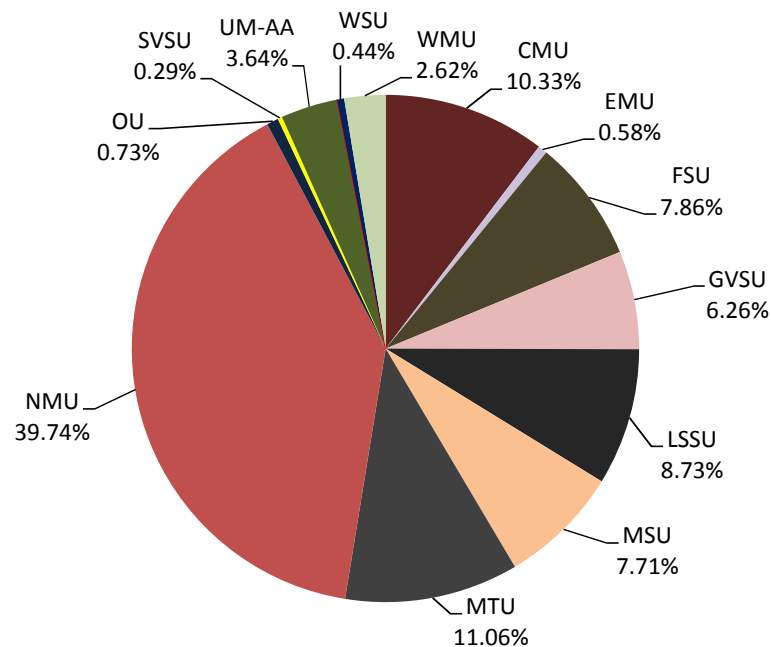

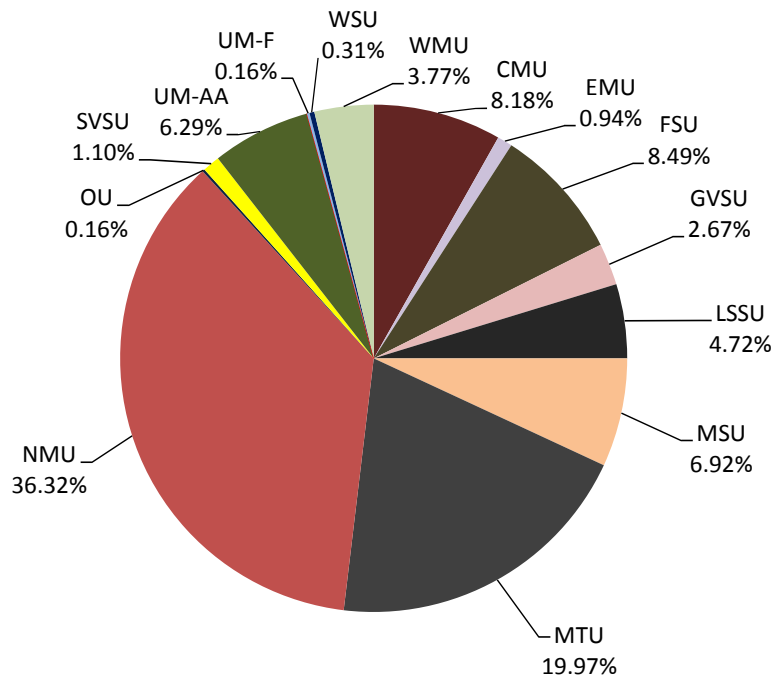

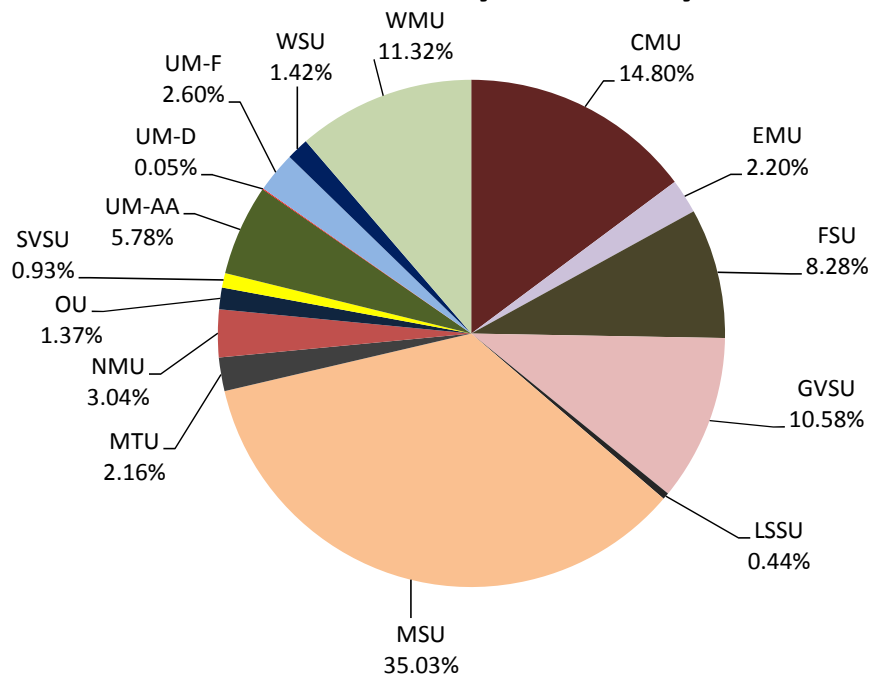

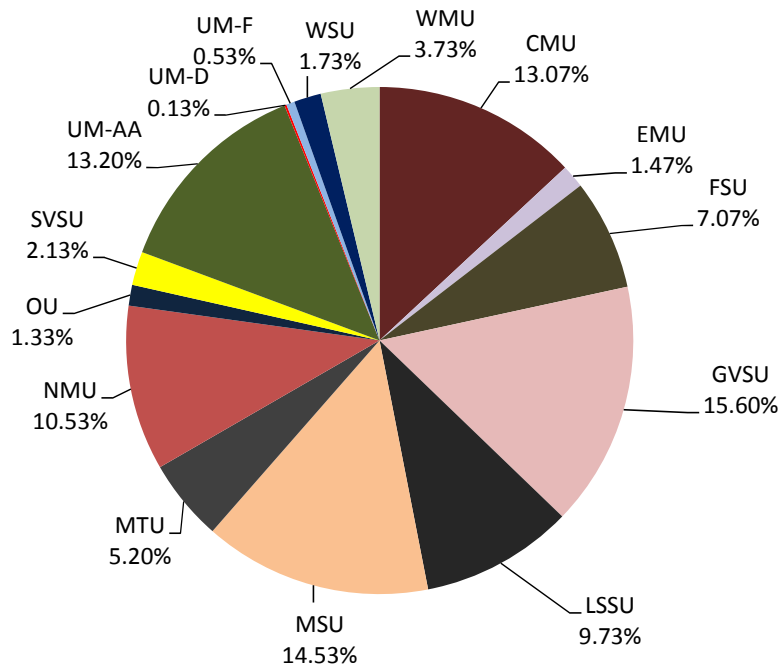

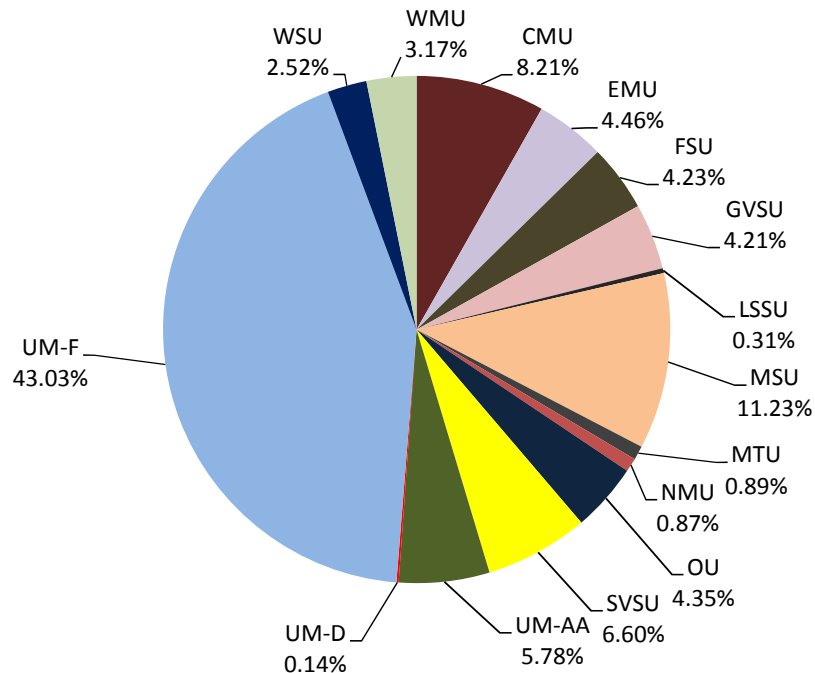

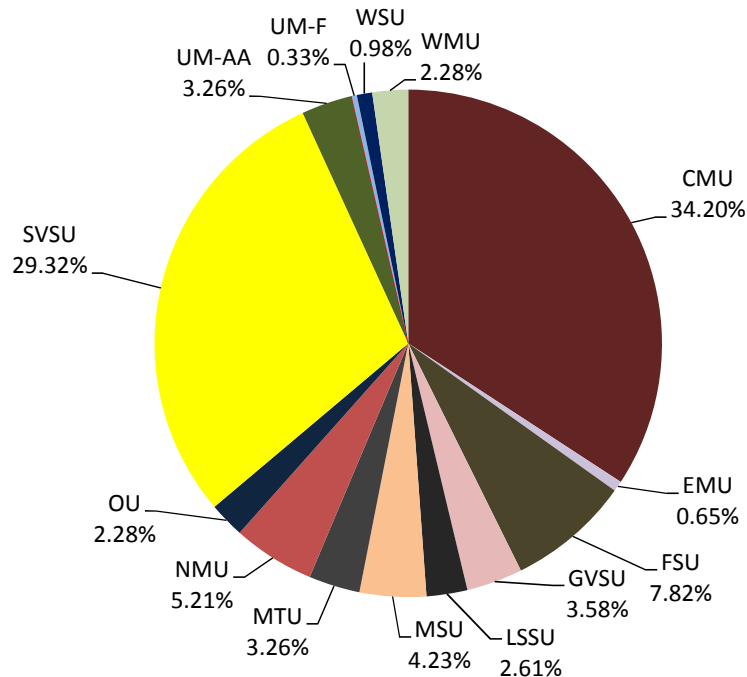

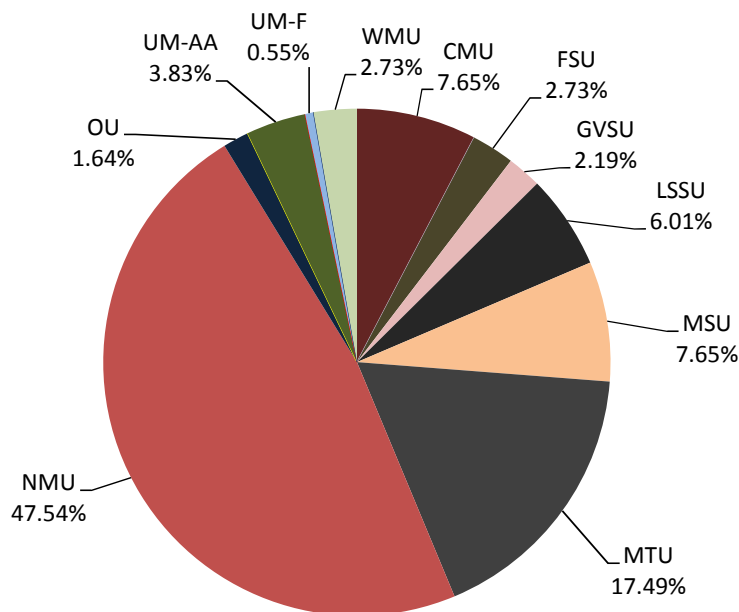

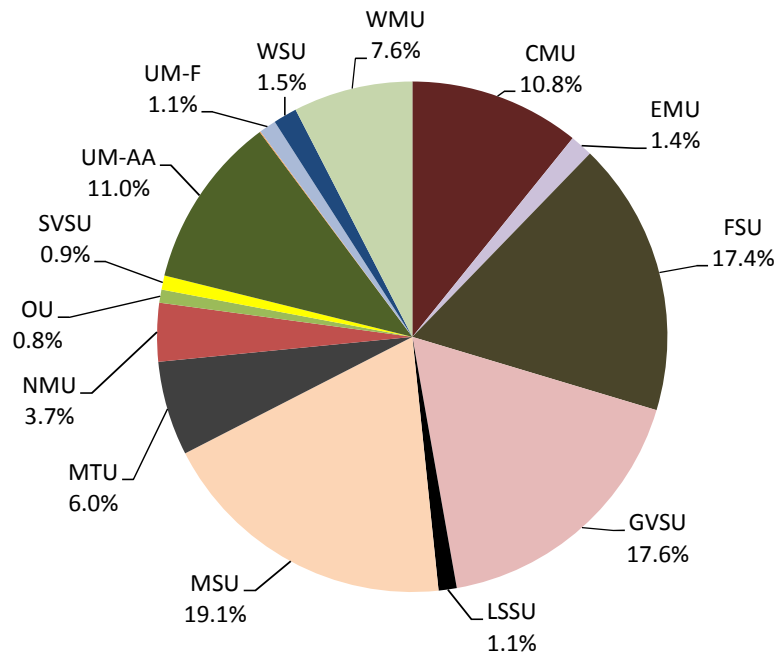

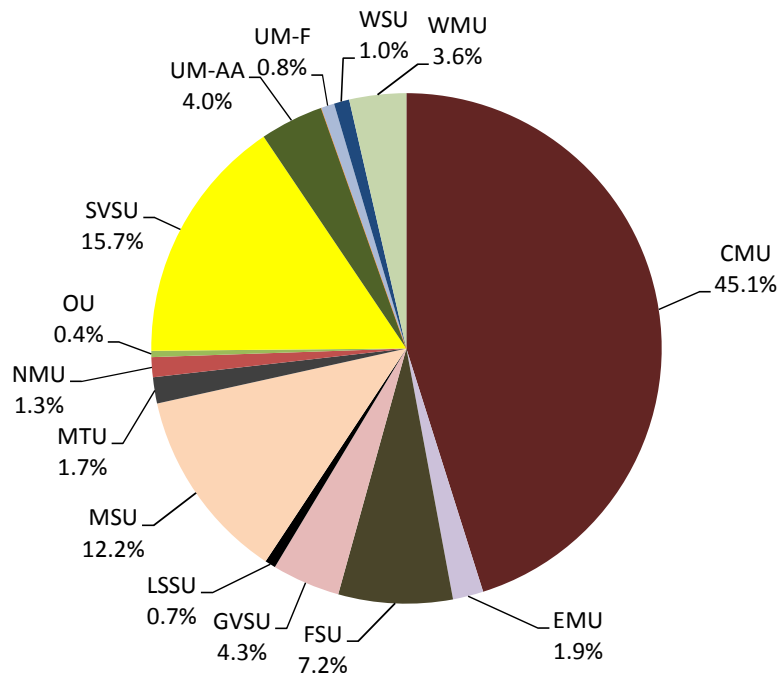

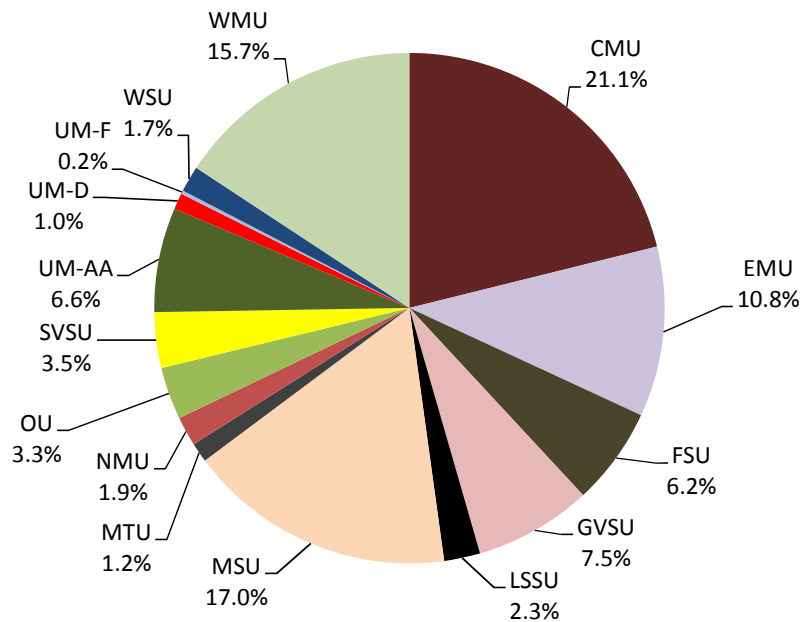

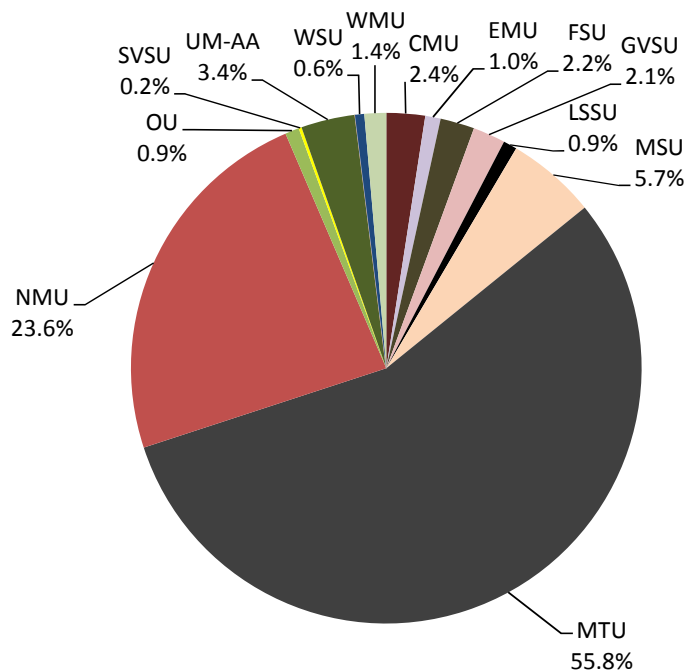

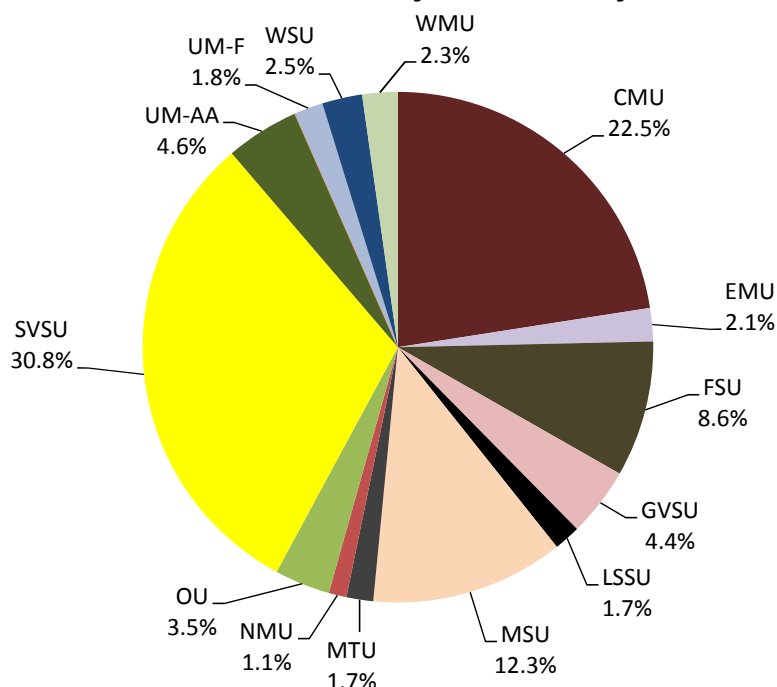

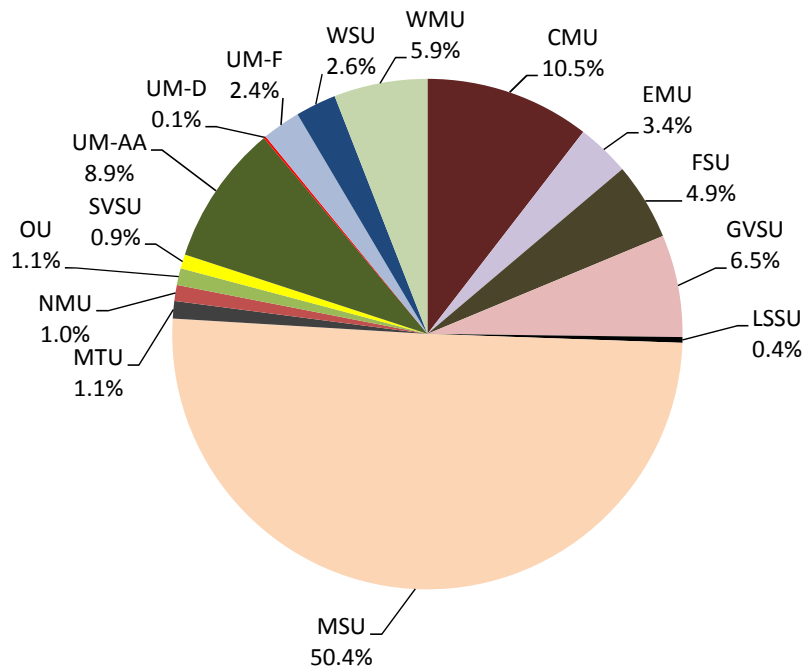

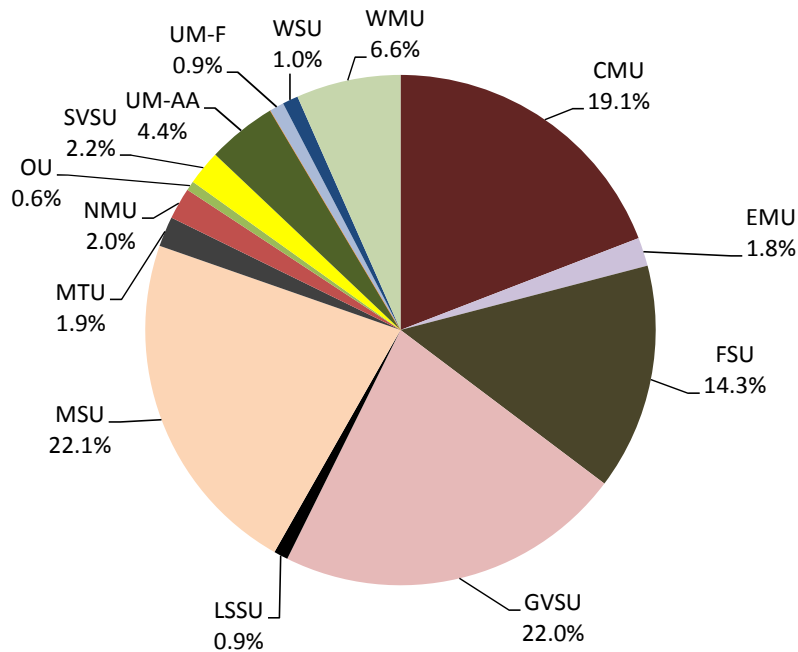

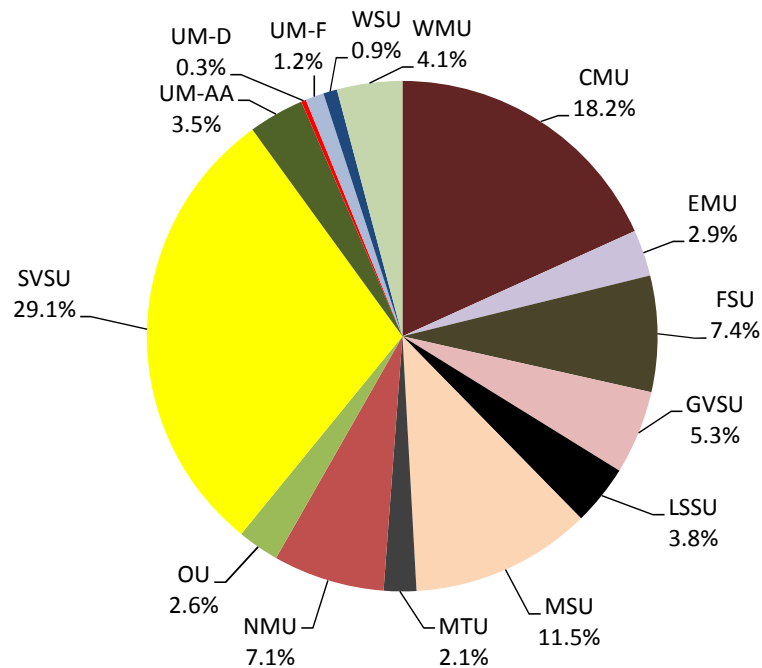

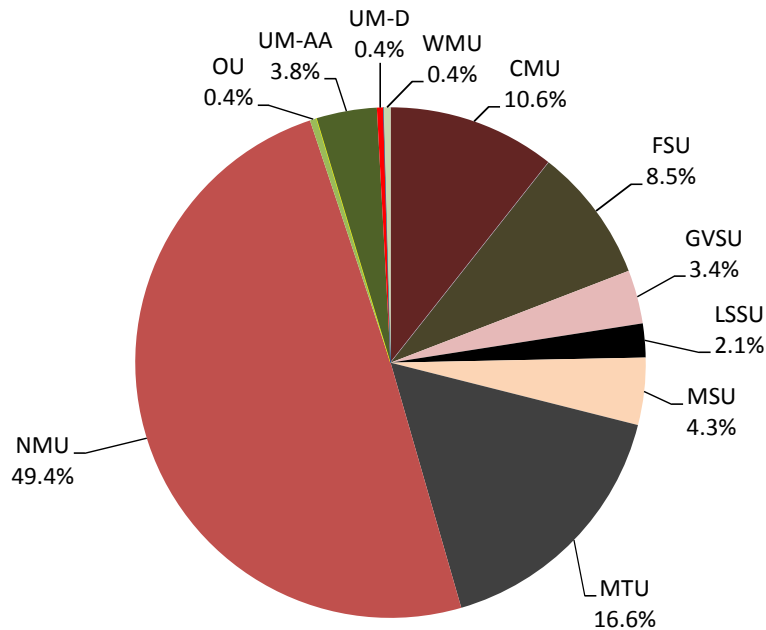

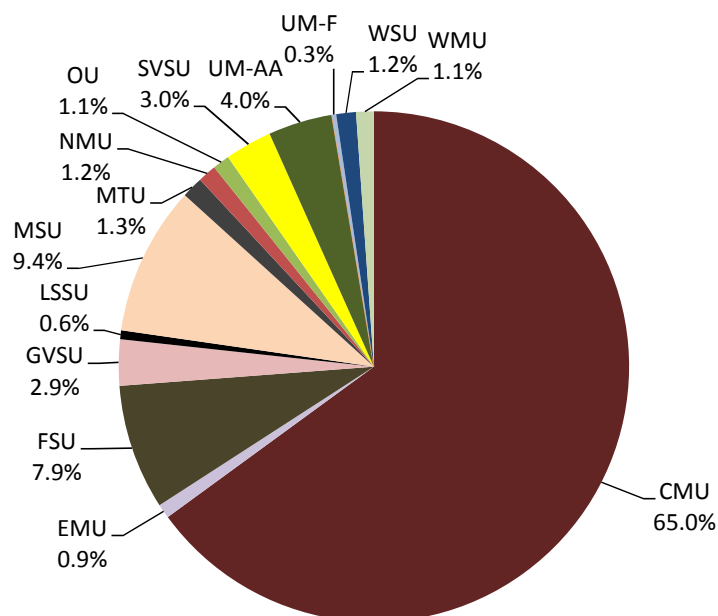

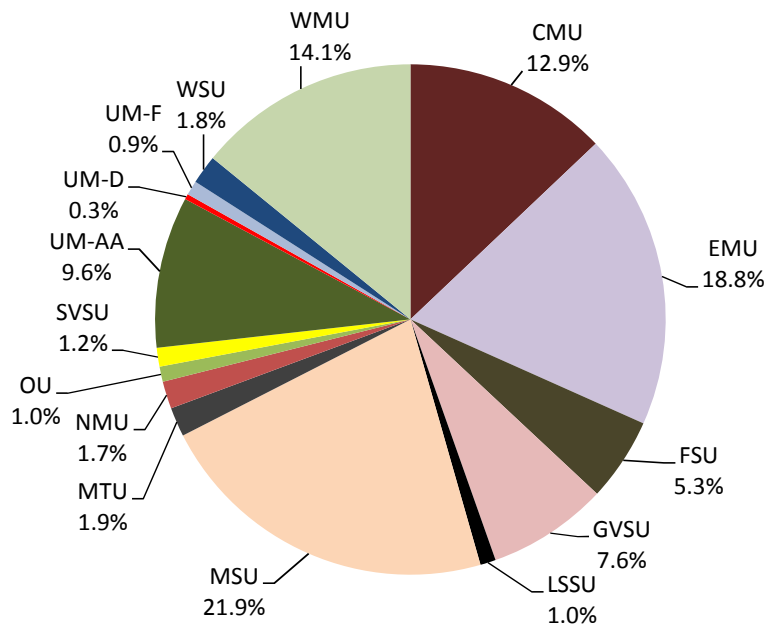

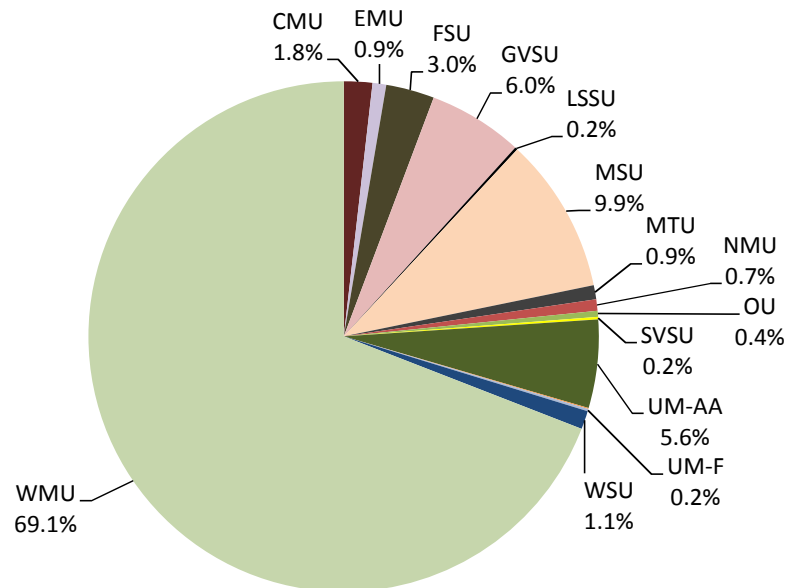

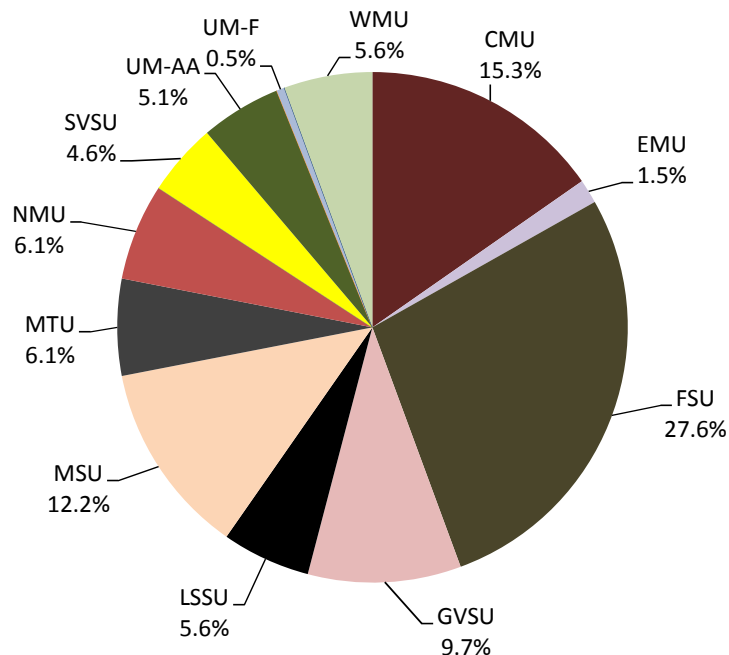

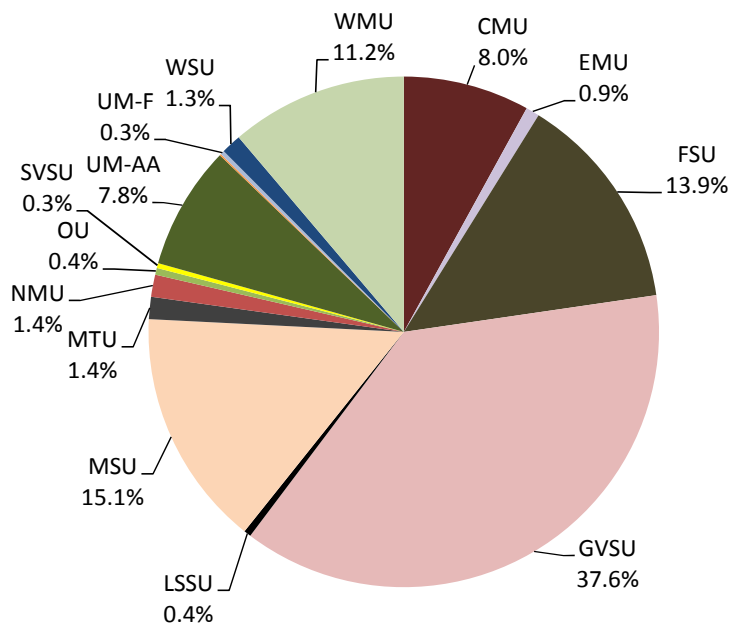

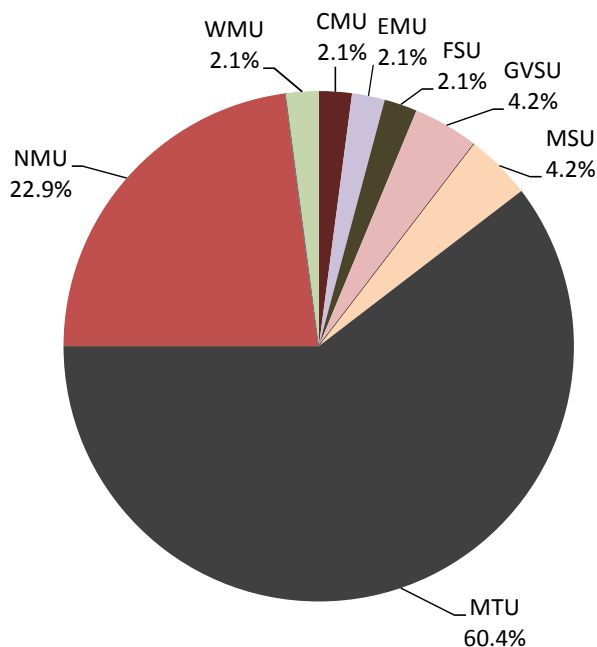

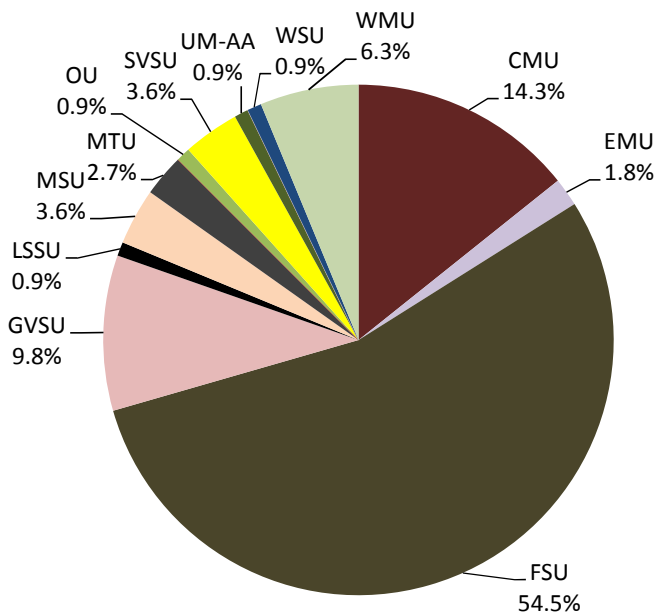

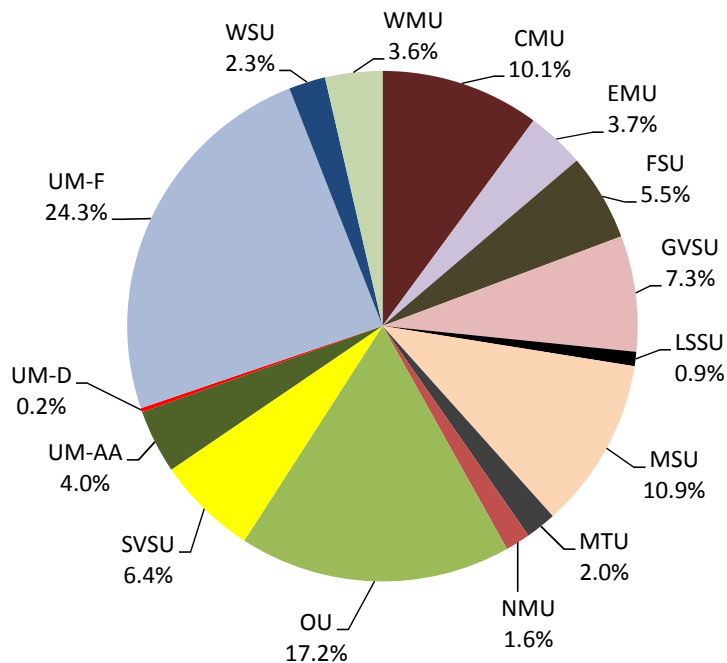

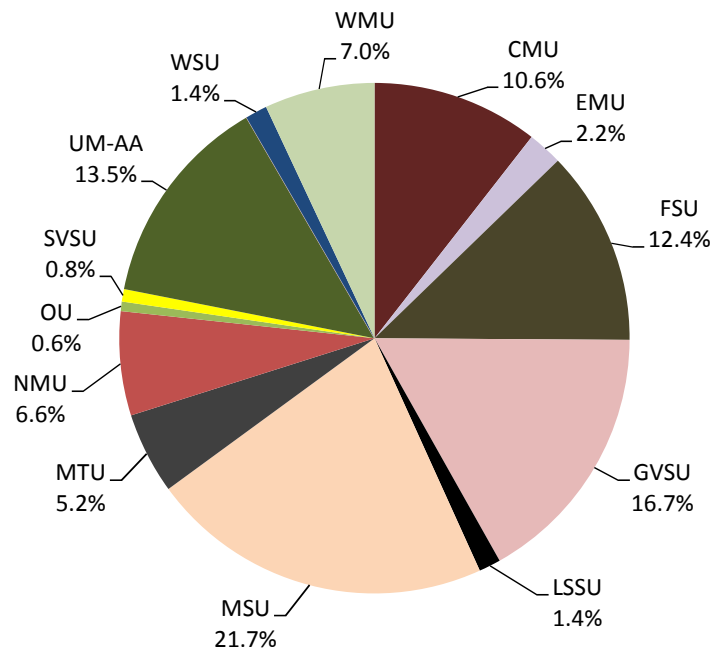

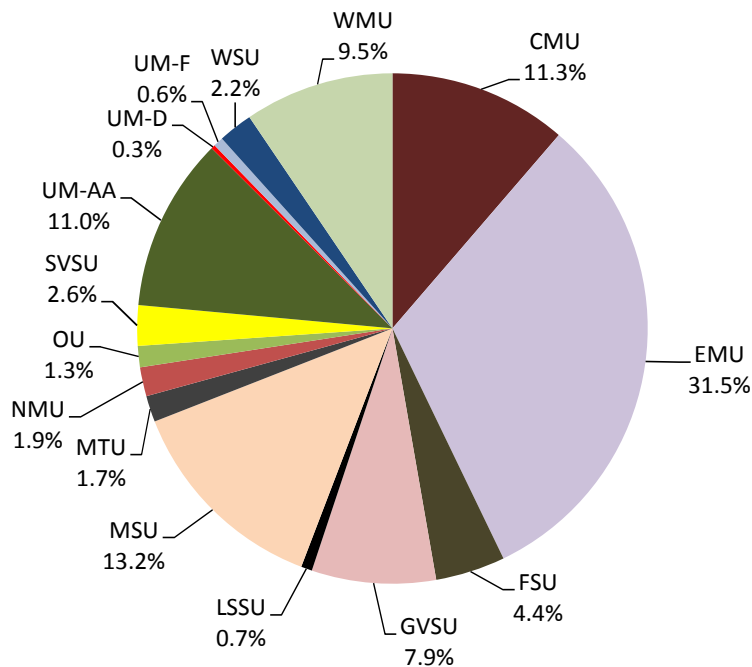

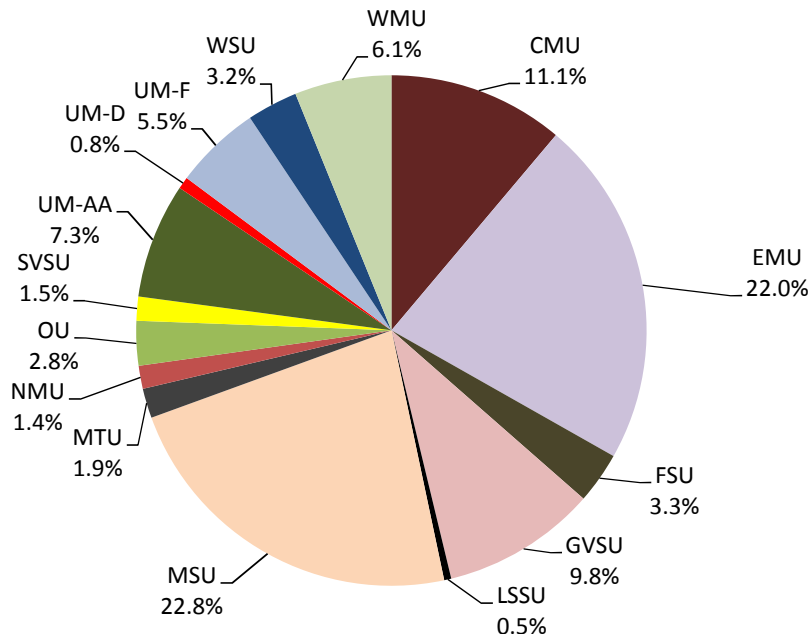

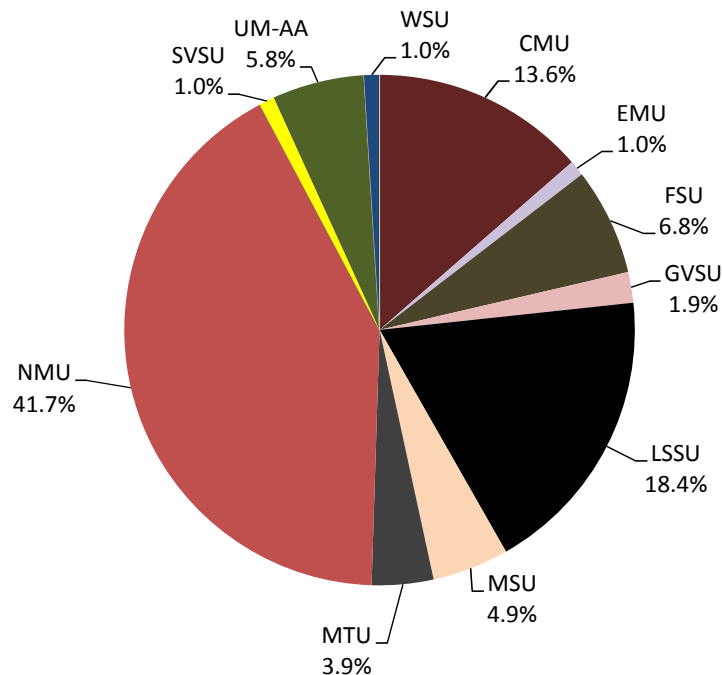

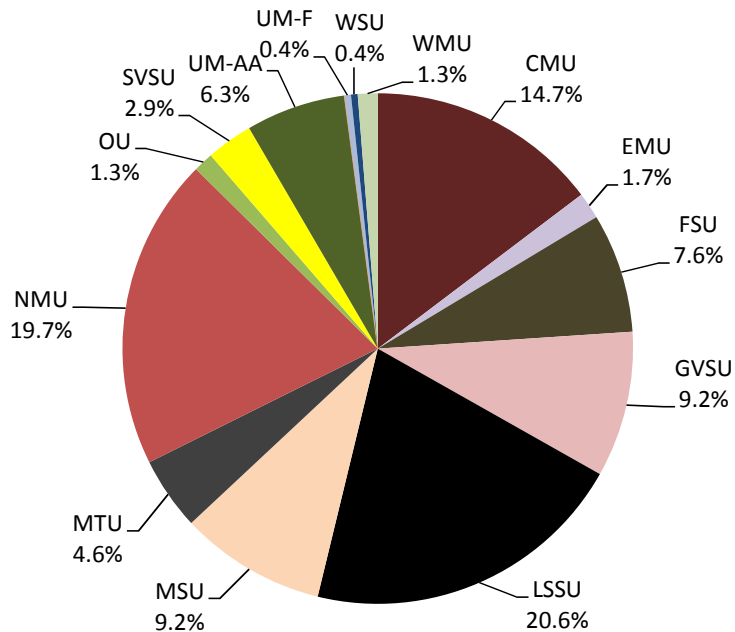

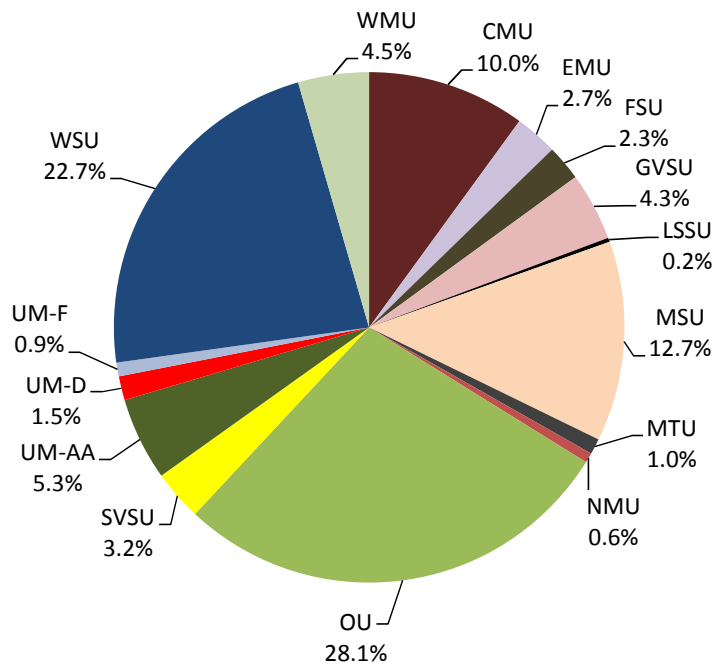

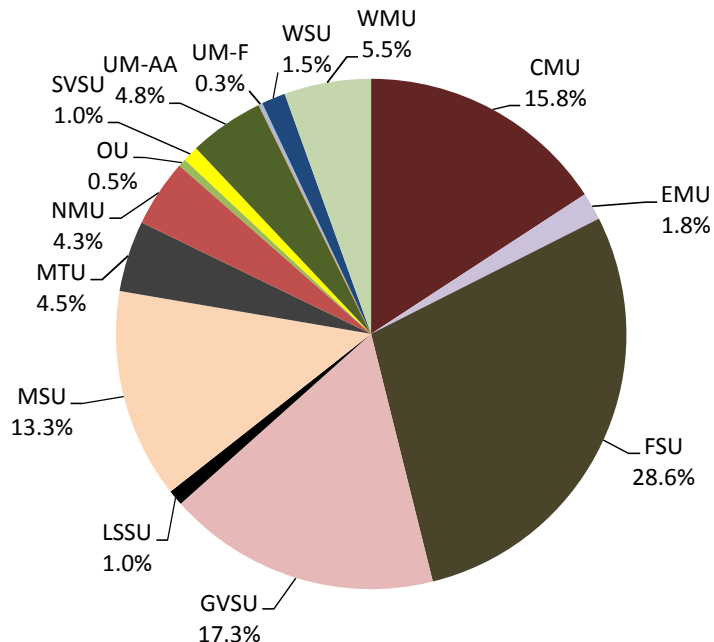

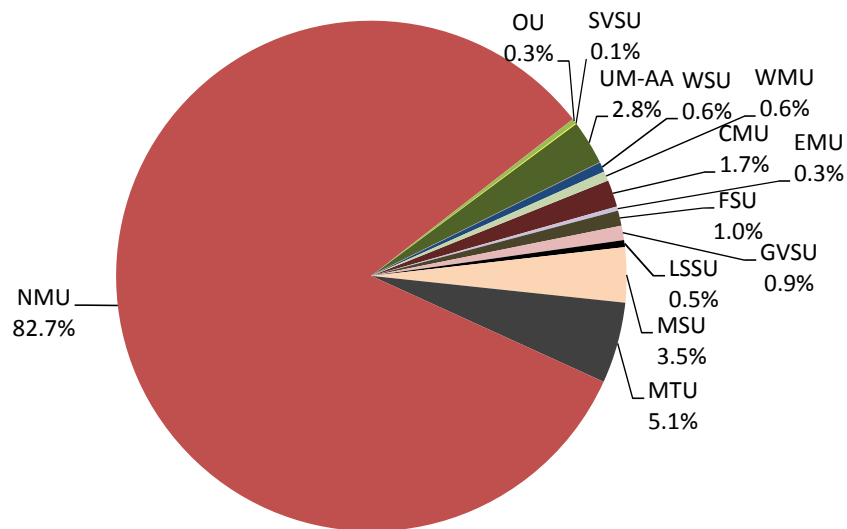

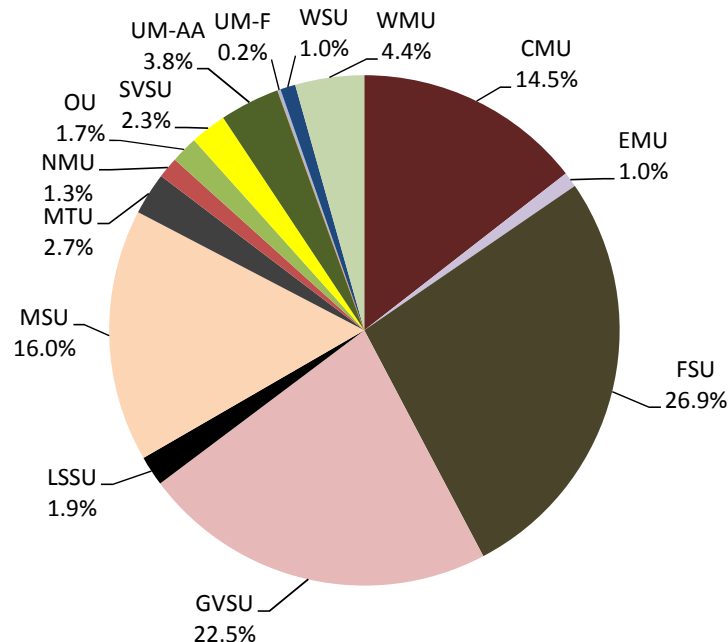

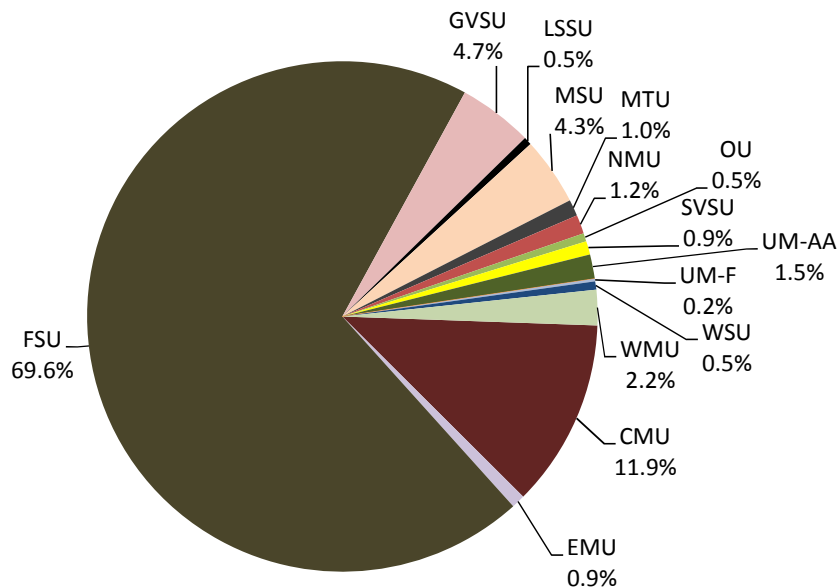

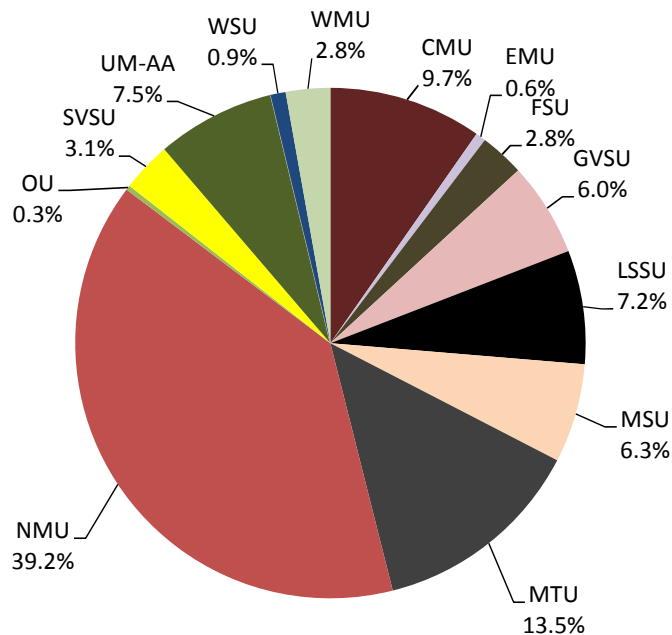

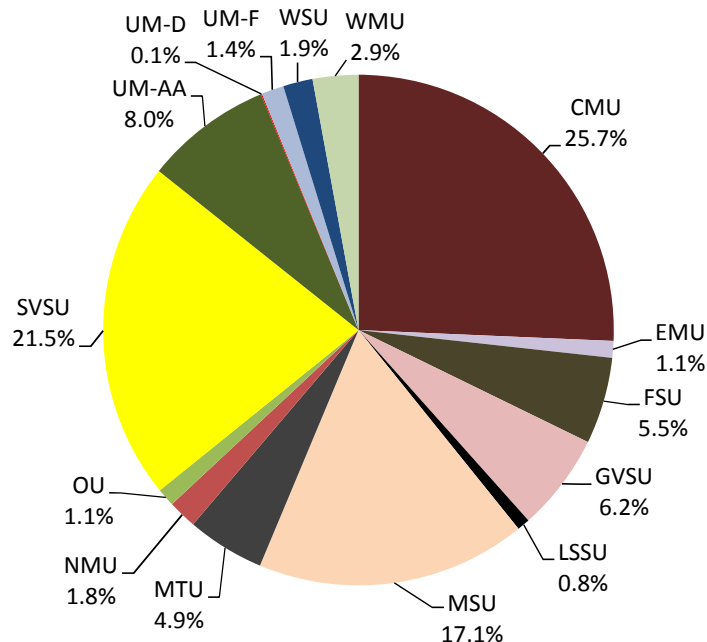

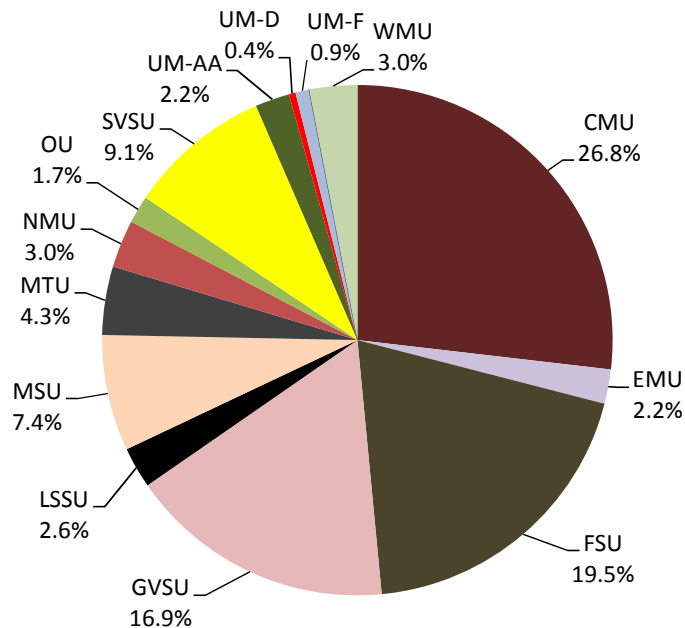

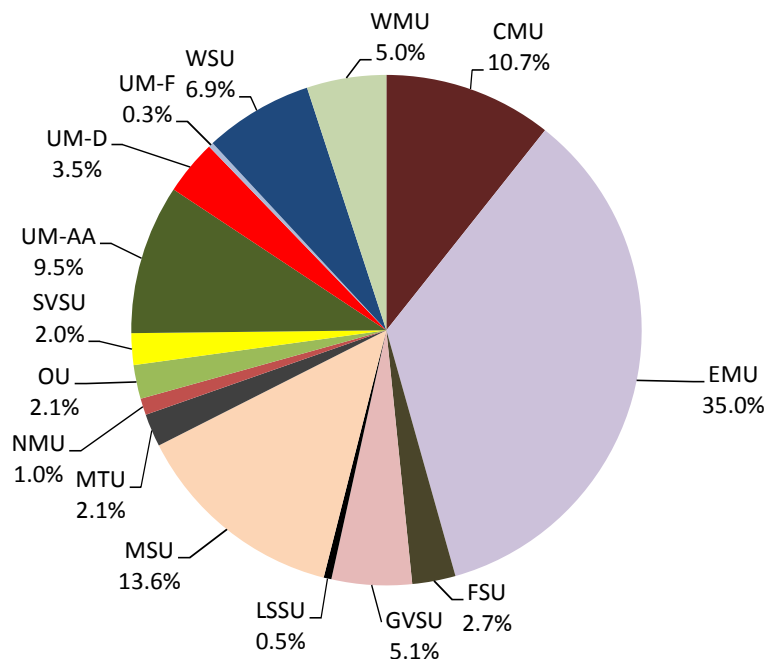

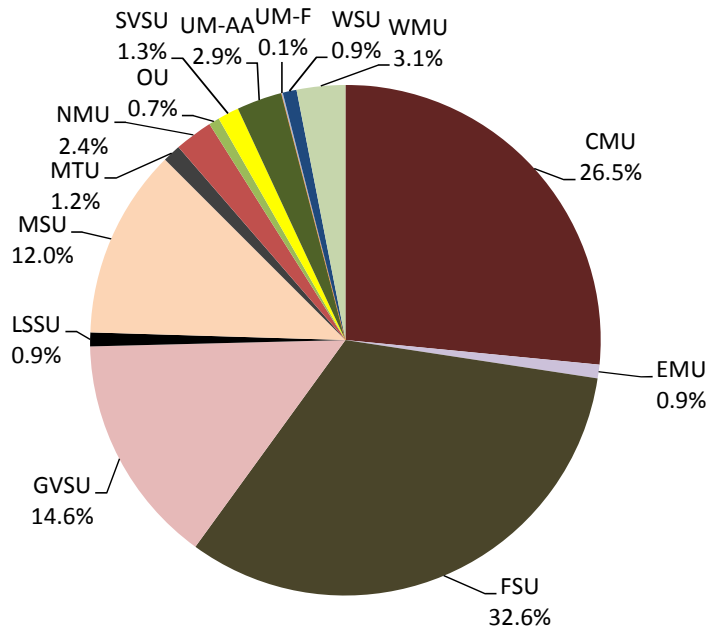

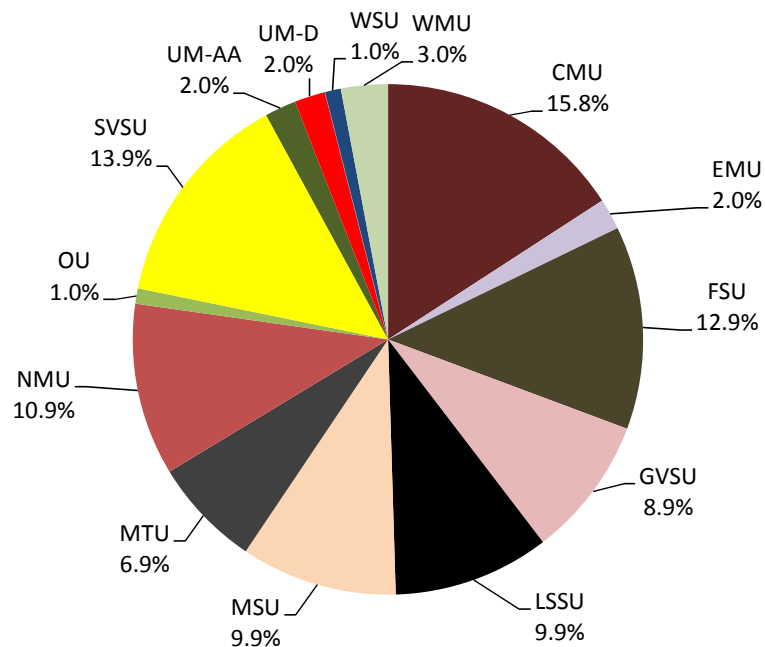

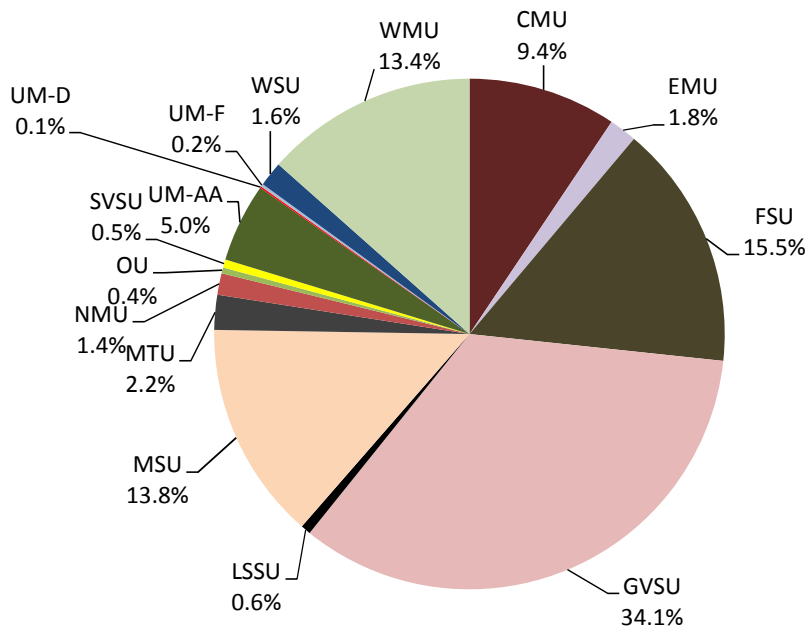

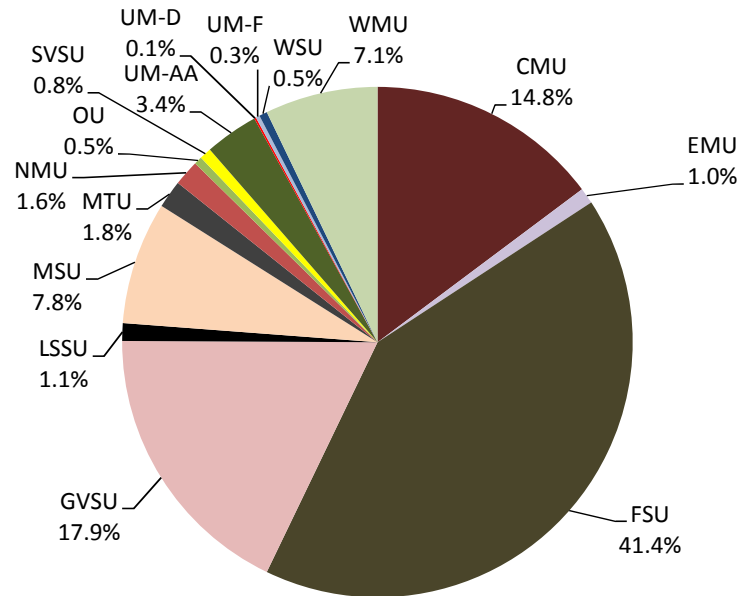

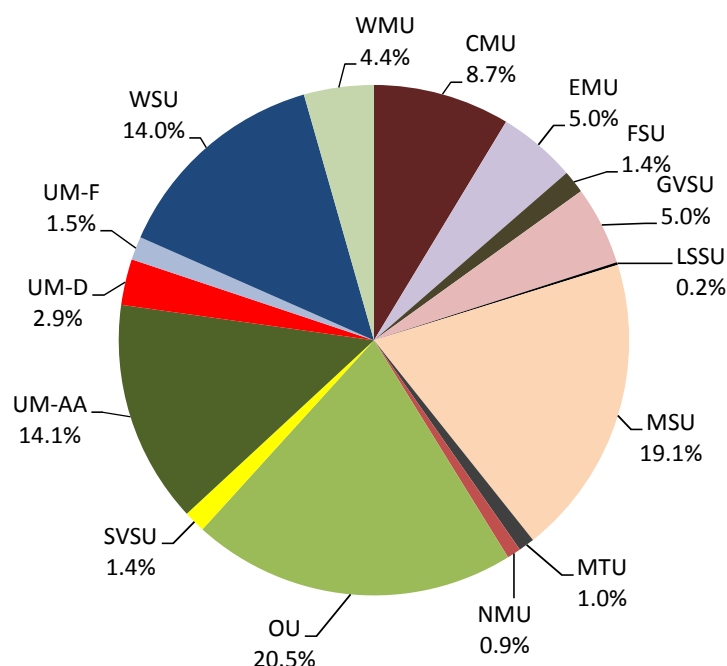

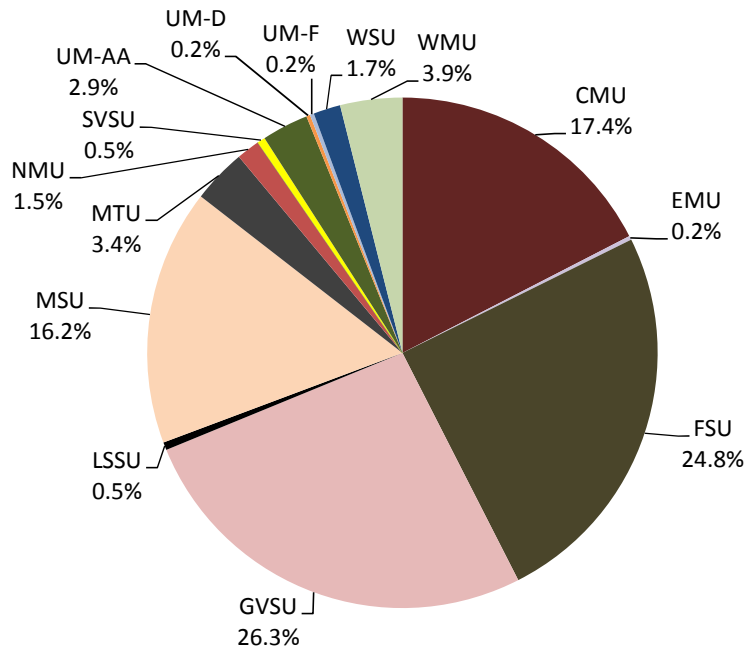

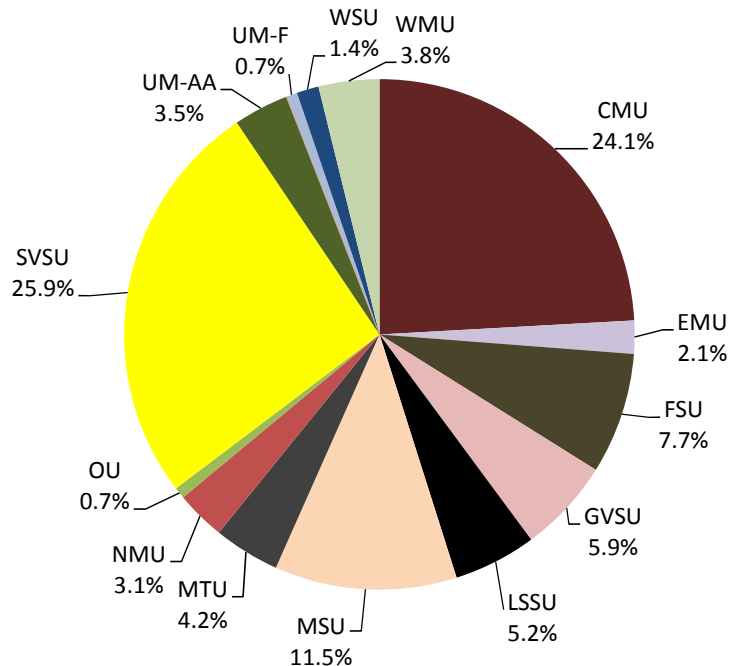

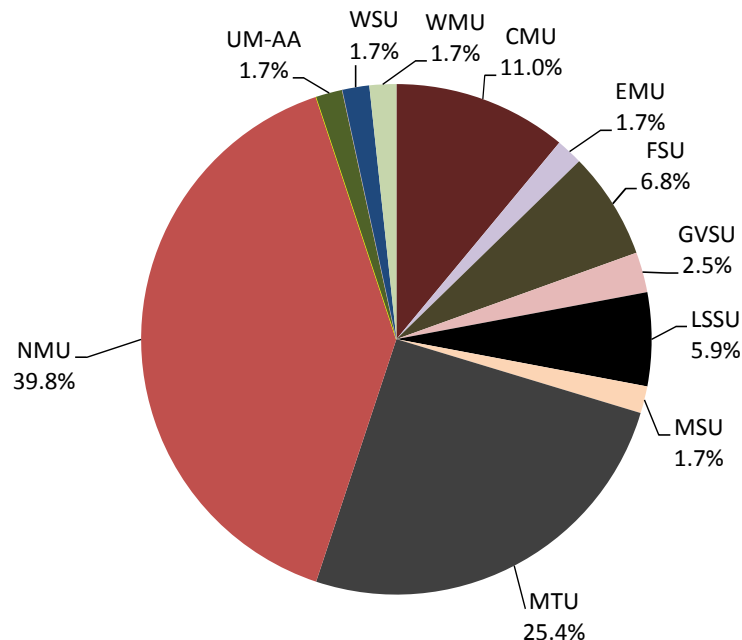

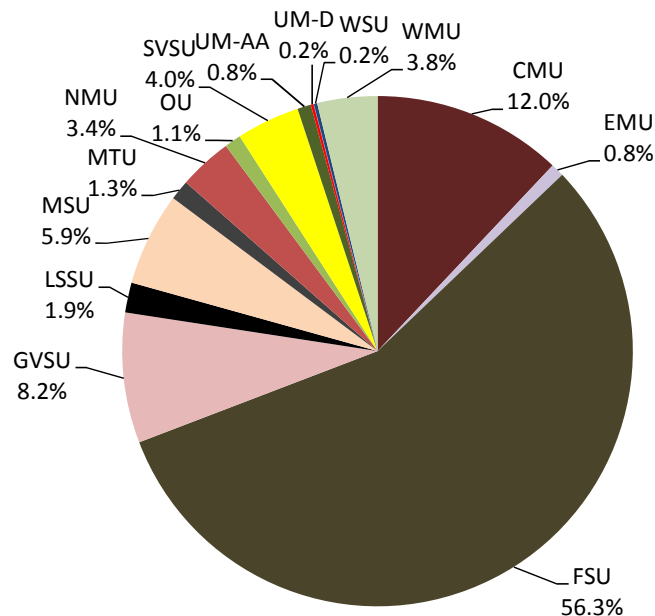

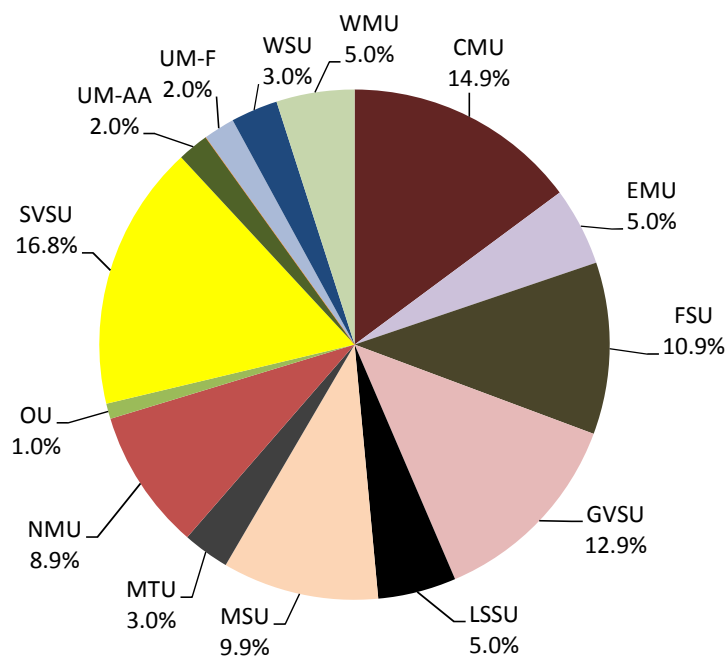

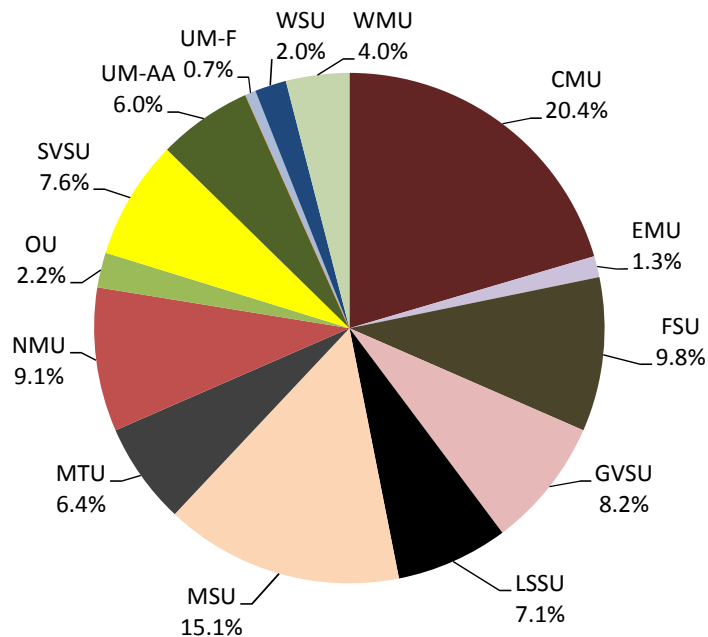

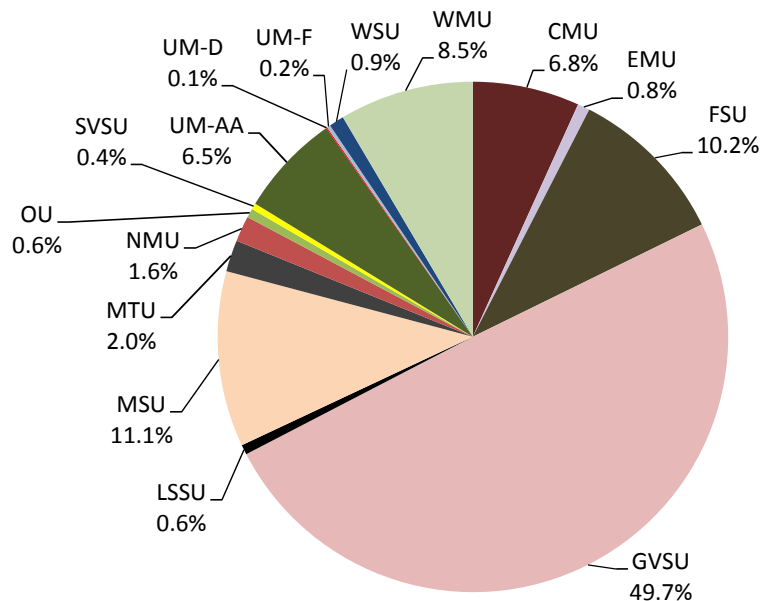

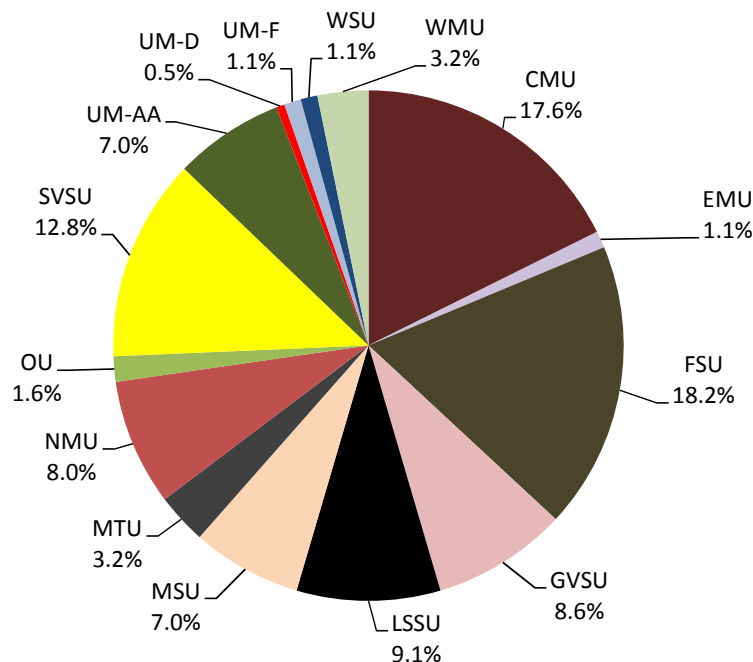

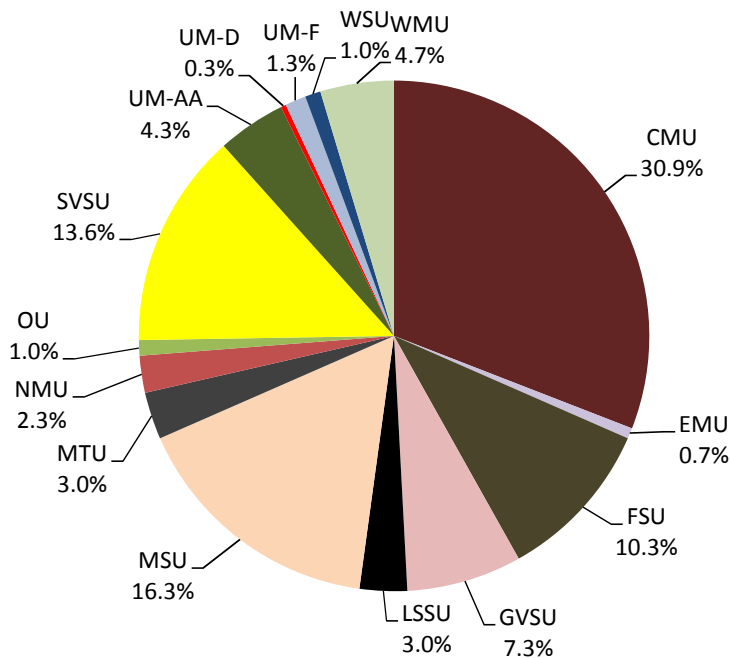

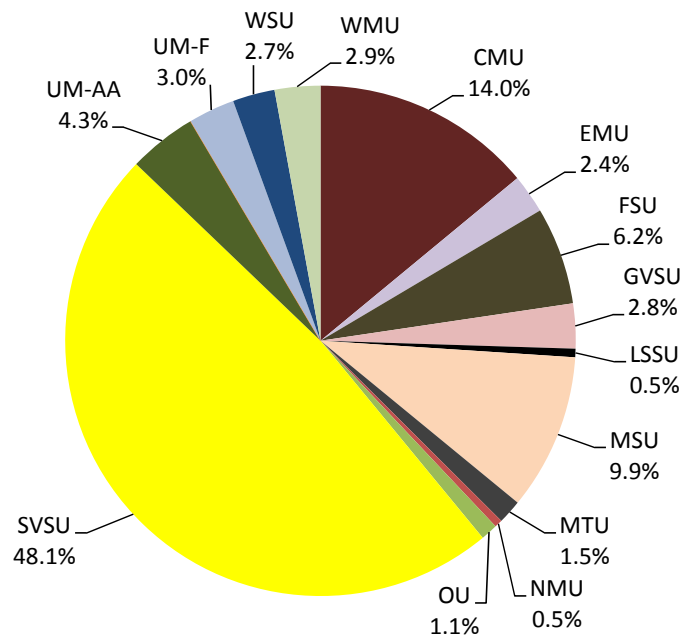

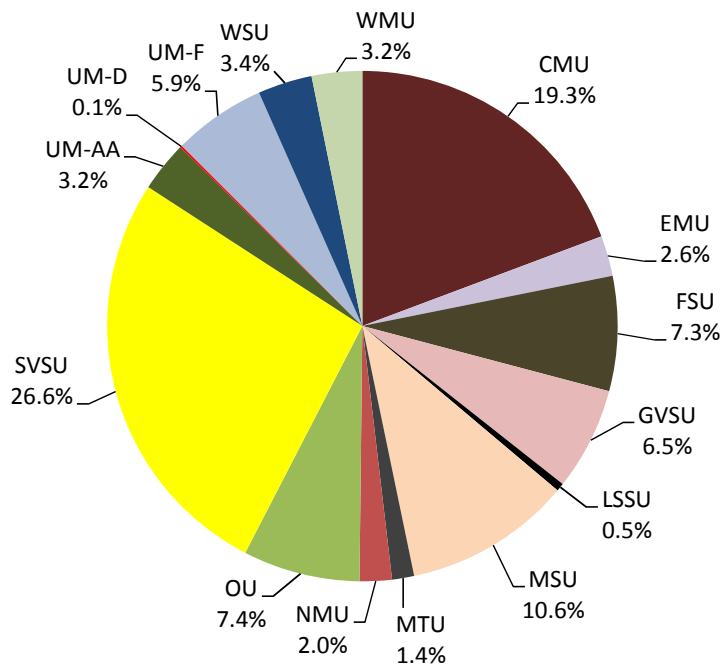

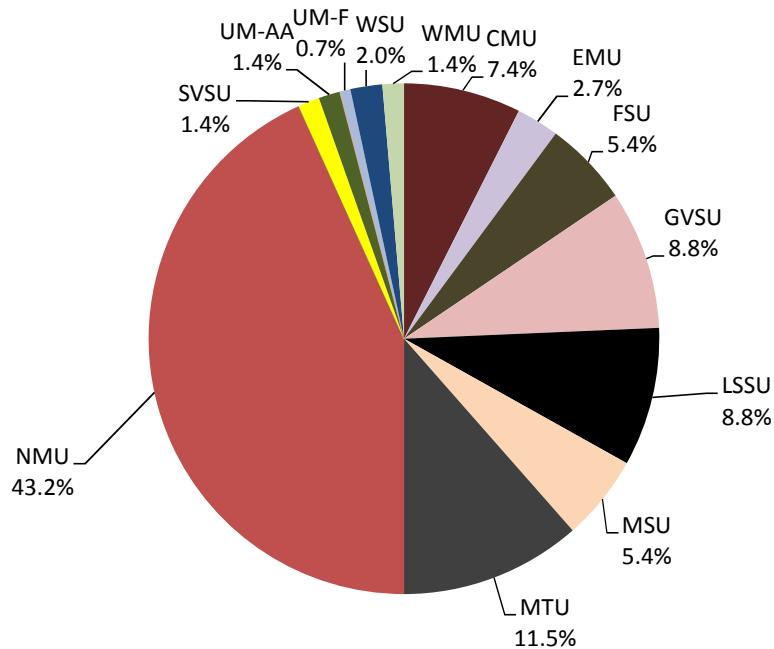

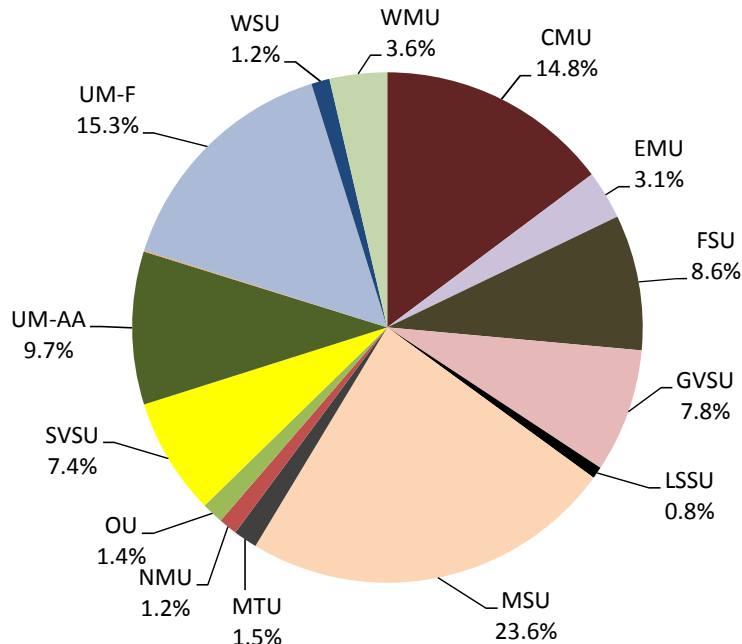

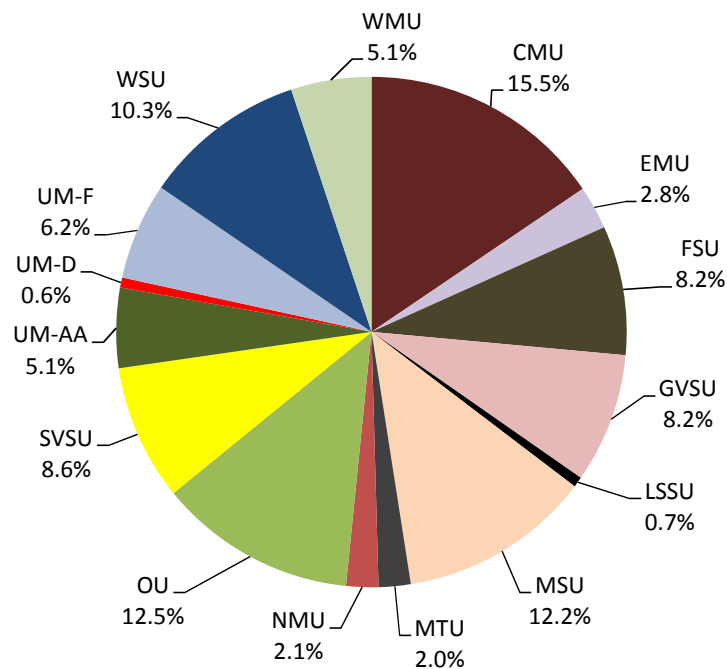

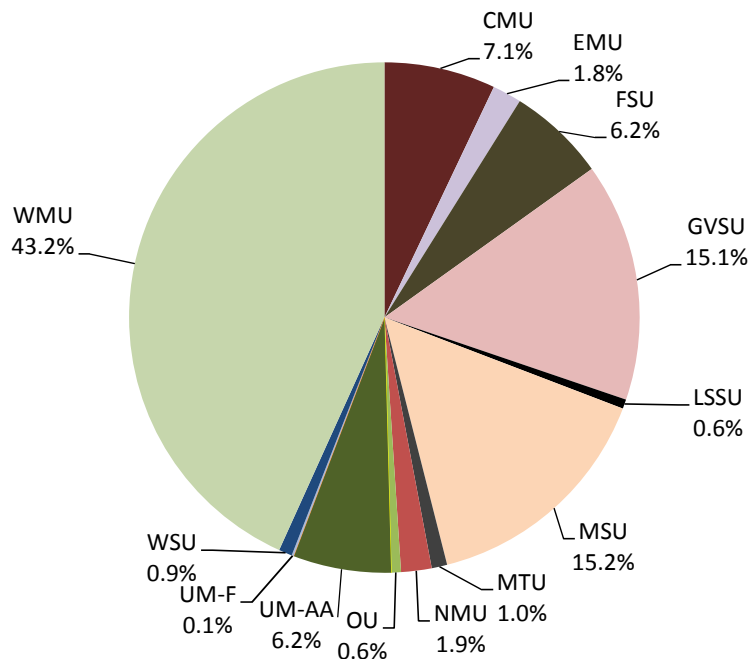

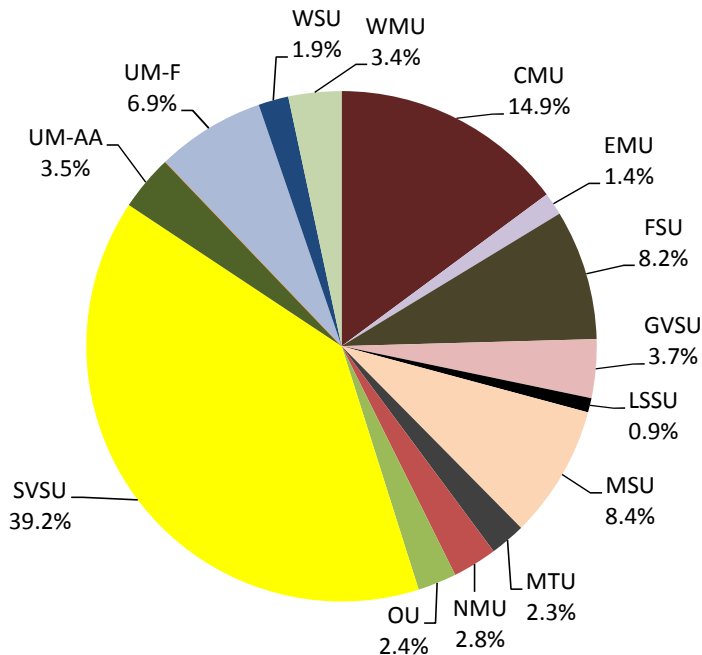

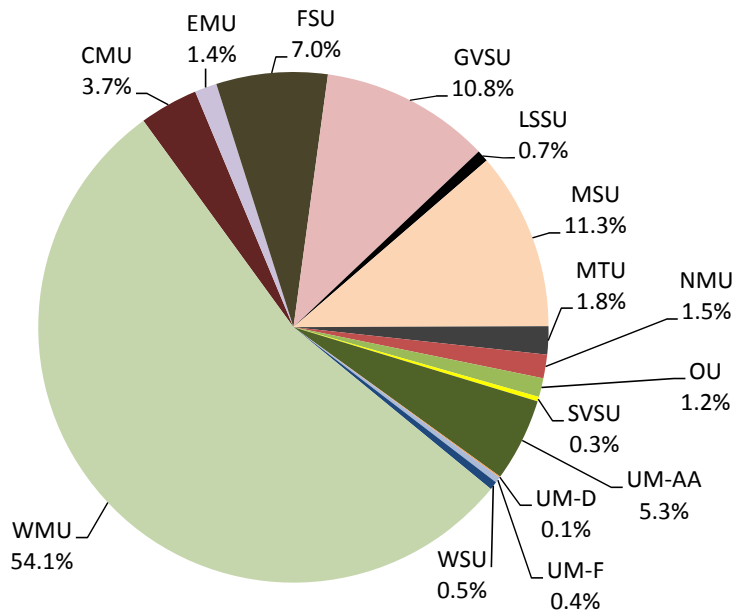

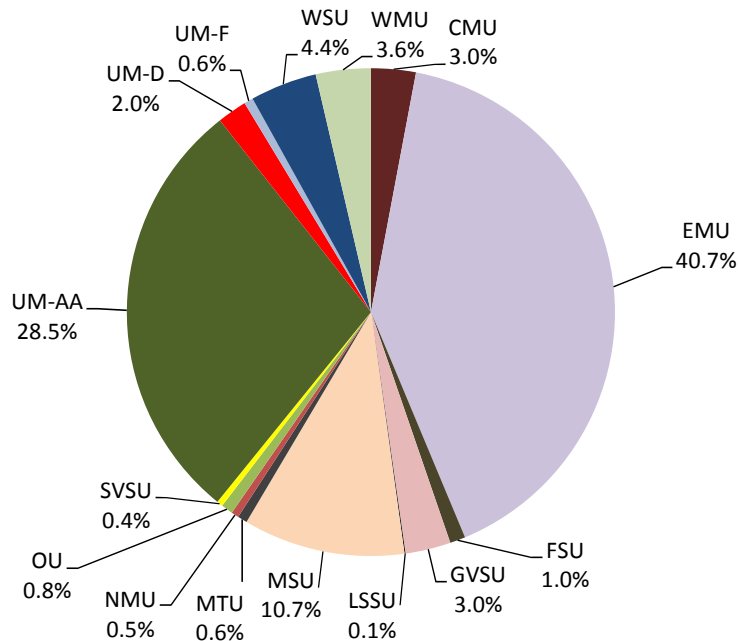

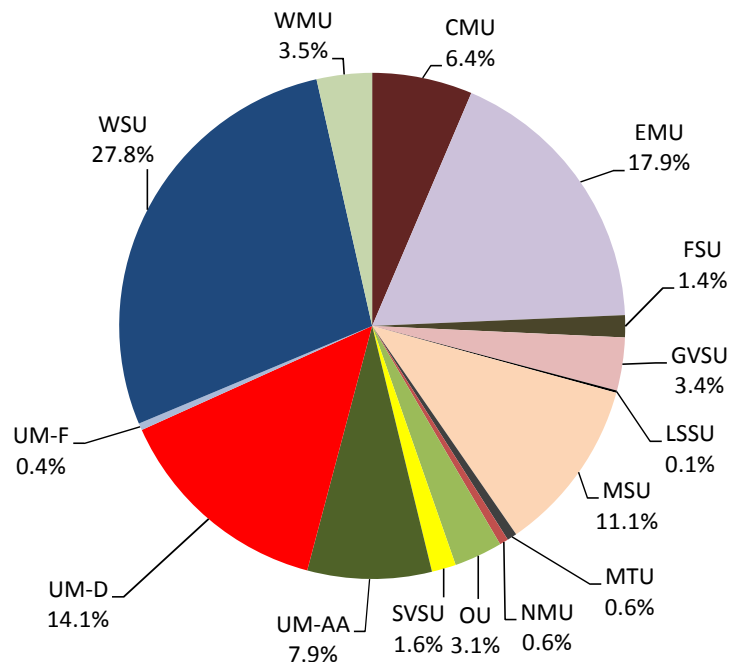

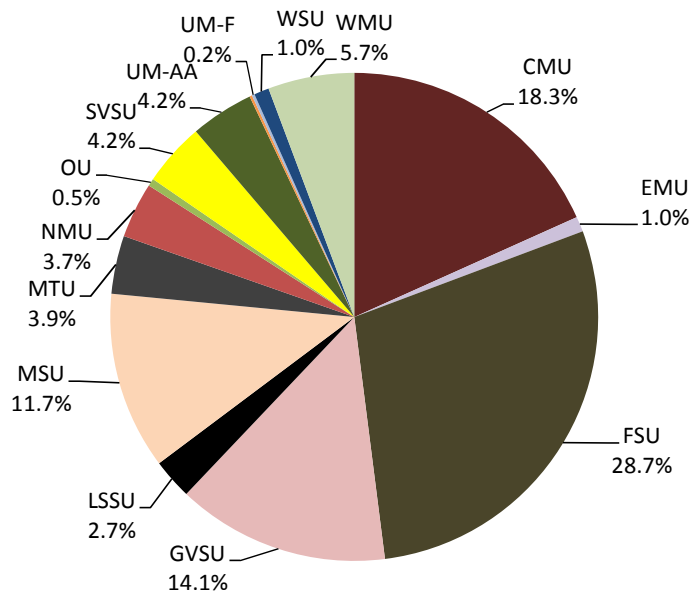

SECTION 3: University Reports

Summary

This section breaks down the enrollment of each individual State university by geographic origin, specifically categorizing all enrollment into three sectors: in-State, out-of-State, and foreign. These three sectors are further broken down into respective geographic locations as the section reports the top 10 counties, states, and countries for enrollment at all 15 State universities.

The introductory section, titled "University Enrollment Overview", shows the overarching enrollment trends from 2008 to 2012. [Table 3.A](#) and [Chart 3.A](#) show the total enrollment in Michigan public universities. The subsequent tables separate the total enrollment into three geographic sectors: [Table 3.B](#) and [Chart 3.B](#) show overall trends in resident enrollment, [Table 3.C](#) and [Chart 3.C](#) show the out-of-State enrollment trends, and [Table 3.D](#) and [Chart 3.D](#) demonstrate total foreign enrollment trends. Since 2008, Michigan has seen an increase in total enrollment in its public universities, as shown by [Chart 3.A](#). Despite this, the majority of State universities reported a decrease in the proportion of in-State enrollment over the last five years, as demonstrated in [Chart 3.B](#). An increase in total foreign and out-of-State enrollment seems to outweigh the decline in in-State enrollment, as depicted in [Chart 3.B](#) and [Chart 3.C](#).

Each individual university report contains the tables, charts, and maps described below.

[Table A](#) breaks down both the headcount total and the percentage of students by in-State, out-of-State, and foreign for each university over the last five years.

[Chart A](#) visually demonstrates the change in enrollment headcount from 2008 to 2012 in each university, as well as the change in enrollment composition from year to year.

The next three tables provide a snapshot of the geographic origins of each of the three enrollment sectors for each university: [Table B](#) gives the top 10 counties of in-State students, [Table C](#) shows the top 10 countries of foreign students, and [Table D](#) gives the top 10 states for out-of-State students.

[Chart B](#) further illustrates the geographic origin of the foreign student population at each university. This chart can provide a better glimpse of the geographic origins of a university's foreign student population, because it accounts for all foreign countries of origin, even those from which the incoming enrollment might be too small to show up in [Table C](#).

[Map 3](#) illustrates the enrollment in a particular university from each county. The shade of each county represents a certain numeric range of students enrolled in the specified university for 2012. The darker the county, the greater the number of students enrolled at the university. If the map range begins at 1, the university has at least a single student enrolled from each county.

Chart 3.A Total Enrollment Over Time

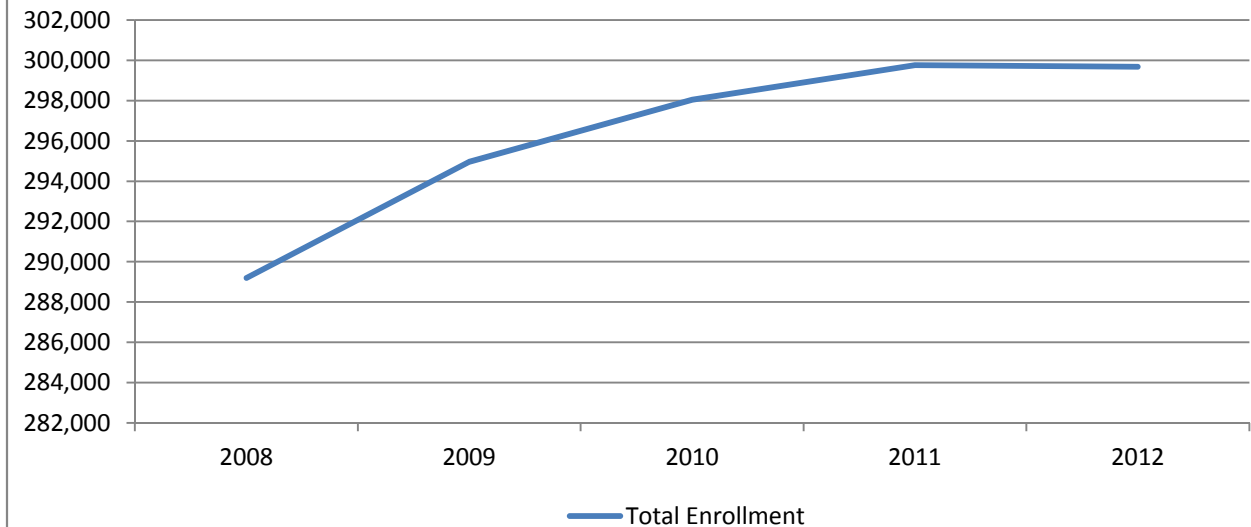
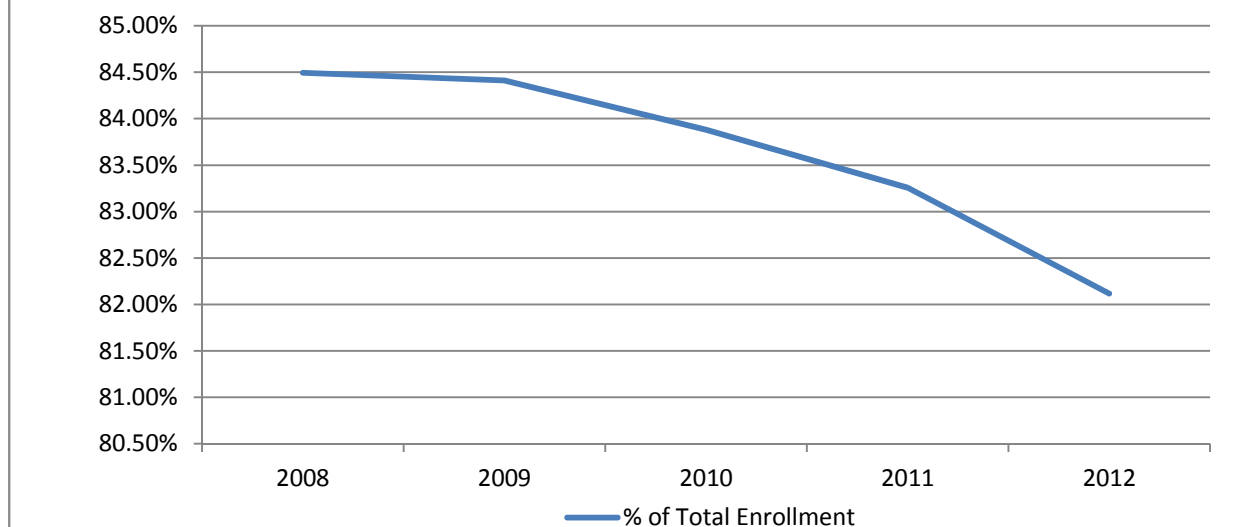

Chart 3.C Percentage of Out-of-State Enrollment Over Time (Domestic)

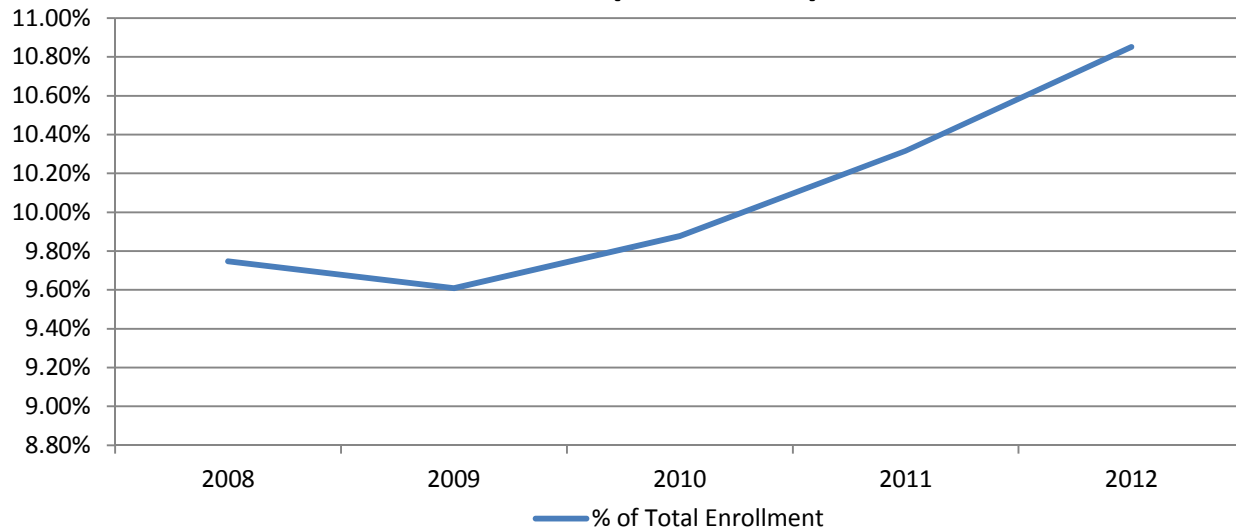
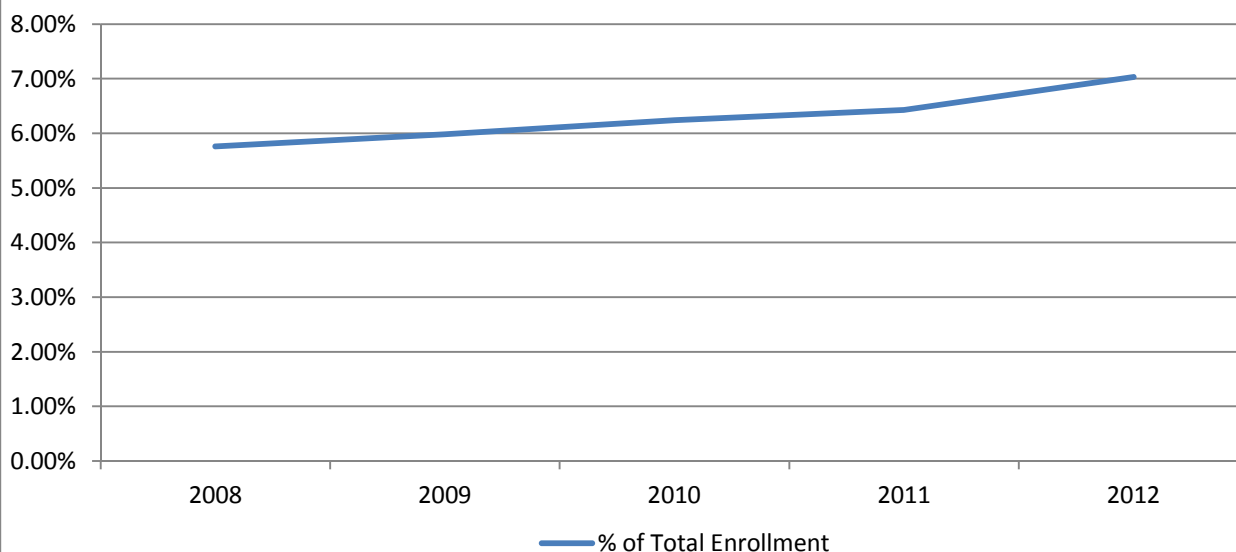

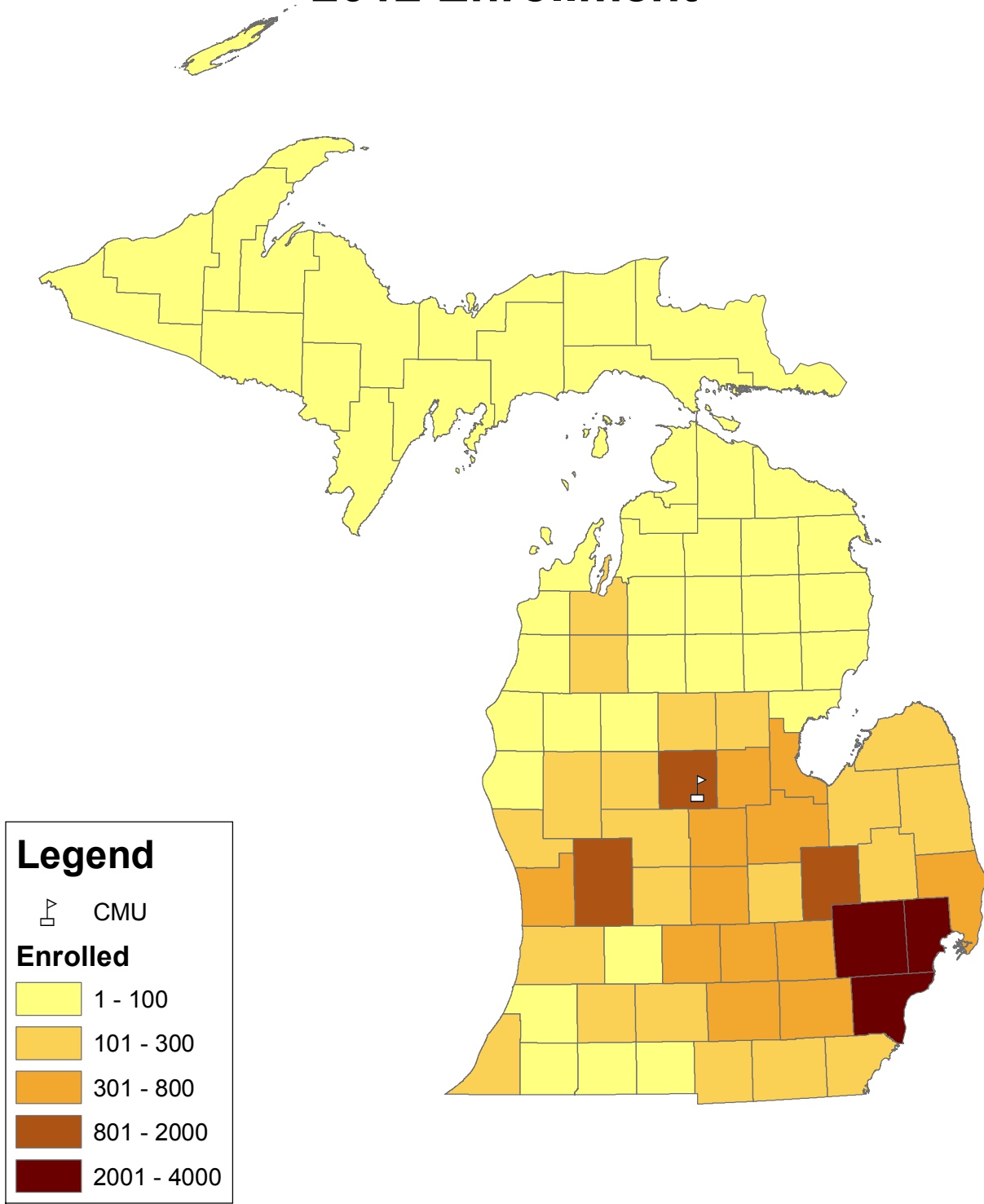

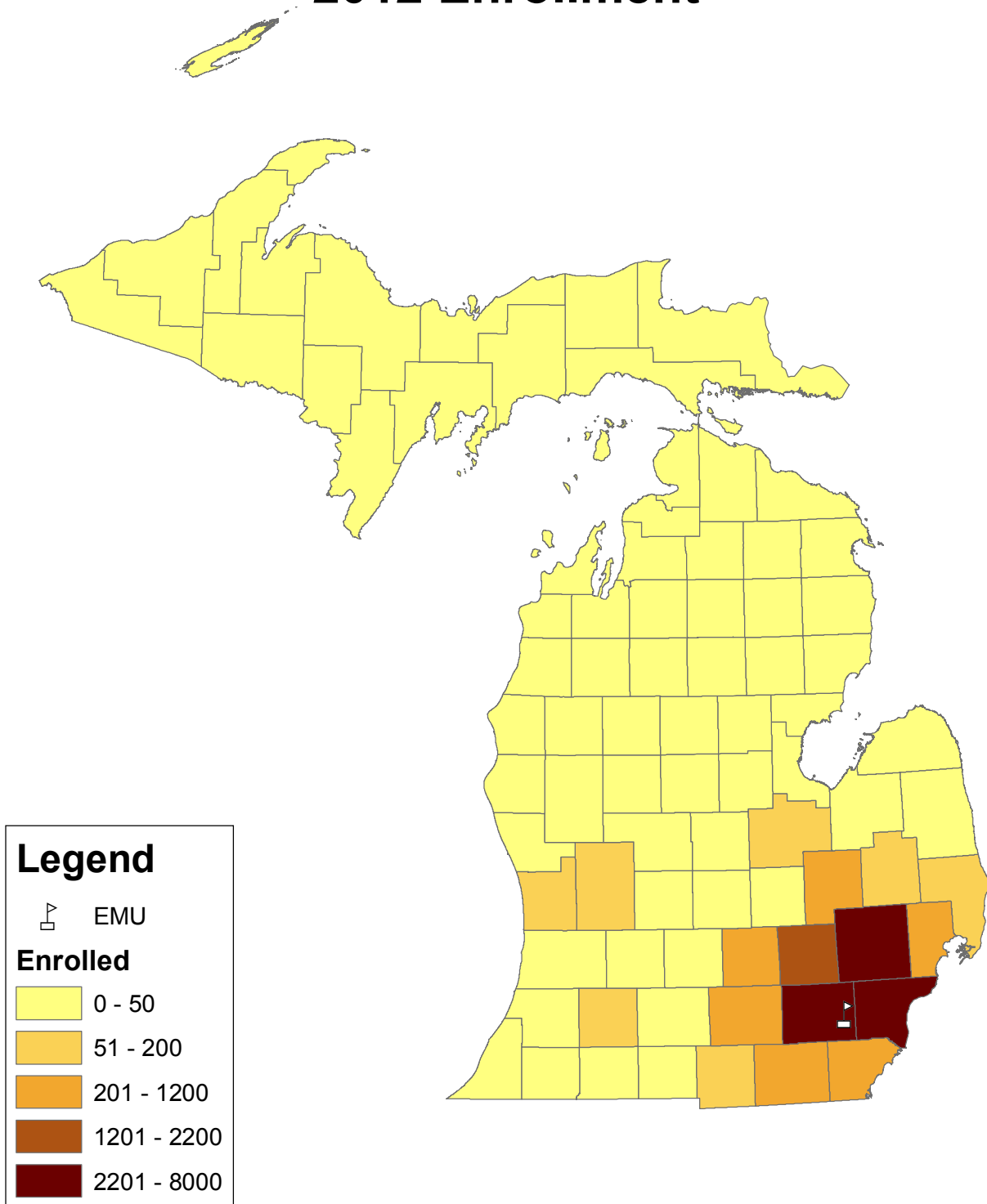

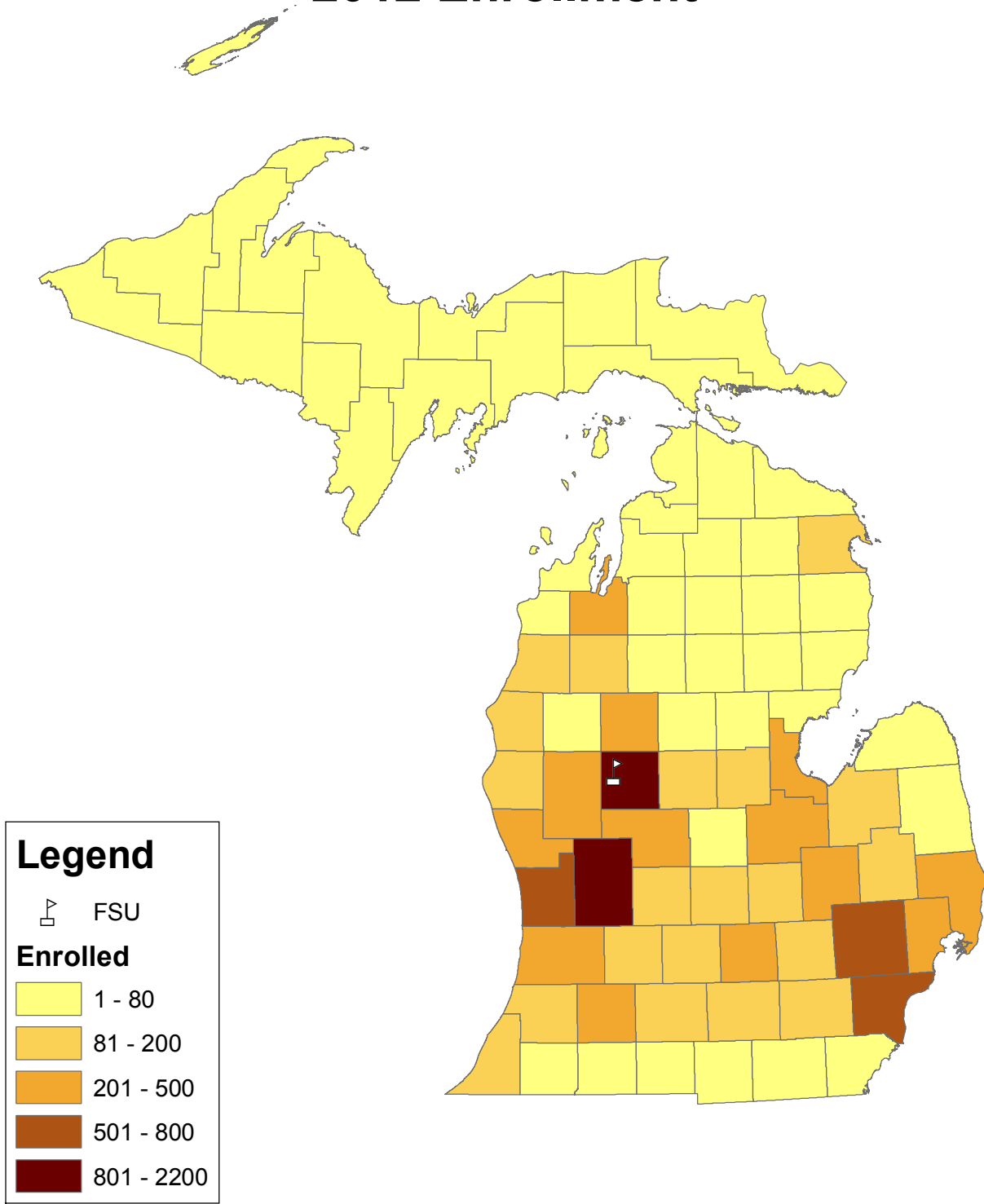

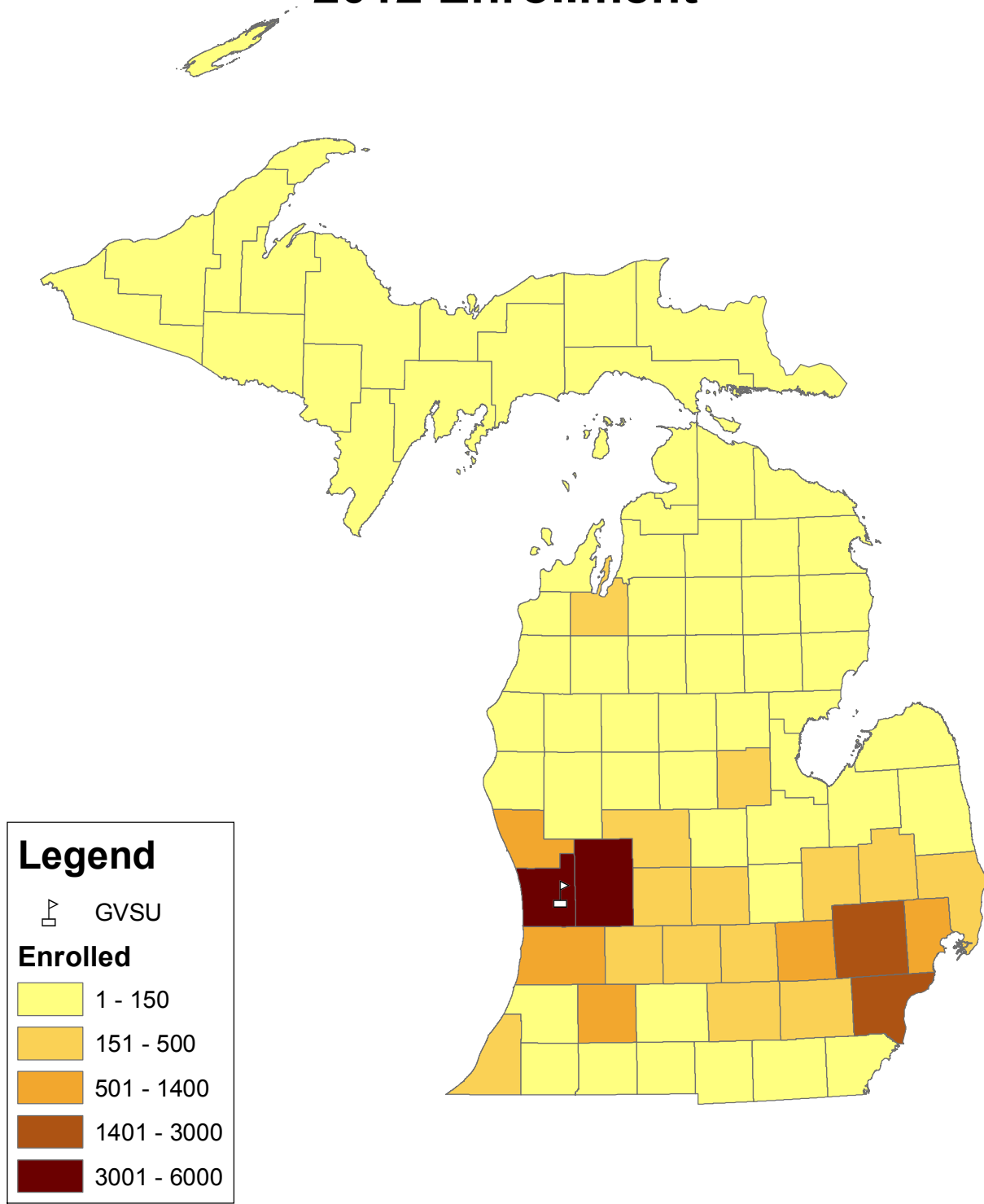

Chart 3.5.A LSSU Enrollment Breakdown

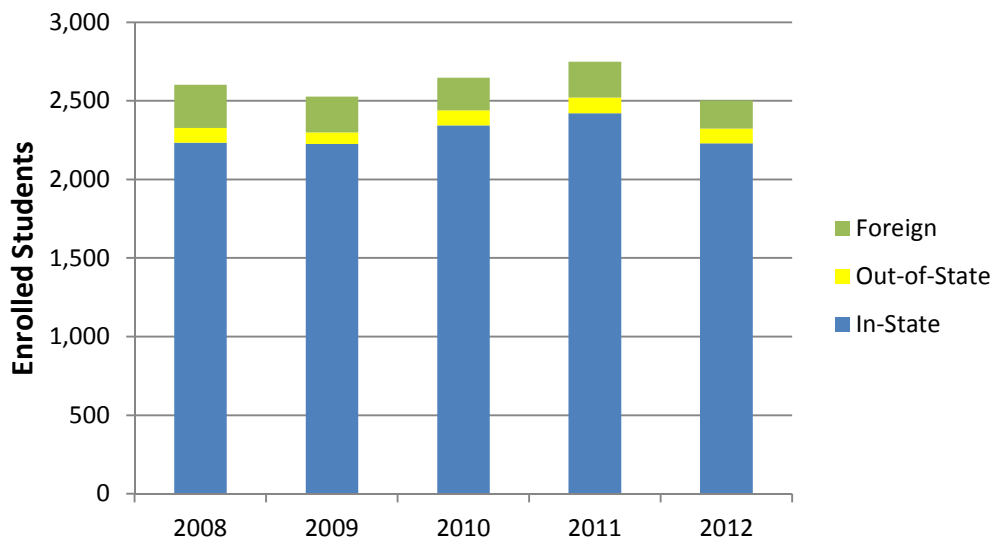

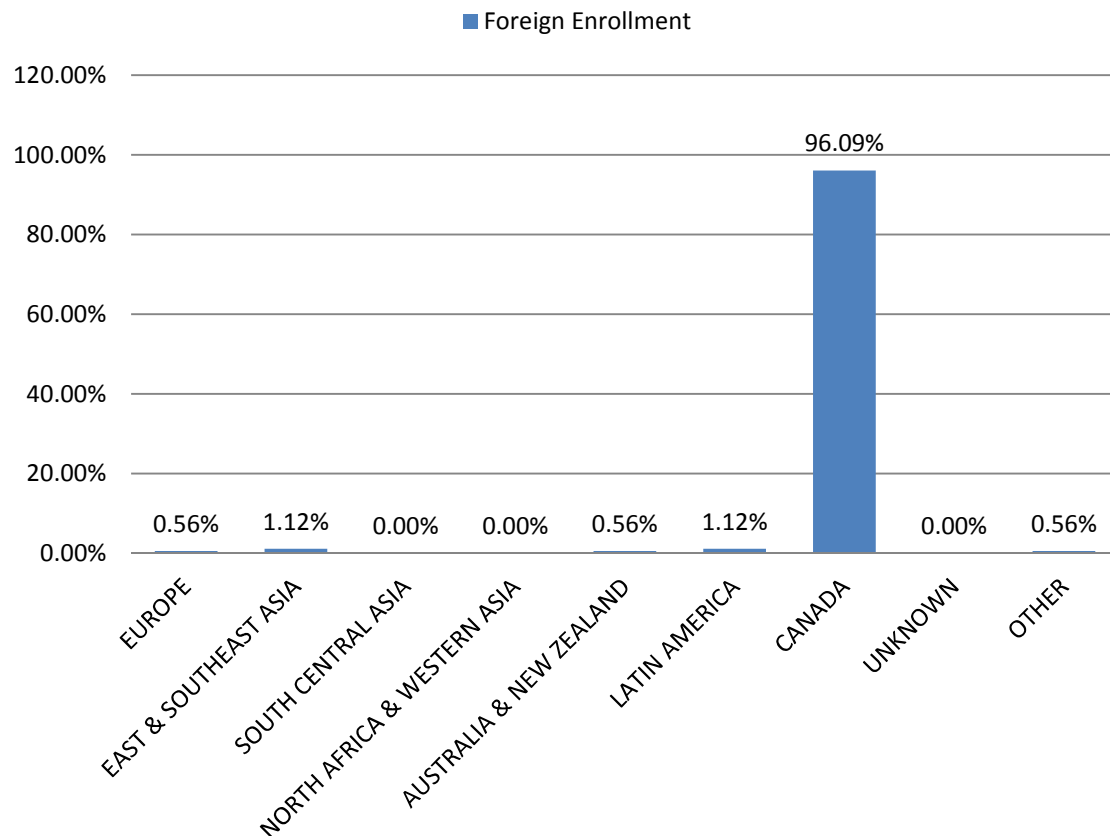

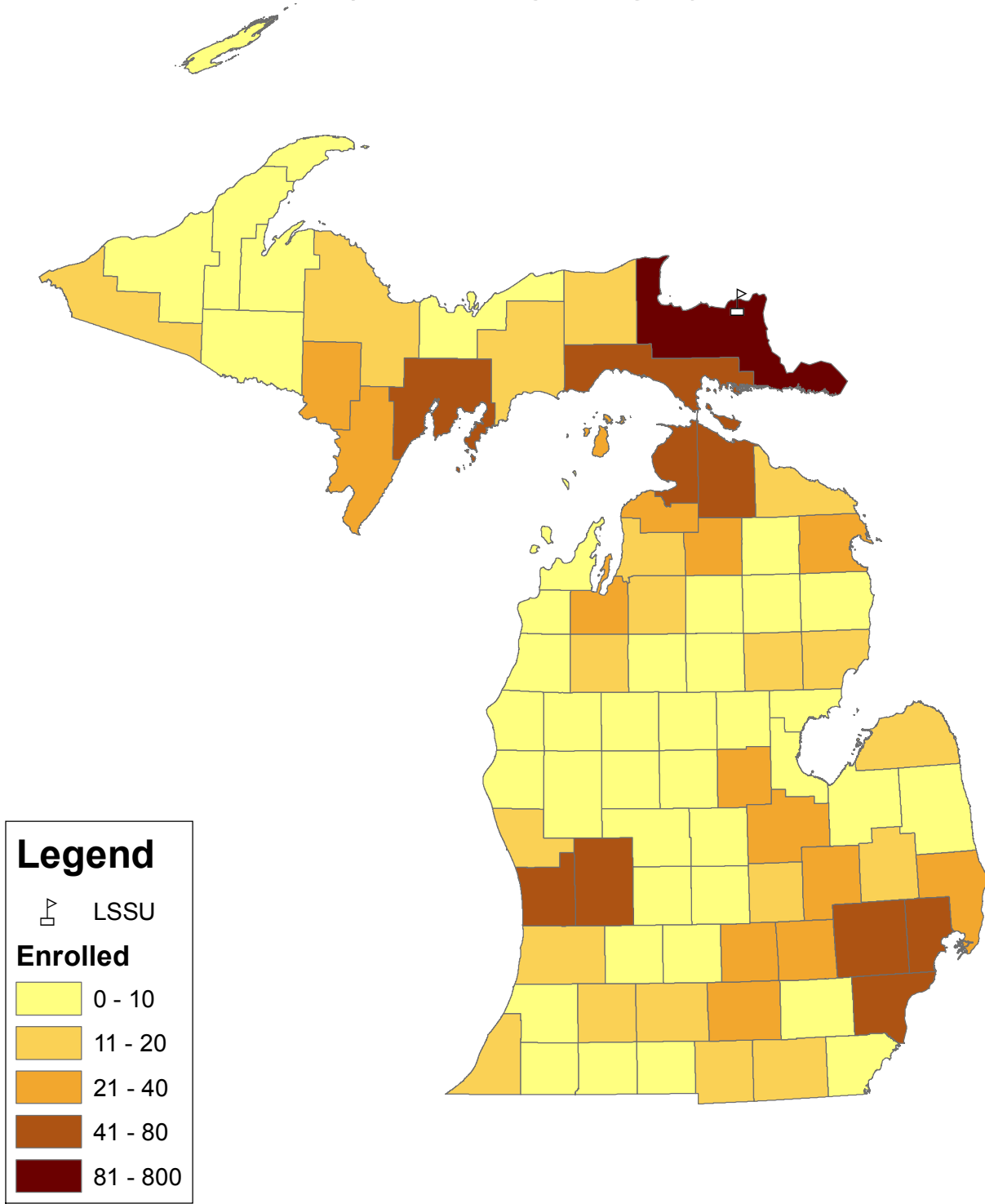

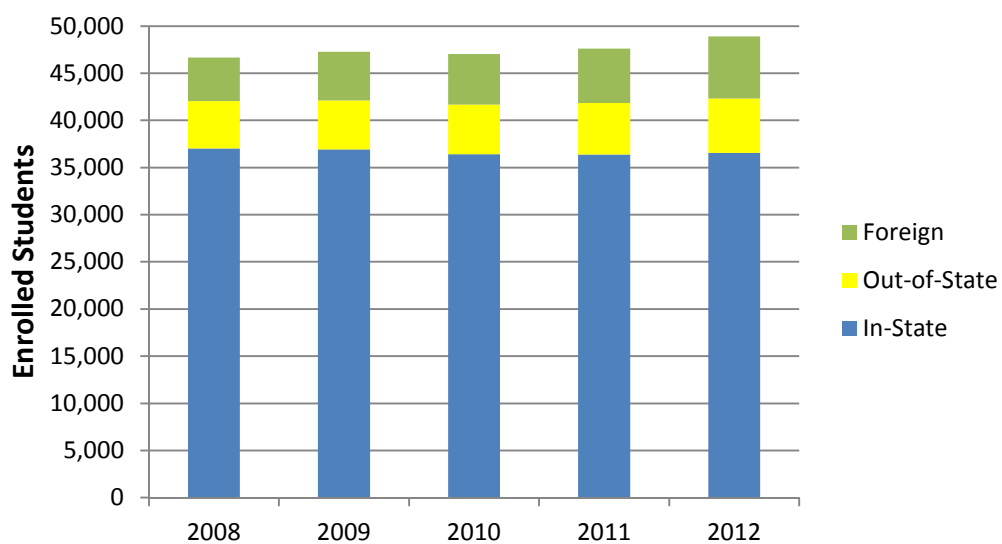

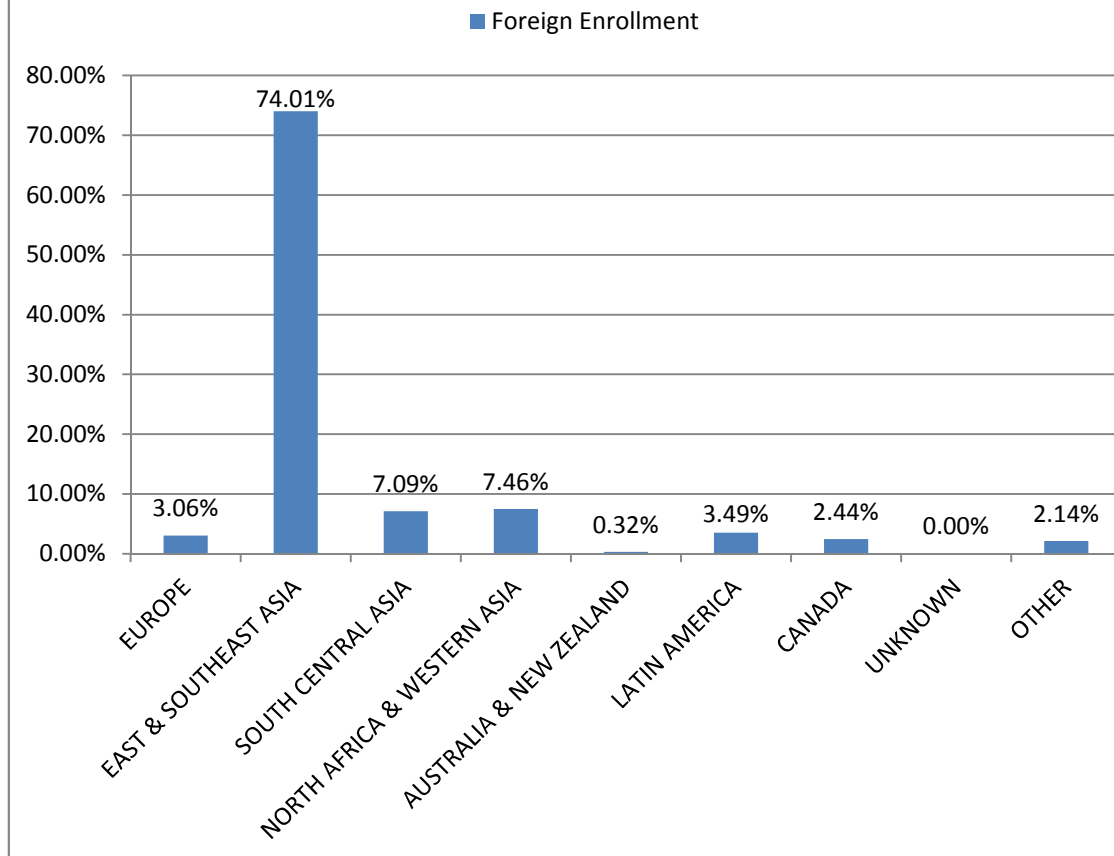

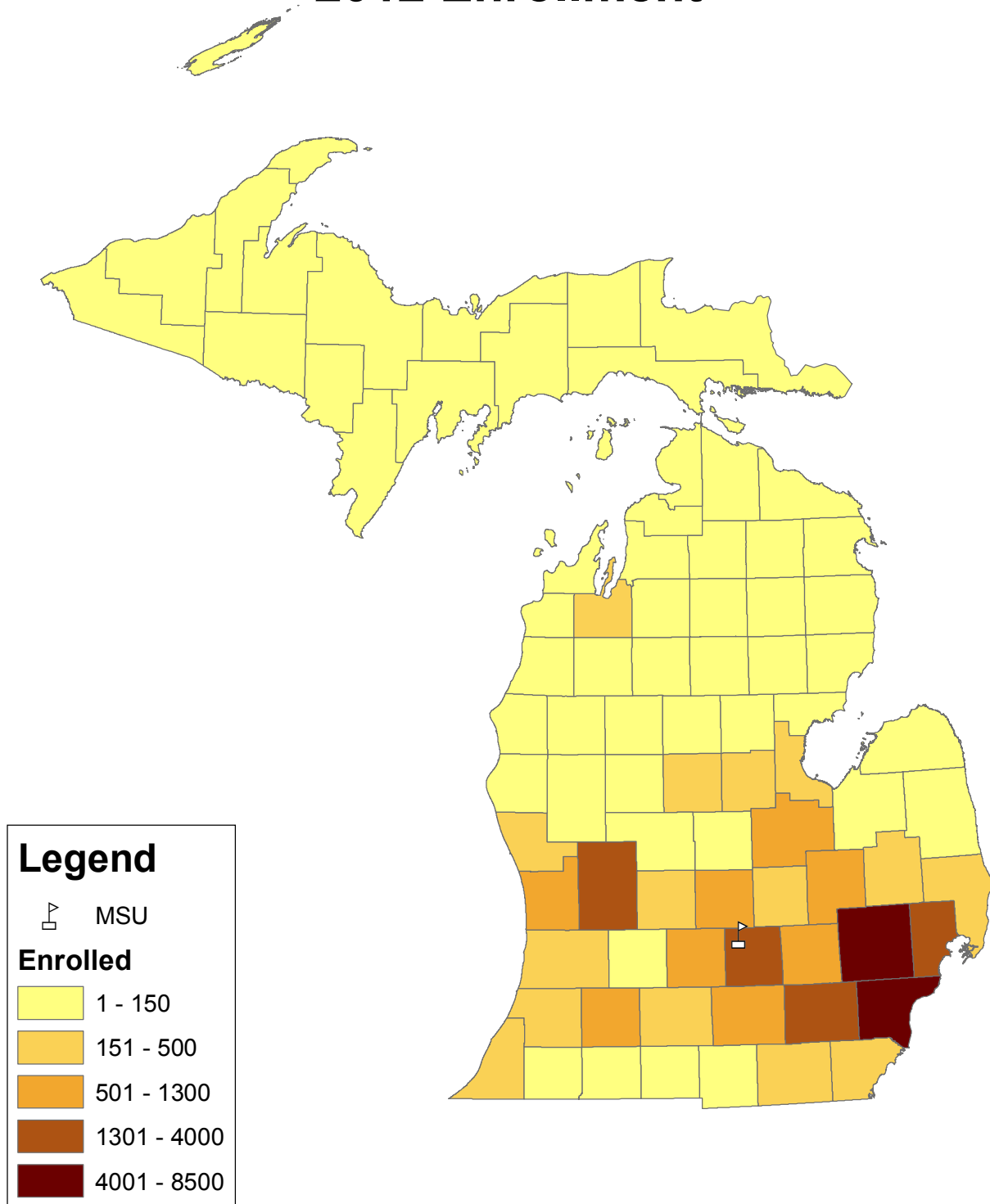

Chart 3.7.A MTU Enrollment Breakdown

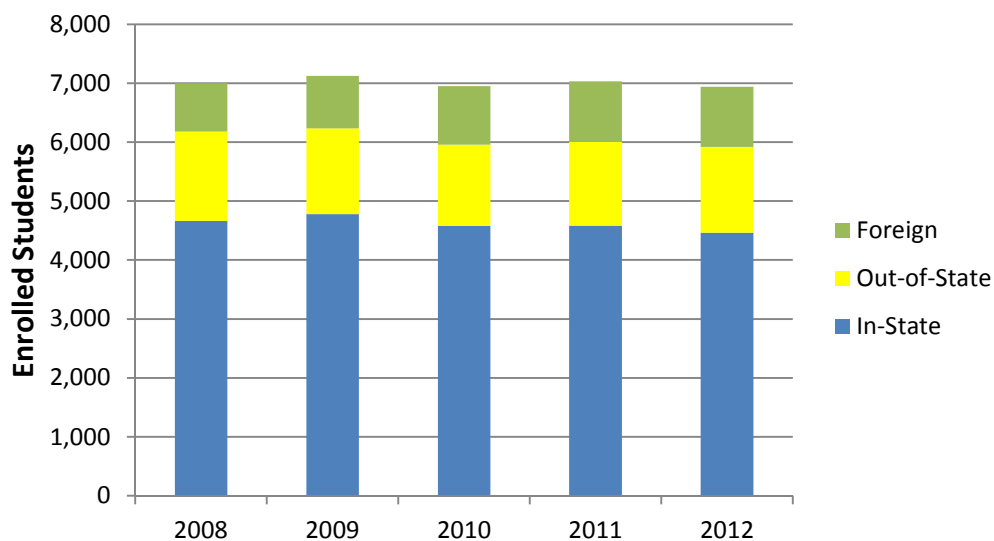

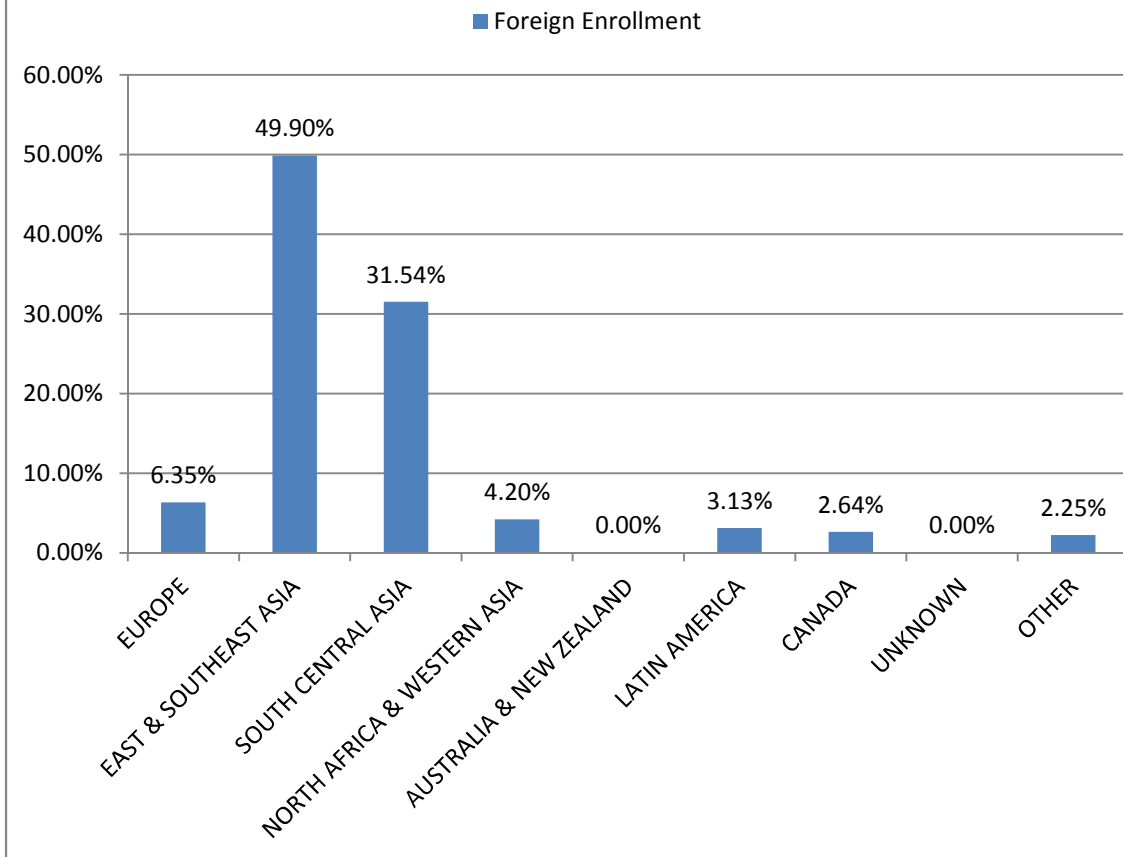

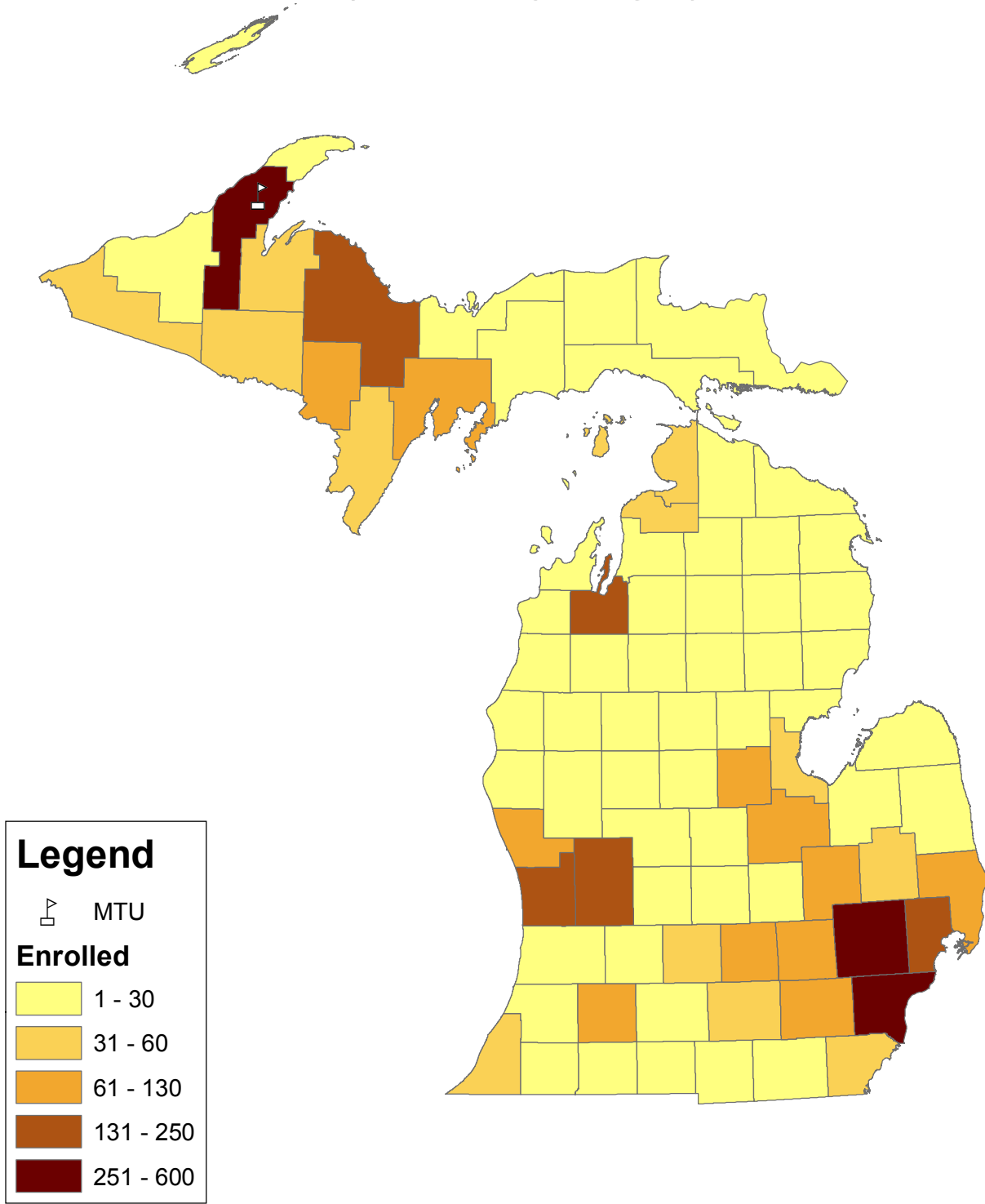
Chart 3.7.B Breakdown of Foreign Enrollment by Geographic Region

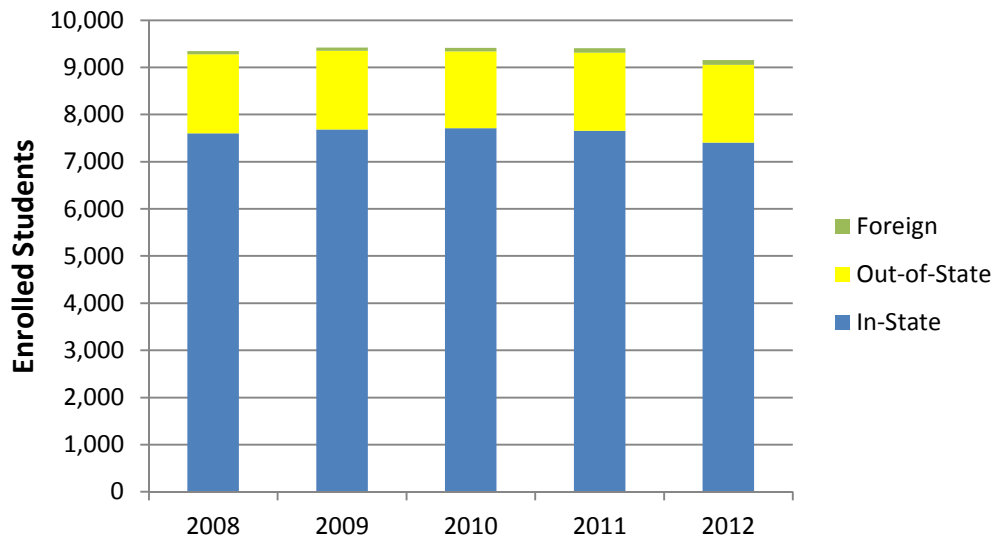

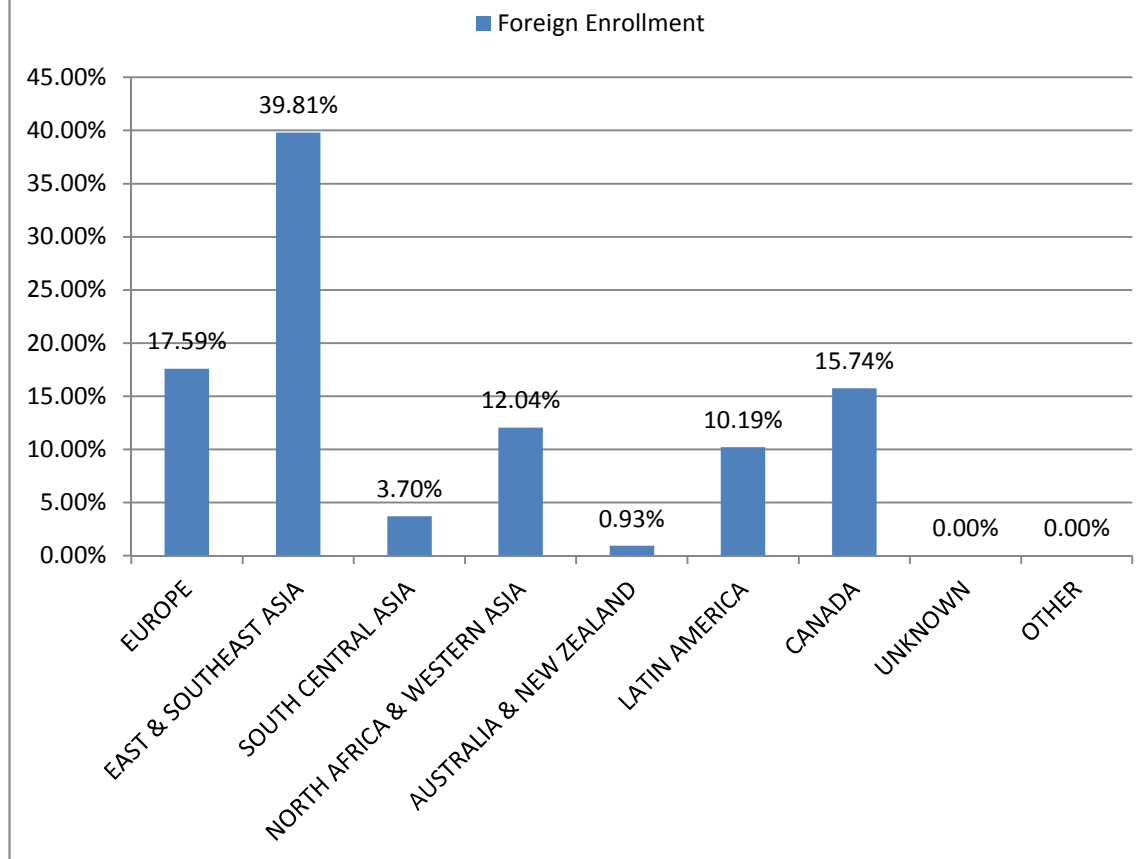

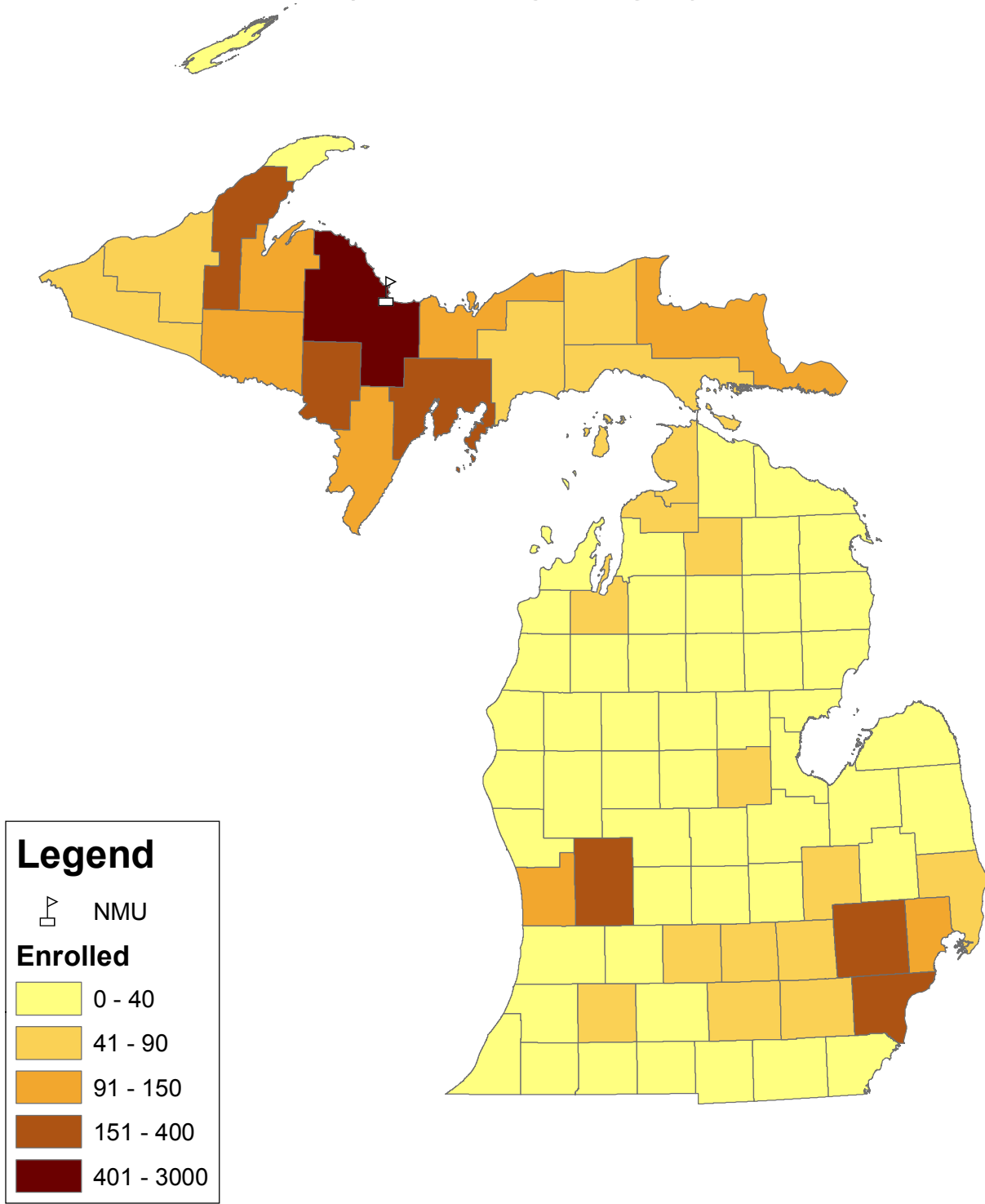

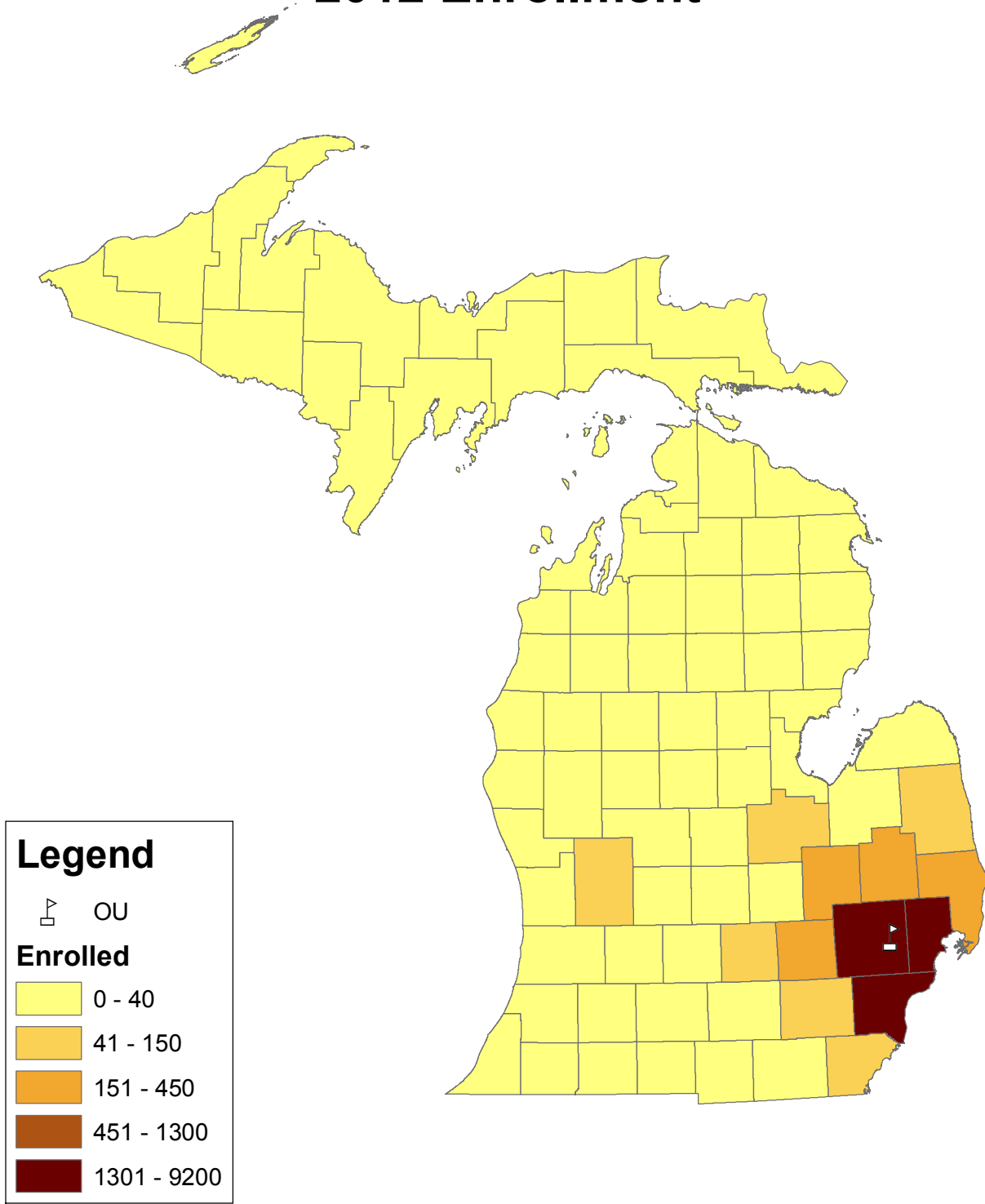

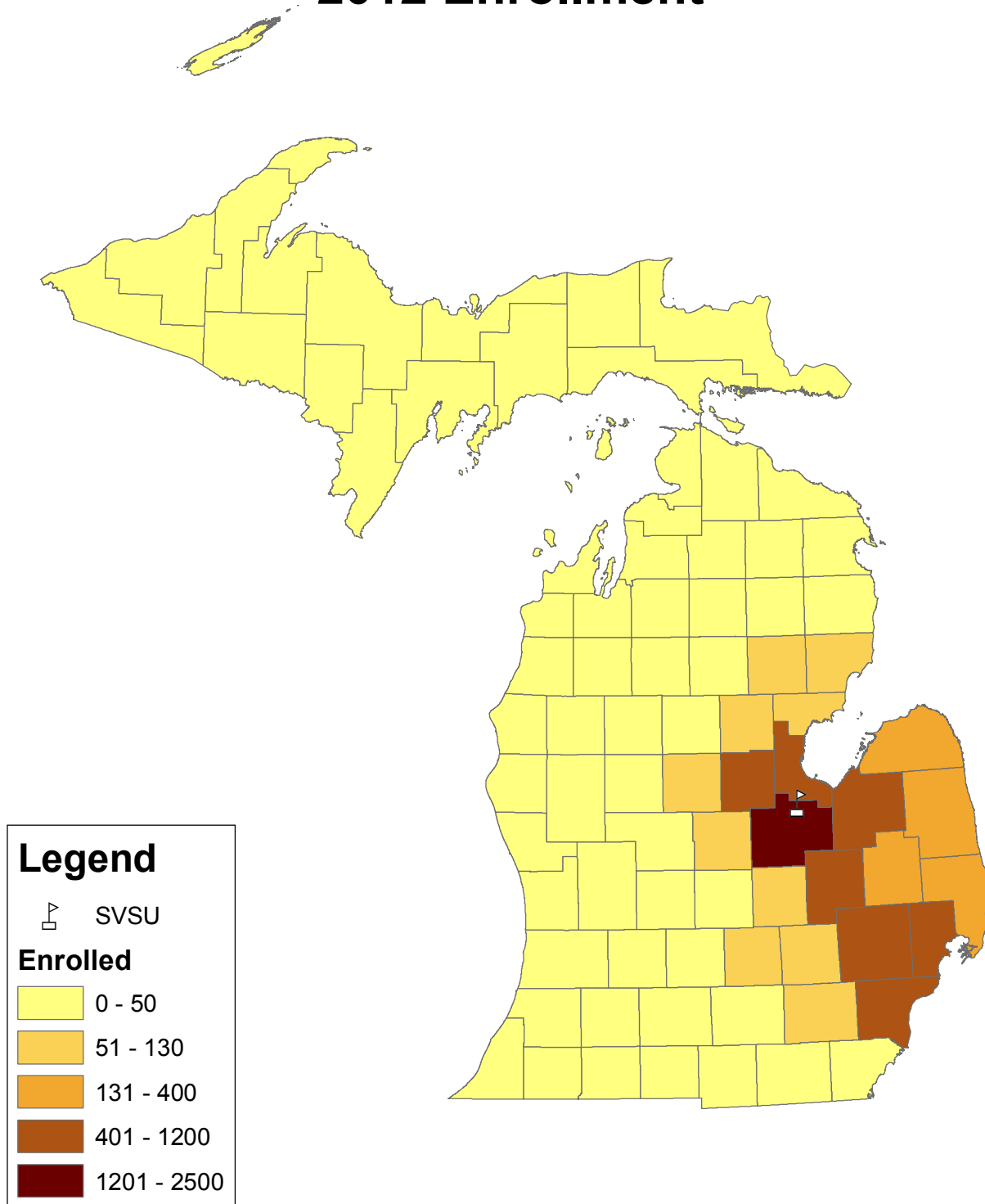

Chart 3.11.A UM-AA Enrollment Breakdown

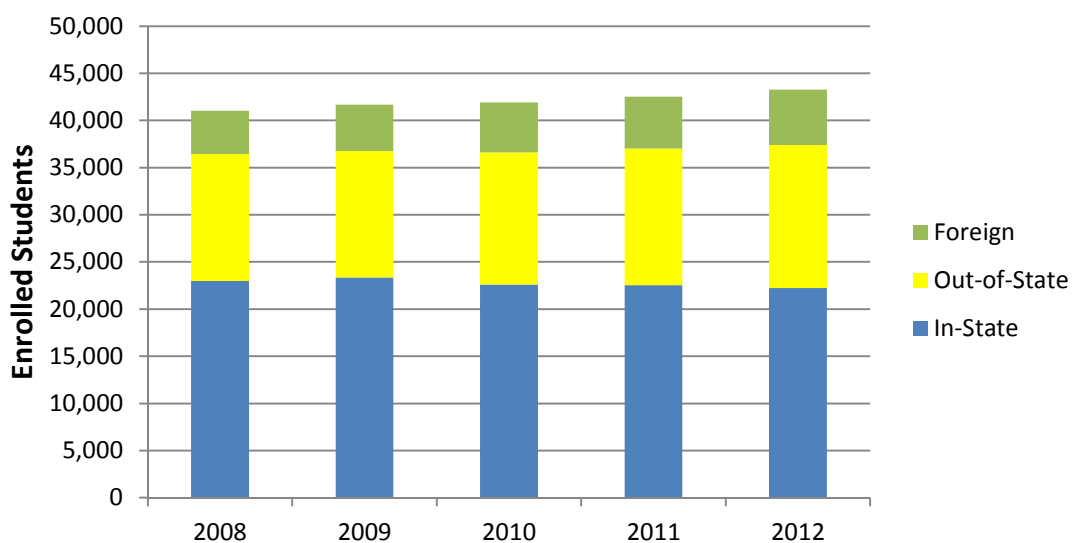

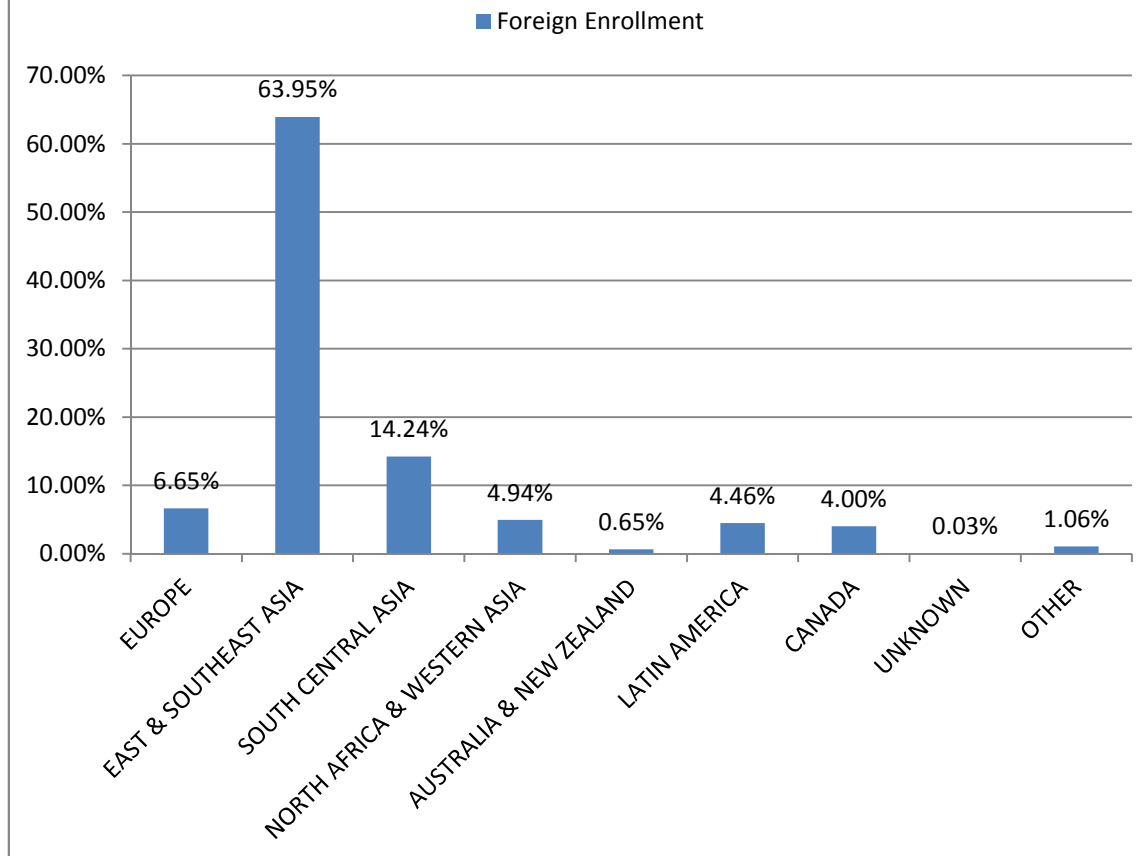

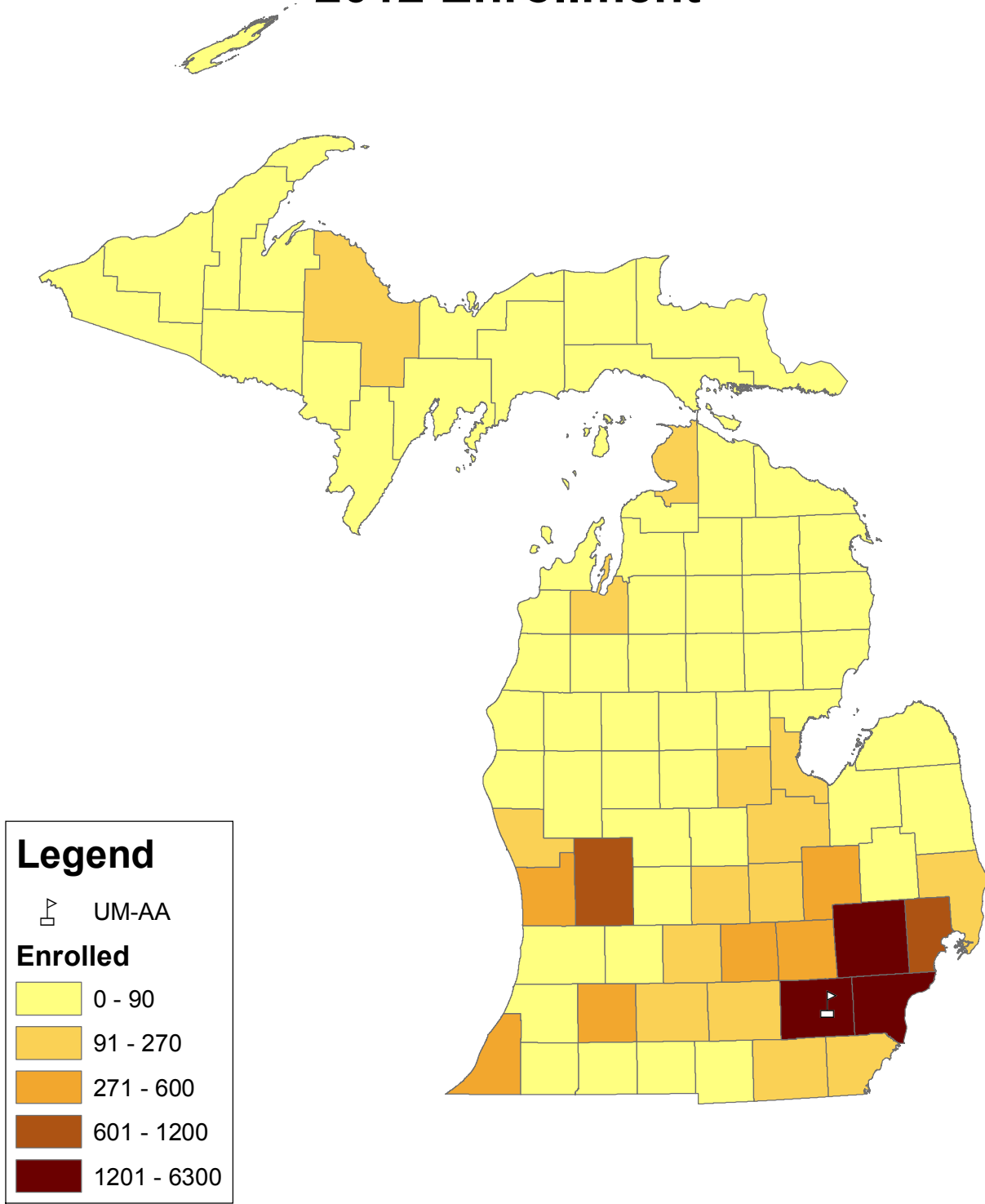
Chart 3.11.B Breakdown of Foreign Enrollment by Geographic Region

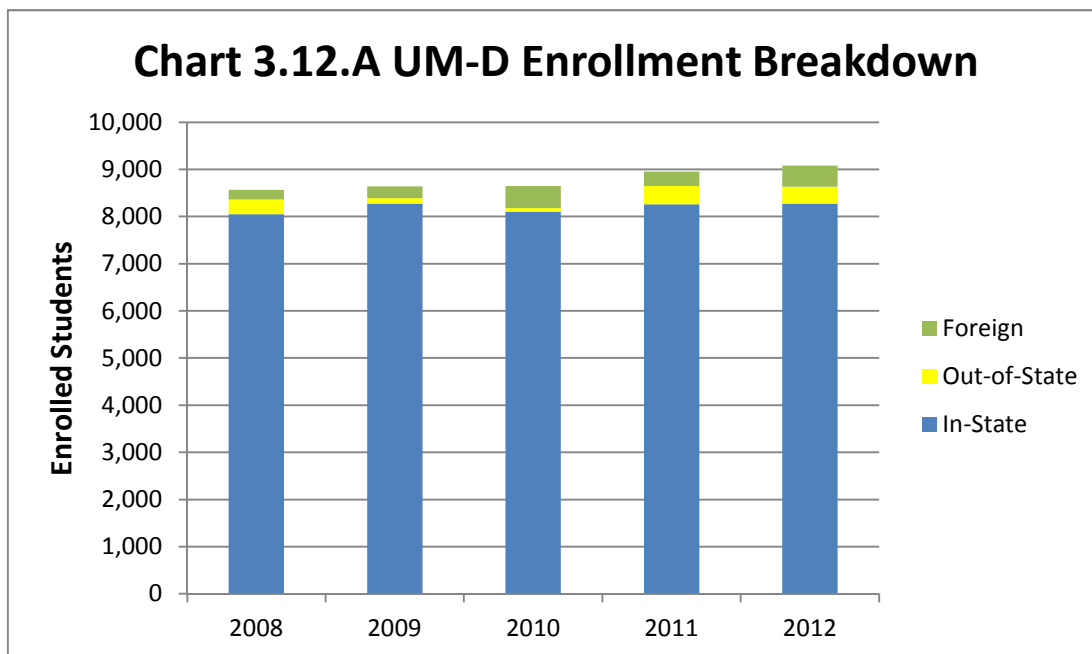

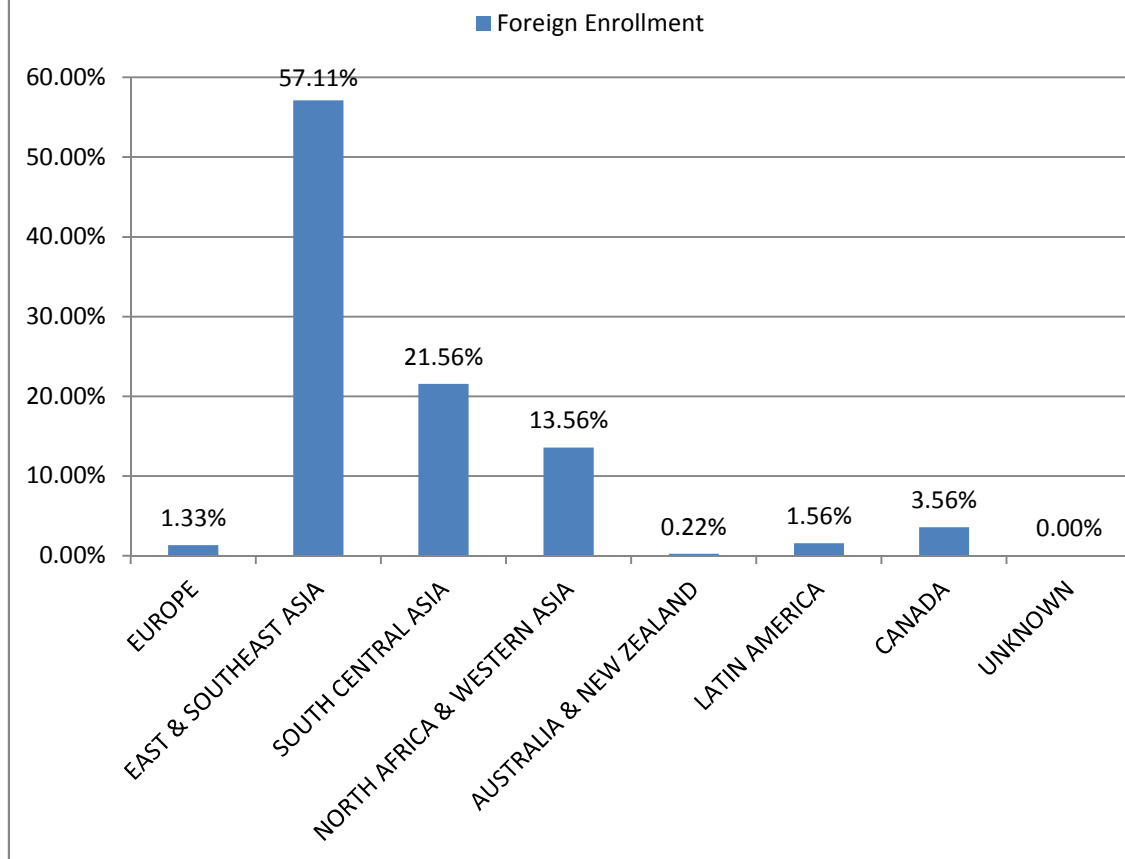

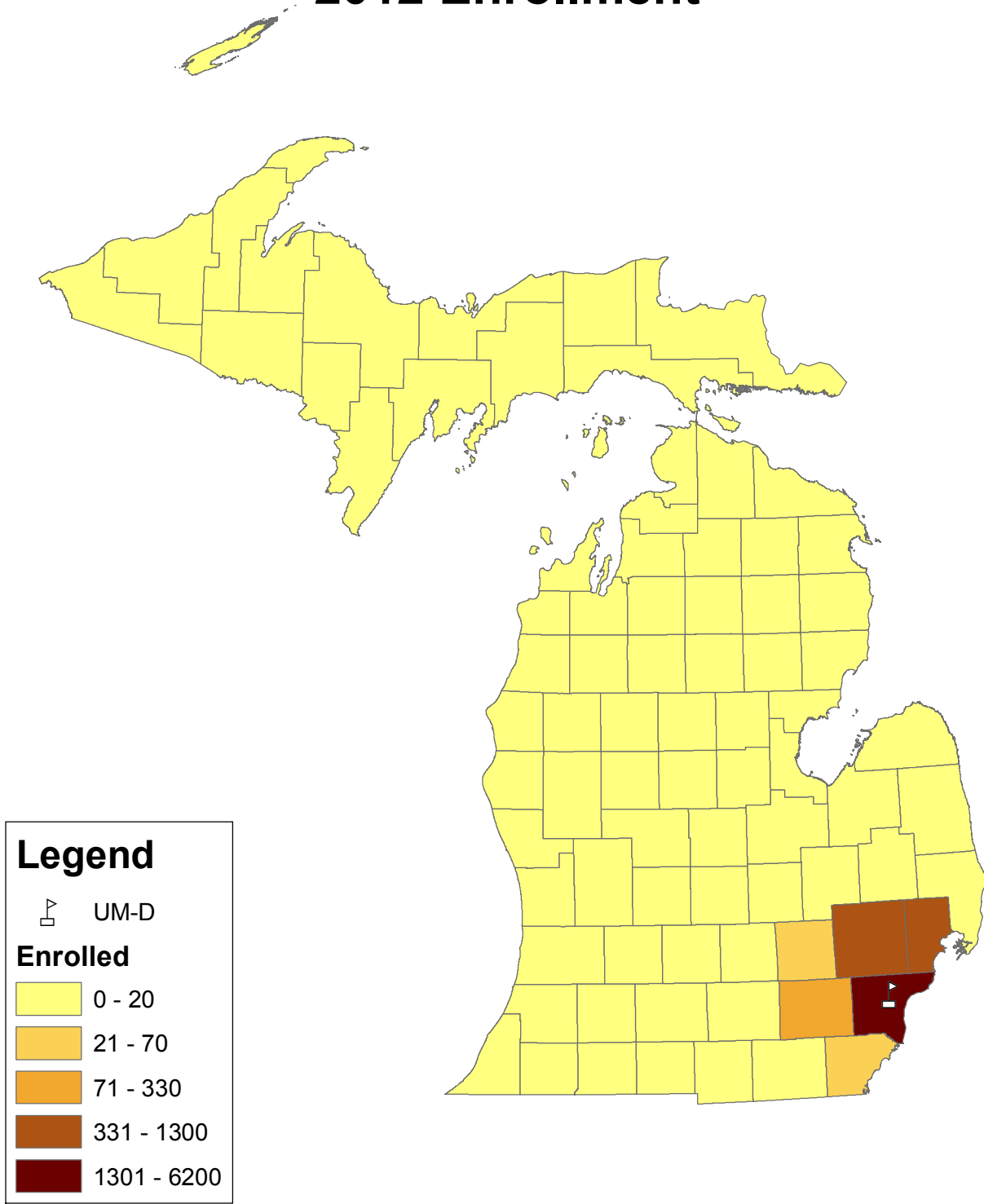
Chart 3.12.B Breakdown of Foreign Enrollment by Geographic Region

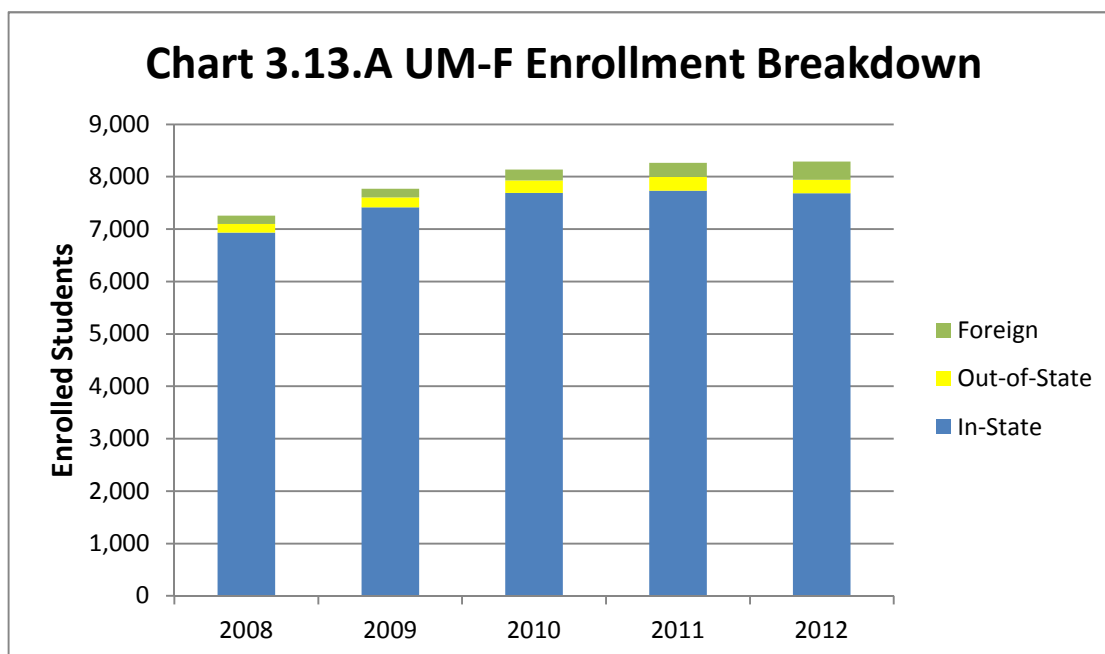

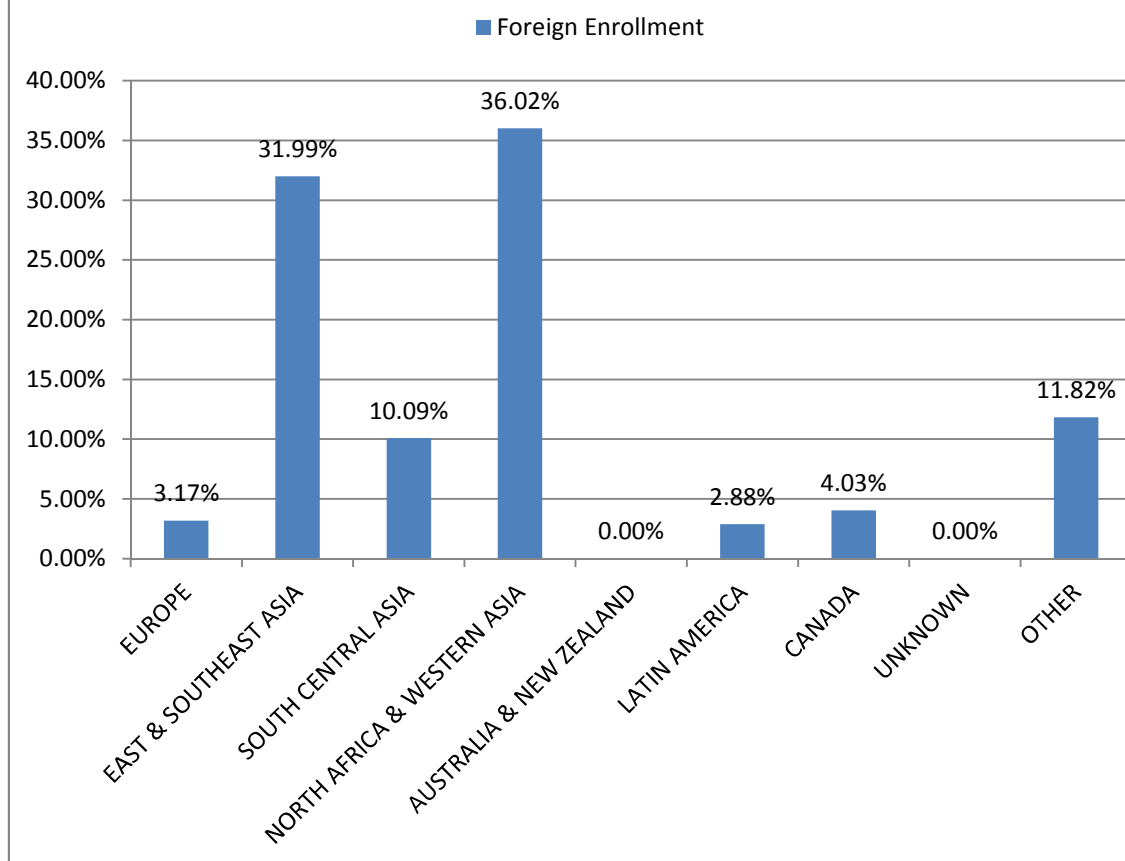

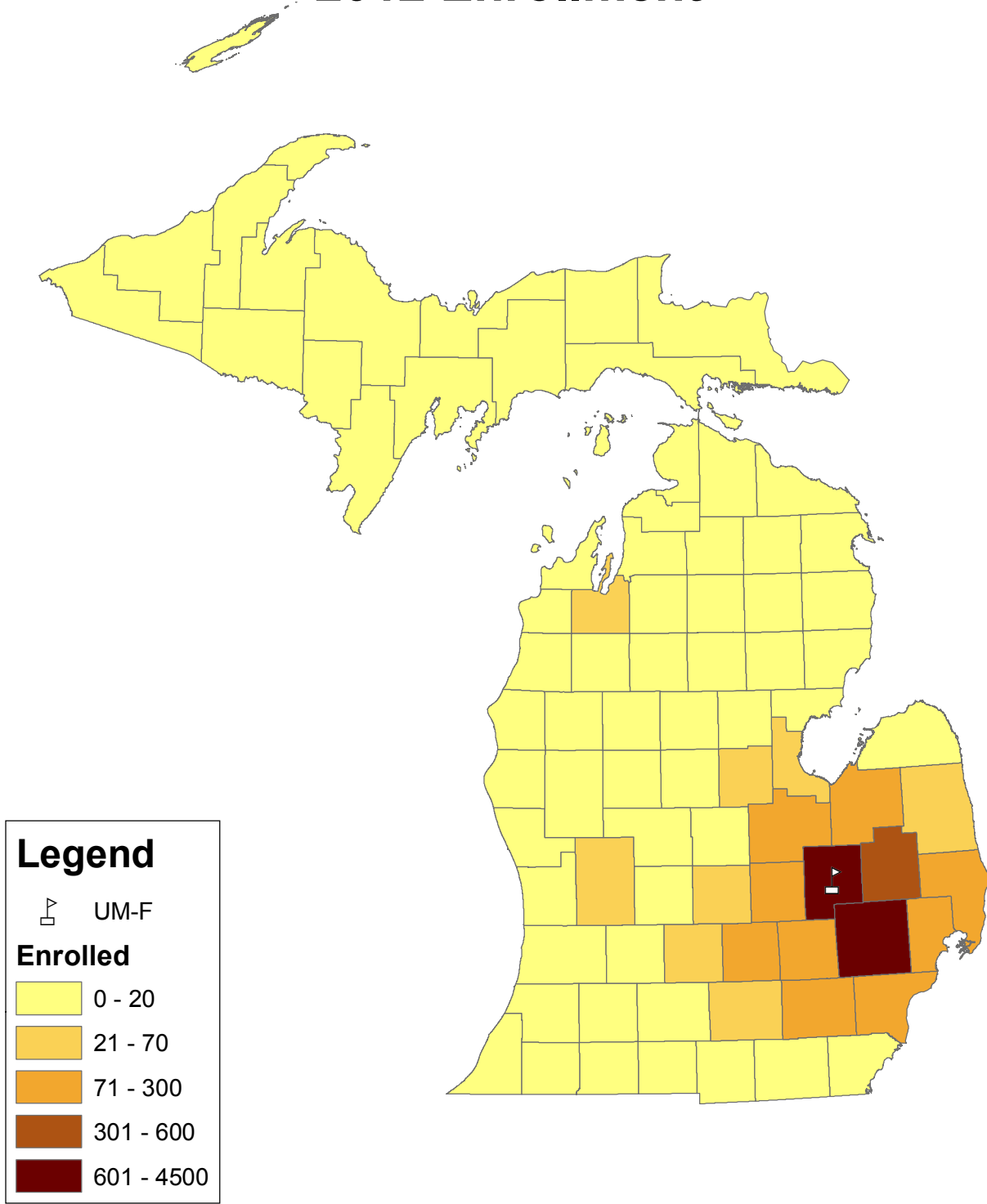

Chart 3.14.A WSU Enrollment Breakdown

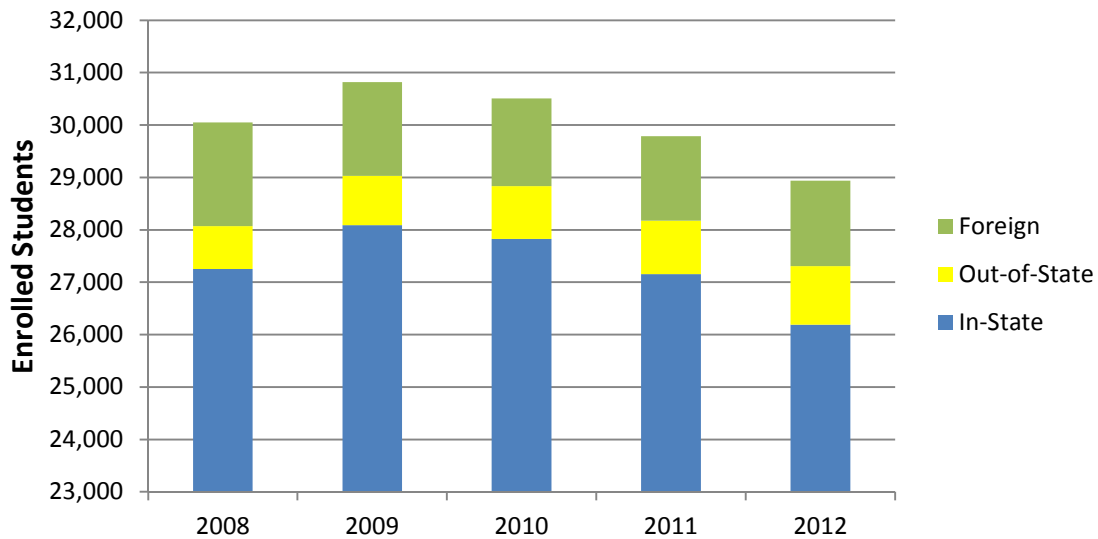

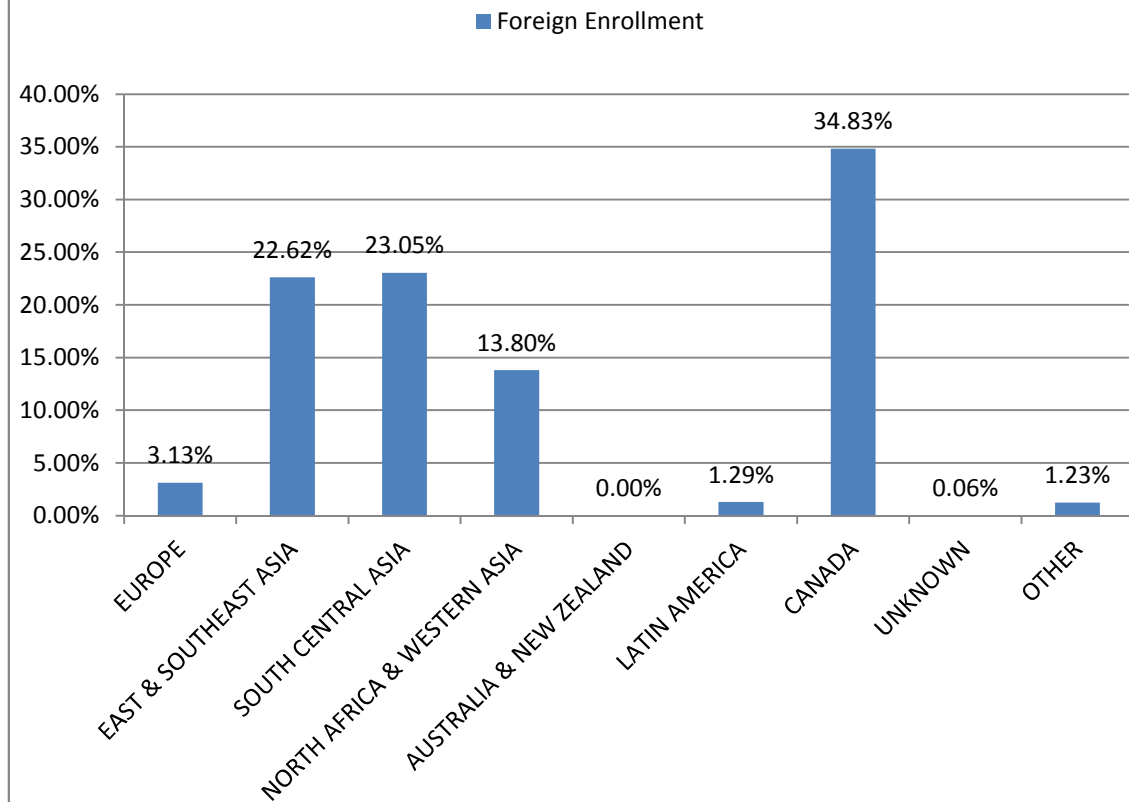

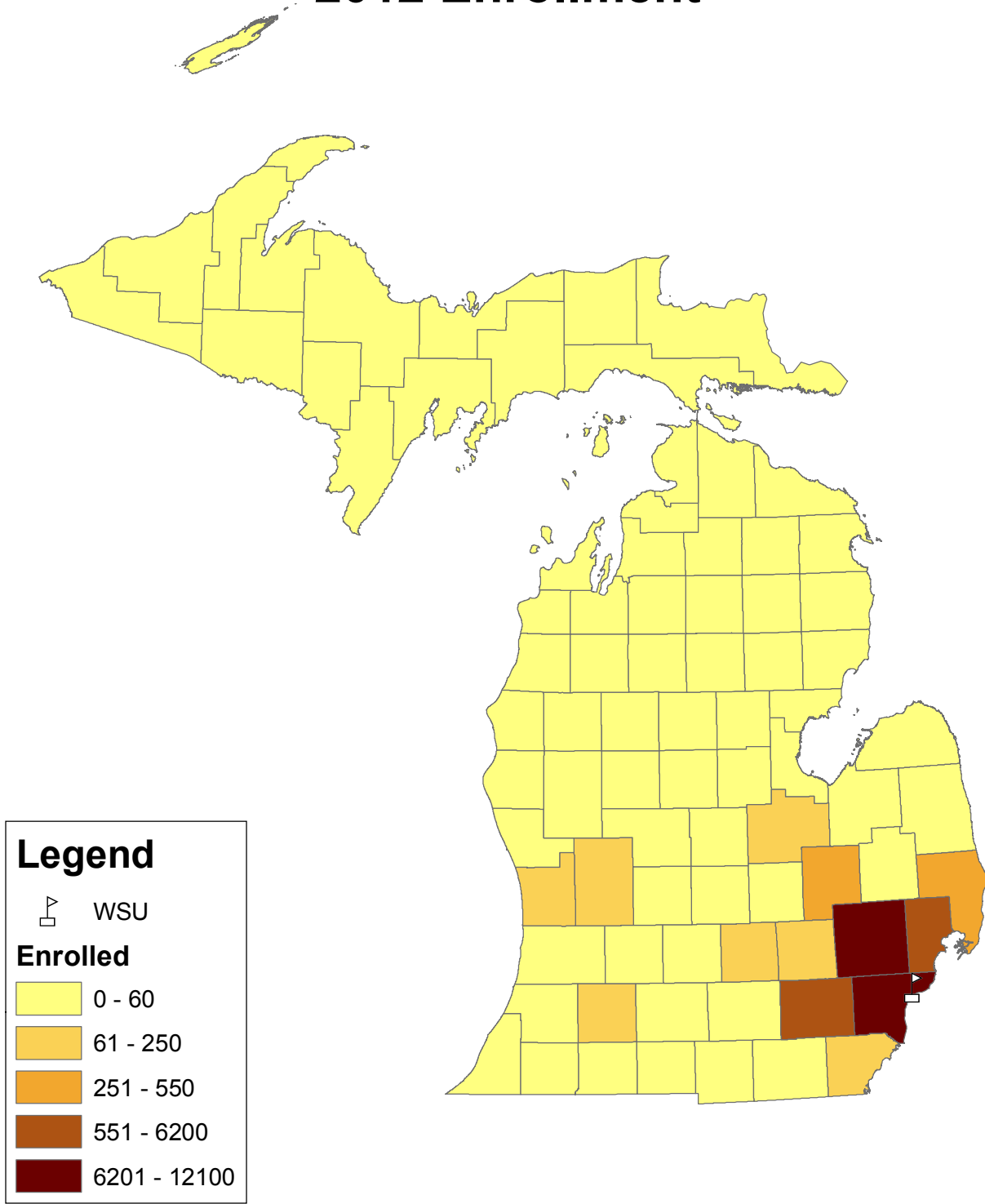
Chart 3.14.B Breakdown of Foreign Enrollment by Geographic Region

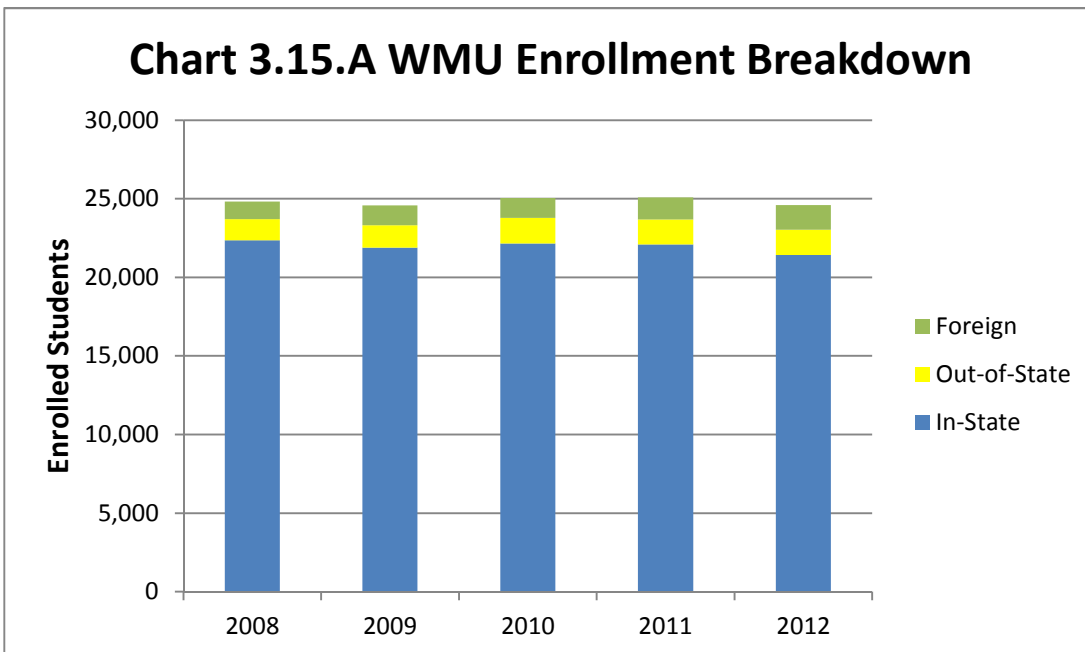

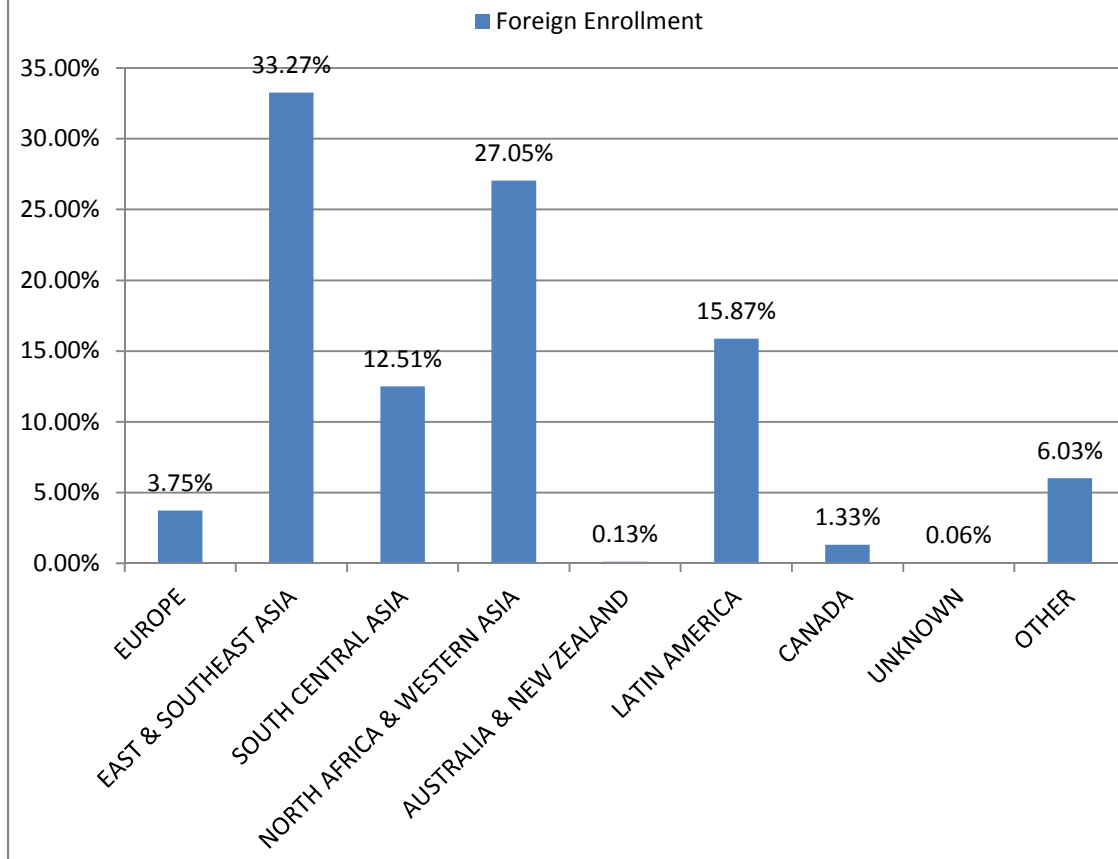

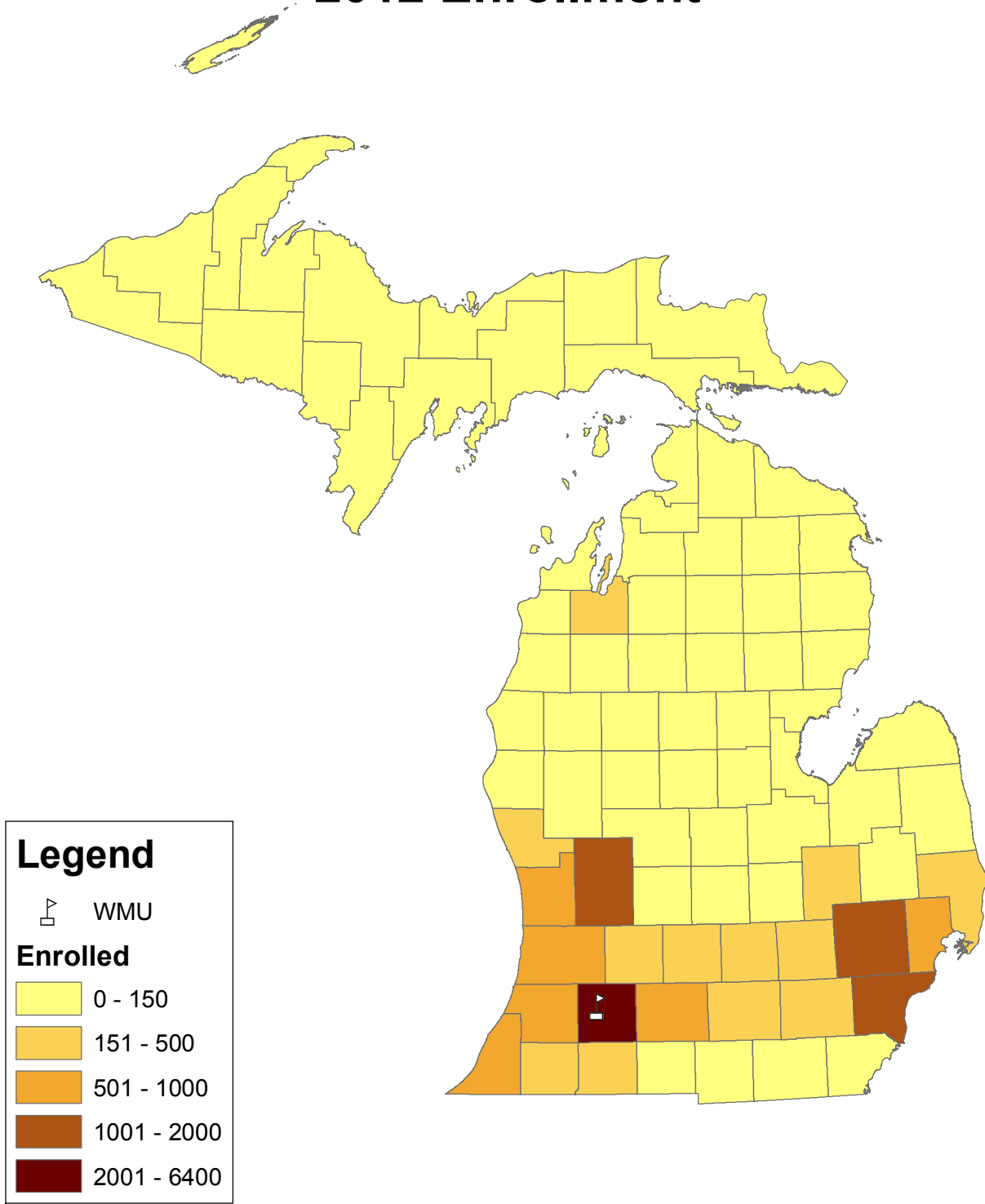

SECTION 4: Foreign Enrollment Spotlight

Summary

This section provides a snapshot of enrollment patterns for the top five foreign countries of origin for Michigan international students: China, India, Saudi Arabia, South Korea, and Canada. The section is organized by ranking; thus, China in [Section 4.1](#) is the number one country of origin for foreign students in Michigan, and so on. As each country demonstrates different enrollment patterns and has a separate and independent relationship with Michigan and the United States, each country spotlight contains an individual summary of the presented data. In fall 2012, students from these five countries constituted 69.09% of all foreign enrollment in Michigan universities.

Each spotlight contains the tables and charts described below.

[Table A](#) breaks down the enrollment from the spotlight country by institution attended for the years 2008 to 2012.

[Chart A](#) takes the data reported in [Table A](#) for 2012 and illustrates in a pie graph the percentage of students from the country attending each State university.

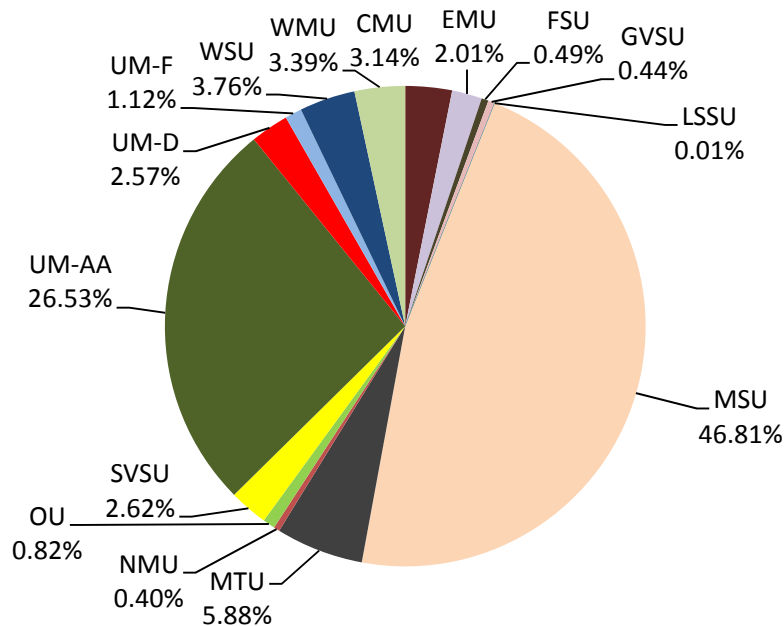
[Chart B](#) presents in a line graph the number of students from that country enrolled in Michigan universities from 2008 to 2012. This chart allows one to visualize the five-year enrollment trend and to quickly compare each selected country to the others.

[Table B](#) shows the percentage of students from the spotlight country enrolled in Michigan public universities compared to the national average, and also shows the rate of change from 2011 to 2012.

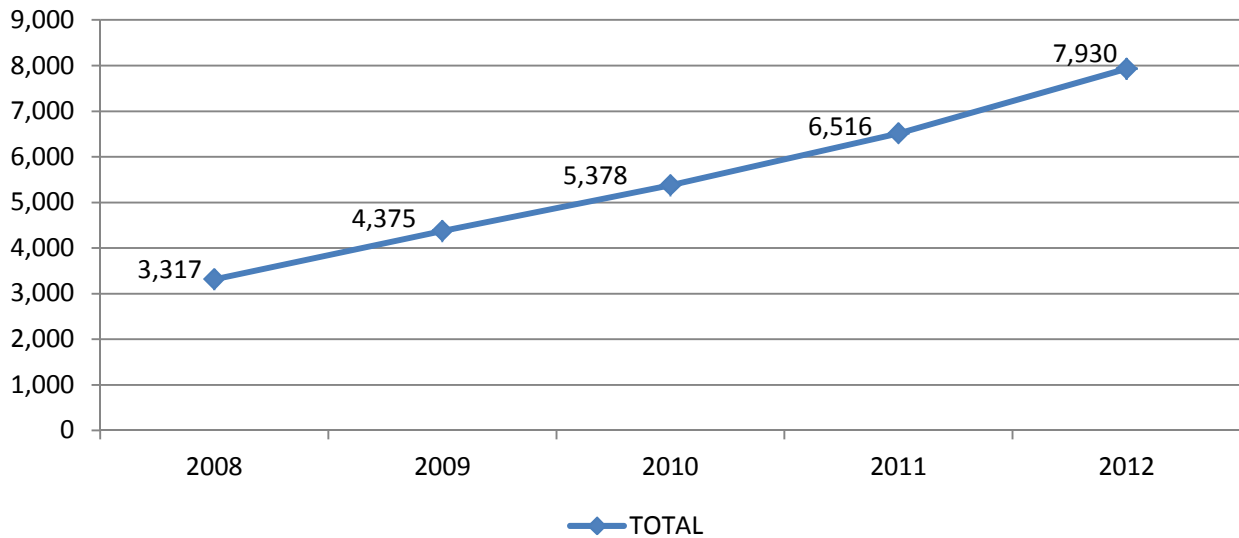

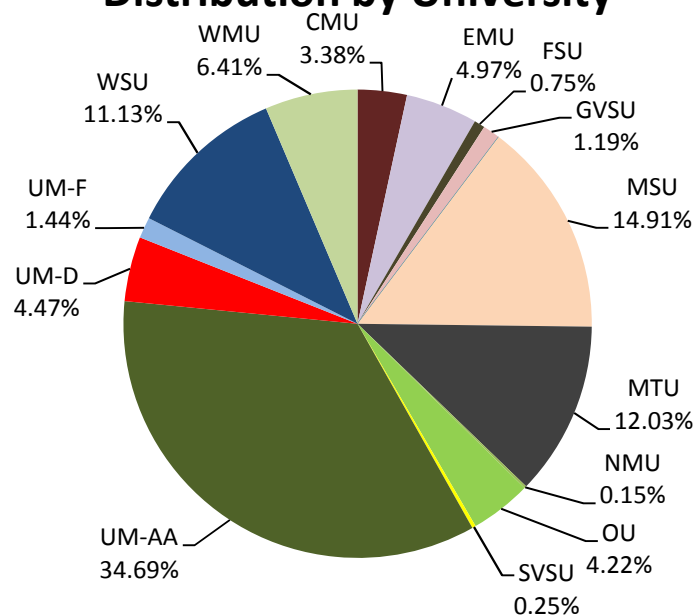

Chinese student enrollment at Michigan public universities has steadily risen since 2008. In 2012, Chinese students accounted for 37.63% of all of the foreign students enrolled in Michigan public universities. As [Table 4.1.A](#) indicates, 14 of Michigan's 15 public universities have seen dramatic increases in Chinese enrollment since 2008. (The exception is LSSU, where there has been a downward trend.) [Chart 4.1.A](#) shows how MSU and UM-AA combine for 73.34% of Michigan universities' total Chinese enrollment. [Table 4.1.B](#) reveals that Michigan's percentage of Chinese student enrollment was higher than the national trend, and that there was a significant increase in Chinese student enrollment on the Michigan and national levels from 2011 to 2012.

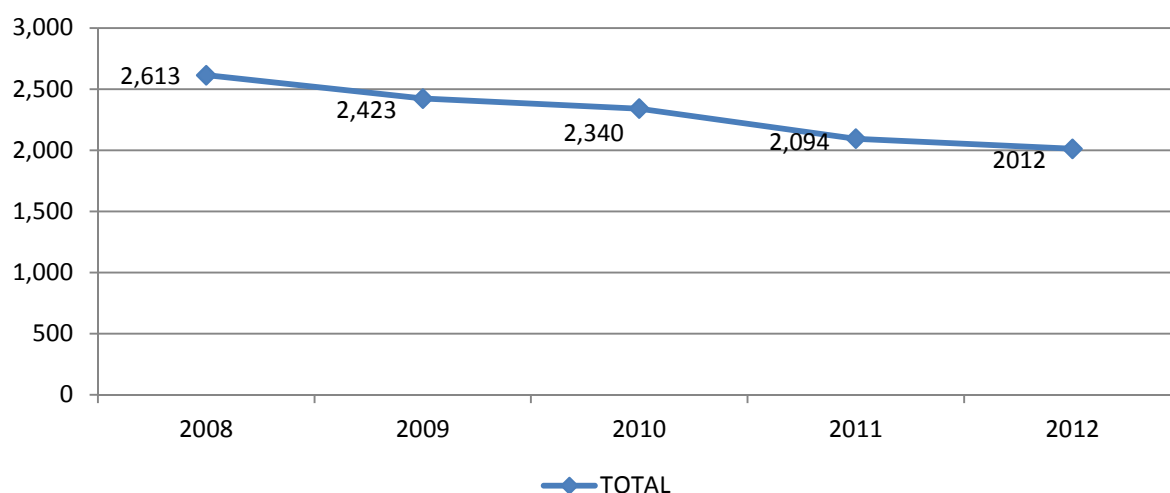

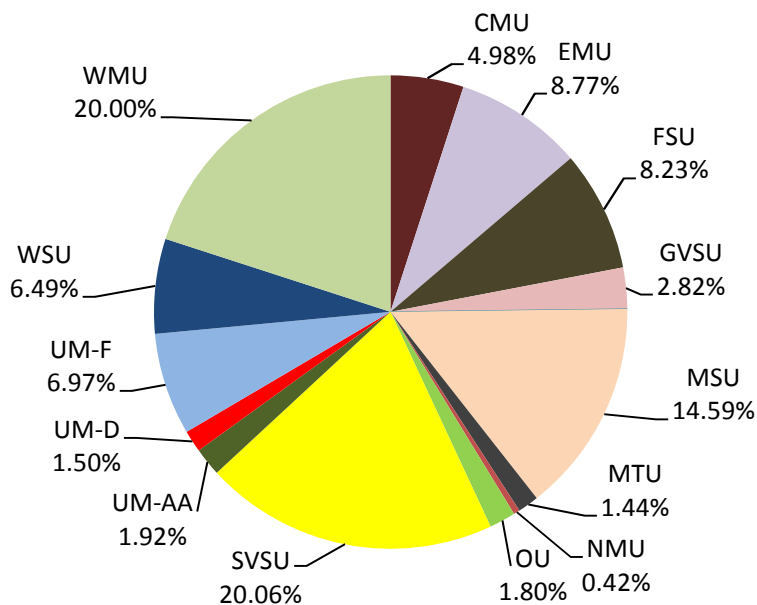

Since 2008, Indian student enrollment in Michigan public universities has declined. India has consistently been the second-most-common country for foreign enrollment in Michigan, but India is slowly losing the edge it had over Saudi Arabia. [Table 4.2.A](#) shows that MTU, UM-AA, and UM-D were the only universities to have a net increase of Indian students over the five-year span. Despite these three net increases, most Michigan public universities were down in 2012 from their peak years of Indian student enrollment. [Chart 4.2.A](#) indicates that UM-AA and MSU account for the highest percentage of Indian student enrollment in the State. [Table 4.2.B](#) demonstrates how the decrease in Indian enrollment in Michigan also reflects a national trend.

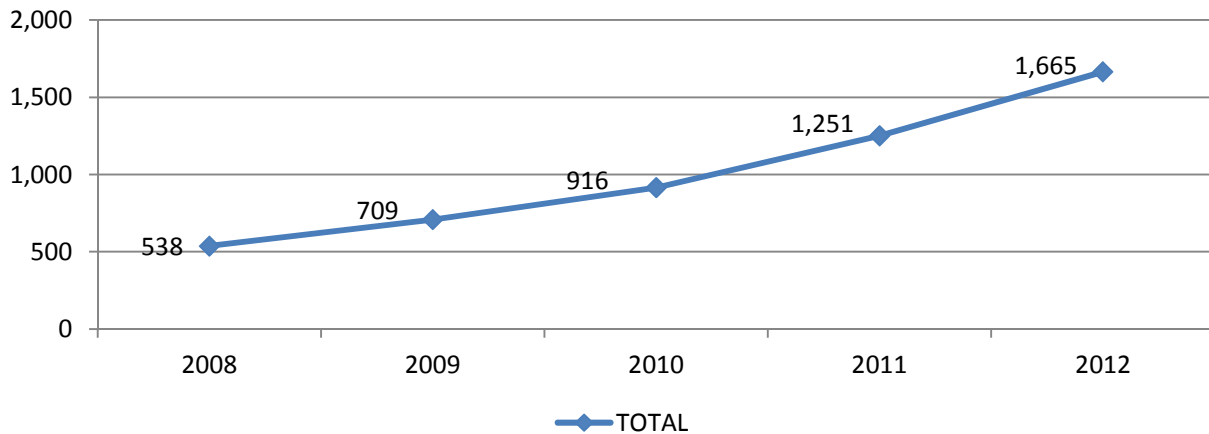

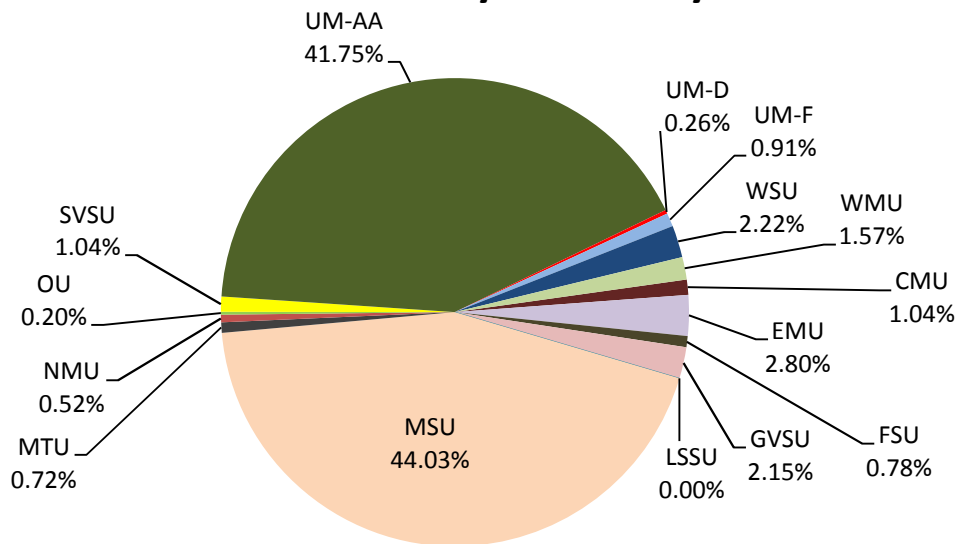

Since 2008, Saudi Arabian students displayed the greatest percentage increase in enrollment in Michigan public universities compared with students from all foreign countries, growing by 209.5% as demonstrated by [Table 4.3.A](#). Except for LSSU, which has no Saudi Arabian students, all Michigan public universities have seen a net increase in Saudi Arabian enrollment since 2008. [Chart 4.3.A](#) shows that the majority of Saudi Arabian students are enrolled in SVSU, WMU, and MSU. Saudi Arabian student enrollment is on the rise, not only in Michigan but also nationwide, according to [Table 4.3.B](#).

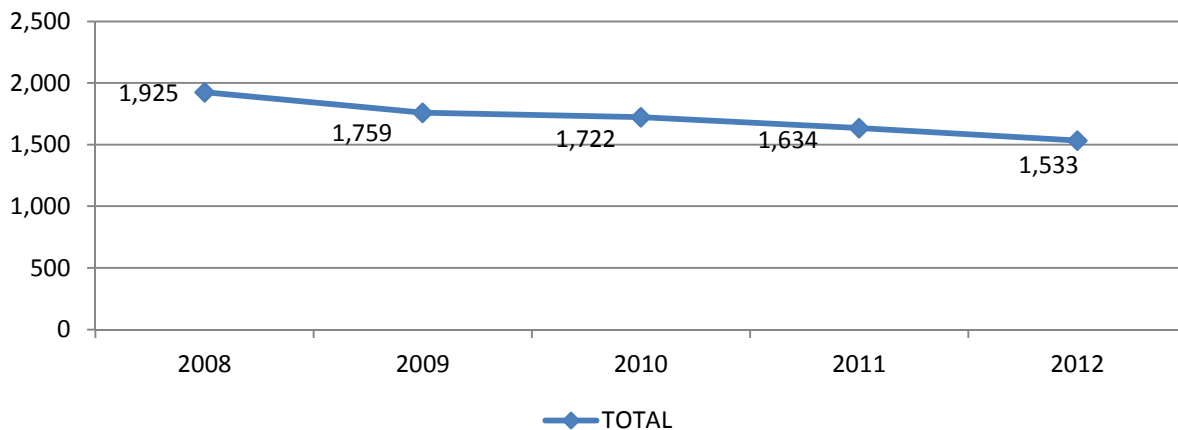

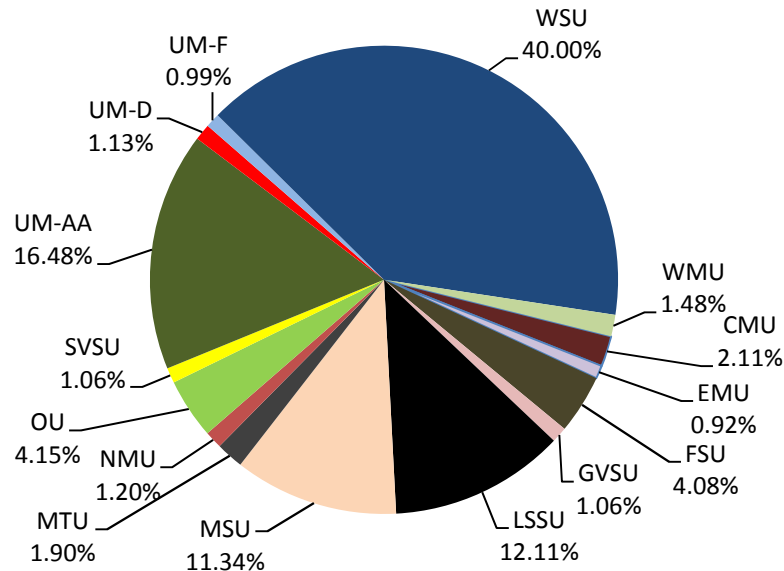

South Korean student enrollment has been on a slight decline since 2008 according to [Table 4.4.A](#). In the past five years, South Korean enrollment in Michigan public universities has decreased by 20.4%. UM-AA and MSU have the highest percentage of South Korean students enrolled, with 85.8% between the two universities, as indicated by [Chart 4.4.A](#). South Korea was surpassed by Saudi Arabia to make it the fourth-most-common country of origin for foreign enrollment in Michigan. Although South Korean student enrollment in Michigan public universities is dropping, the national enrollment rate is on a slight incline, according to [Table 4.4.B](#).

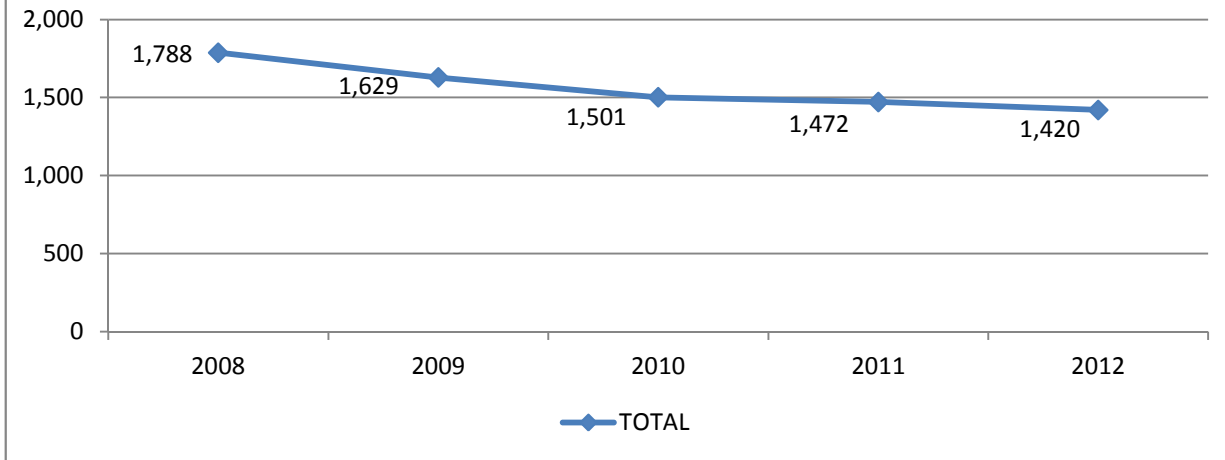

Canadian enrollment in Michigan public universities has been on a steady downfall in the past five years. Canada has historically been one of the top countries of origin for enrollment in Michigan public universities, but as of 2012 it dropped to the fifth spot. Wayne State University boasts the highest percentage of Canadian students at 40%, according to [Chart 4.5.A](#), despite having a 31.4% decrease since 2008.
