

Medicaid Disproportionate Share Hospital

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Executive Summary

- Medicaid disproportionate share hospital (DSH) payments are intended by the Federal government to support hospitals serving low-income patients and those with high Medicaid patient volume.
- There are annual processes that determine the total amount of State DSH payments and the amount each hospital will receive.
- Though annual DSH payments have stayed stable, relative to the total cost of the Medicaid program, the annual amounts have declined in percentage terms.

Introduction

Medicaid, a jointly funded program by both the Federal government and the states, is administered by individual states. Within Medicaid, state programs issue DSH payments to hospitals that serve a higher proportion of low-income patients. These payments are mandated by Federal law and have a dual purpose: covering hospitals' uncompensated care costs (UCCs) (including Medicaid shortfalls and unpaid care for uninsured individuals) and improving access for both Medicaid and uninsured patients. Additionally, these payments contribute to the financial stability of safety-net hospitals, which are generally defined as facilities serving all patients regardless of a patient's ability to pay.


To qualify as a DSH, certain criteria are considered, such as the number of beds, patient days, hospital location, total UCCs, and total payments (including Medicaid and uninsured self-pay). These criteria are used to adjust the payment amount each year.

In Michigan, DSHs exhibit considerable diversity in terms of their size and geographical locations. On average, there were 117 DSHs in Michigan from the State plan rate year (SPRY) 2005 through SPRY 2019.^{i,ii} The cumulative DSH payments from fiscal year (FY) 2004-2005 to FY 2018-2019 amounted to \$6.4 billion, encompassing both Federal and State funds, with an annual average of \$428.0 million.

Figure 1 illustrates the variability in DSH payments, ranging from a low of \$387.2 million in FY 2011-2012 to an estimated high of \$550.7 million in FY 2023-2024.

However, like most other budgetary amounts, the DSH payment amounts listed are in nominal dollars meaning that the effective value, after factoring in inflation, has declined. Additionally, as Michigan's Medicaid program has grown, DSH payments to non-institutes for mental disease (non-IMD) hospitals have declined as a relative share of the overall Medicaid program, from 5.1% in fiscal year (FY) 2004-2005 to 2.4% in FY 2021-2022. On an overall cost of care basis (which includes Medicaid and uninsured costs), DSH payments have declined from 13.8% to 5.9%, as shown in [Table 1](#).

This shift mainly has to do with the implementation of the expansion of Medicaid in Michigan, known as the Healthy Michigan Plan (HMP). The Healthy Michigan Plan was completed through the passage and enactment of PA 107 of 2013 which began enrolling recipients in April 2014. The overall payments to hospitals have risen more than the costs incurred in providing care to both the Medicaid and uninsured populations. As shown in Figure 5, from FY 2004-05 through FY 2018-19, total payments to DSH-eligible hospitals increased by 260%, whereas the costs associated with caring for this population increased by 152% over the same period. Essentially, the HMP has enabled DSH-eligible hospitals to



reduce their dependence on DSH payments, as these hospitals have been able to receive compensation for treating Medicaid-eligible patients.

There are certain limitations associated with the data presented in this paper. The data sourced from the Federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) is accessible only on a hospital-by-hospital basis once the DSH audit is completed. This audit must be submitted to CMS no later than December 31 of the Federal fiscal year ending three years from the Medicaid SPRY year being audited. To illustrate, the most recent available DSH audit data for Michigan pertain to the year concluding on September 30, 2019. Unfortunately, these data do not encompass any hospital-specific information that would reflect the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic. Nonetheless, the Senate Fiscal Agency (SFA) does have access to comprehensive Statewide DSH and Medicaid data, which are included where applicable. Over the next three years, as the DSH audit results become accessible, the SFA will closely monitor the various data elements discussed in this paper. This will enable us to gauge whether the pandemic has accelerated or reversed the trends discussed here.

This paper covers some of the history of DSH payments, then moves into a discussion of how national DSH payment amounts are determined and how Michigan allocates DSH payments. The paper then analyzes various Michigan-specific data surrounding DSH payments and discusses potential changes to the DSH payment program.

Historical Overview of Medicare and Medicaid Hospital Payments

When Medicaid was introduced in 1965, participating states were obligated to cover a hospital's "reasonable costs." To fulfill this obligation, most states used Medicare's payment standards as a benchmark for hospital reimbursement. It is important to note that Medicare is a solely Federal program, whereas Medicaid operates as a cost-sharing arrangement between the Federal government and participating states. The Federal share of these costs is known as the Federal Medical Assistance Percentage (FMAP), and it is adjusted annually based on changes in a state's per capita income relative to the national average.ⁱⁱⁱ

As Medicare's hospital reimbursement rates became more generous, state expenses rose since Medicaid payments were linked to Medicare payment levels. The connection between Medicare and Medicaid hospital payment structures was severed by the Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1981 (OBRA 1981).¹ This legislative change meant that states were no longer obligated to reimburse hospitals based on the Medicare "reasonable cost" basis. Instead, states were free to establish their own reimbursement methodologies.

As part of OBRA 1981, Congress recognized that severing the link to "reasonable cost" could result in reduced payments for hospitals that predominantly serve Medicaid and uninsured patients compared to those with a larger Medicare and privately insured patient population. To rectify this disparity in patient demographics, Congress mandated that Medicaid reimbursement methods incorporate supplementary payments for hospitals catering to a disproportionate share of low-income patients.² These additional payments are made in recognition of the fact that no compensation is provided for

services to uninsured patients and rates paid for services under Medicaid are generally lower than those of Medicare and private insurance.

While DSH payments were mandated by Congress, specific amounts to be allocated to these hospitals were not initially defined. Consequently, in 1980s, the total annual DSH payments remained below \$1.0 billion.³ However, a series of legislative changes in the late 1980s altered the landscape. These changes excluded DSH payments from overall hospital payment restrictions and permitted non-state public and private revenues to contribute to Medicaid funding. As a result, DSH payments rose from \$1.0 billion in combined Federal and state funding in FY 1989-1990 to \$17.4 billion by FY 1991-1992.⁴

This substantial growth in DSH payments prompted Congress to establish an annual limit on each state's DSH allotment. This cap ensures that DSH payments are restricted at the state level, preventing the Federal share of DSH payments from exceeding 12% of total Medicaid spending within each state.⁵ In addition to the national and state-specific caps placed on DSH payments, Congress also instituted hospital-specific DSH limits. These limits are computed based on the real costs incurred for uncompensated care related to hospital services provided to both Medicaid enrollees and uninsured individuals. The process for calculating these UCCs is detailed in [Box 2](#).

The Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (ACA) (PL 111-148) anticipated an expansion of insurance coverage, which, in turn, would lead to a decrease in the number of uninsured individuals and the amount of uncompensated care hospitals provide. As a result, the ACA directed the Secretary of the United States Department of Health and Human Services to commence reductions in DSH payments, starting in FY 2013-2014 and continuing through FY 2019-2020. Subsequently, Congress



introduced several amendments to this requirement and postponed the overall reductions in DSH payments until FY 2023-2024.⁶

National DSH Allotment Methodology

State-specific DSH allotments are calculated annually using a detailed methodology conducted by the CMS. Each state's allotment is determined by selecting the higher of the FY 2003-2004 allotment or the allotment from the previous fiscal year. This amount is then adjusted to account for changes in inflation, as measured by the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U).⁷

It is important to note that DSH allotments are not distributed based on a formula tied to the number of DSH hospitals in a state or the amount of hospital services these facilities offer to low-income patients. Rather, they are established using an index year of payments (FY 2003-2004) as a reference point. Consequently, states that made larger DSH payments during the index year receive proportionally higher payments, while states with fewer DSH payments receive relatively lower DSH payments.

To determine a state's annual DSH allocation, two tests are conducted, and the lesser of the two amounts is applied (see [Box 2](#) for an example):

- The first test, known as the CPI-U test, involves adjusting the amount of DSH allotments for the previous fiscal year by the percentage change in the CPI-U.
- The second test, commonly referred to as the '12% limit', is designed to ensure that no state receives a DSH allotment exceeding 12% of the total Medicaid expenditures, which encompass both Federal and State spending.
 - Under the 12% test, the greater of the prior year's allotment and the amount calculated by the 12% test is compared to the figure derived from the CPI-U test, and the lesser of the two is used.

Alongside the 12% allotment test, there is also a national '12% limit' in place, which is designed to ensure that the national DSH payments do not exceed 12% of national Medicaid expenditures. However, unlike the state-specific limitation, the national 12% limit serves as more of a target amount rather than a rigid cap. Both the 12% test and CPI-U calculations are based on data from the previous fiscal year, which CMS uses to first release a preliminary DSH allotment. Subsequently, the CMS uses actual expenditure data and inflation figures to calculate the final DSH allotments and then makes allotment adjustments based on the actual data.

To illustrate how these DSH allotment tests work in practice, the box below presents a calculation for DSH allotments for a hypothetical state called 'Acme', using fictional amounts as an example.



Box 2: DSH allocation method for the hypothetical state of 'Acme'

DSH Allotment Limit: Lesser of Method #1 or Method #2

There are two primary funding sources for DSH payments: Federal funds and non-Federal (often state) funds. In Michigan, the state funds comprise various components, including General Fund/General Purpose revenue, state-restricted funds (such as provider taxes), local funds contributed by locally owned community hospitals, and private revenues obtained from other governmental entities or certified public expenditures (such as universities).



Starting in FY 2004-2005, Congress introduced a requirement for an annual independent audit of DSH payments.⁸ This mandatory annual independent audit was implemented to enhance accountability and transparency in the allocation and utilization of DSH payments. It is important to note that this annual audit requirement can limit data availability until the audit process is completed, which can extend up to three years after the end of the fiscal year.

Furthermore, an additional audit requirement stipulates that if audit findings reveal that DSH payments exceed the hospital-specific cost limit, this is considered an overpayment to providers, necessitating the state to return the Federal share of the overpayment to the Federal government unless the excess DSH payments are redistributed to other qualifying hospitals.⁹

There is an additional DSH limitation imposed on states by the Federal government, specifically concerning the maximum payments allowed for IMDs and other mental health facilities. To determine this limitation, states consider the lesser of two values:¹⁰

1. The total IMD or other mental health facility DSH expenditures for the FY 1994-1995 in the state.
2. An amount calculated as the product of the current DSH allotment and a specific percentage. This percentage is either 33% or the proportion of IMD DSH payments in FY 1994-1995, whichever is smaller.

Michigan has consistently adhered to the 33% limitation for nearly every fiscal year since FY 2004-2005. This trend is expected to continue through FY 2023-2024. In contrast, IMD hospitals over the period from FY 2004-2005 to FY 2018-2019 have accounted for an average of only 1.2% of the total DSH hospital costs.¹¹

Michigan DSH Allocation Methodology

States possess significant flexibility in designating DSH hospitals and setting payment rates for individual hospitals. Within the boundaries of Federal maximum and minimum guidelines, states are empowered to provide higher payments to certain hospitals. There is not a pre-established formula dictating specific payment amounts for individual hospitals.

The maximum limits on DSH payments for hospitals are determined by ensuring that payments are not "...greater than the cost of providing inpatient and outpatient hospital services to uninsured and Medicaid patients less payments received for those services".¹²

The CMS grants approval for the DSH methodology through the Medicaid State Plan, which represents a contracted agreement between the Federal government and Michigan, detailing the healthcare services, reimbursement procedures, and eligibility policies governing Michigan Medicaid. Within Michigan's Medicaid State Plan, specific criteria are delineated to determine a hospital's eligibility for DSH payments. One specific requirement for a DSH payment is that a hospital maintains a Medicaid inpatient utilization rate (MIUR) of at least 1%, defined as the ratio of 'Total Medicaid Inpatient Hospital Days' to 'Total Patient Hospital Days'.



In addition to meeting the 1% MIUR, to qualify for DSH payments in Michigan hospitals must meet at least one of the following criteria:¹³

- Have at least two obstetricians with staff privileges at the hospital who have agreed to provide obstetric services to individuals who are eligible for Medicaid services.
- Be located in a rural area (as defined by Federal law) and have at least two physicians with staff privileges at the hospital who have agreed to provide obstetric services to individuals who are eligible for Medicaid services.
- Serve an inpatient population predominately compromised of individuals under 18 years of age.
- As of December 22, 1987, have not have offered nonemergency obstetric services to the general population (also includes distinct part psychiatric units of a hospital).

After meeting the 1% Medicaid utilization threshold and the other factors, the Michigan Medicaid State Plan includes two steps to determine the DSH allotment.

Step 1: Initial DSH Calculation Step

The initial DSH calculation step, as specified in the Michigan Medicaid State Plan, establishes hospital-specific DSH limits, DSH payment allocations, and MIURs. These calculations rely on data from the hospital's cost reporting period, which could include data that is up to two fiscal years old before the calculation is completed. Subsequently, these figures are adjusted based on a CMS prospective reimbursement factor, as detailed in the state plan. It is important to note that DSH payments are typically disbursed annually in a single distribution, usually during the first quarter of the state fiscal year.

The DHHS then allocates the DSH payments to various categories of hospital providers (also referred to as a DSH pool) up to a given hospital's DSH limit in the following sequence:

1. Institute for Mental Disease Pool (State Psychiatric DSH).
2. \$45 million Pool (Regular DSH).
3. Outpatient Uncompensated Care DSH Pool (Outpatient DSH).
4. University with both a College of Allopathic Medicine and a College of Osteopathic Medicine Pool (University DSH).
5. Government Provider DSH Pool (Governmental DSH Certified Public Expenditures (CPE)).

Like the calculation performed at the national level to determine state-level allocations, state-level allocation data are preliminary and require updates during the calculation process to confirm their accuracy. Step 1 is considered complete when the estimated DSH pool has been allocated.

Step 2: Final DSH Settlement Step

The final DSH settlement step involves a recalculation of DSH limits, DSH payment allocations, and MIURs. This process occurs after the completion of the DSH audit for the relevant DSH year and includes adjustments to cost data to accommodate changes that may have occurred between Step 1 and Step 2. As part of this audit process, the final DSH limits and MIURs are determined. The redistribution of DSH funds follows this sequence to the various pools:


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3. Outpatient Uncompensated Care DSH Pool (Outpatient DSH).
4. University with both a College of Allopathic Medicaid and a College of Osteopathic Medicine Pool (University DSH).
5. Government Provider DSH Pool (Governmental DSH CPE).
6. Unspent funds not applicable to Step 1 (Post-audit DSH).

The remaining redistribution of DSH funds is based on calculations from the first five pools. Any unspent Federal DSH allotment is then allocated through a new pool in Step 6. This allocation is distributed among all remaining eligible hospitals in proportion to their share of the remaining audited hospital-specific DSH limit capacity. This share is adjusted to account for any DSH payment amounts hospitals have received from the University DSH and Governmental DSH CPE pools. It is important to note that in both Step 1 and Step 2, no hospital will receive an allocation exceeding their hospital-specific DSH limit.

Figure 2 illustrates the 10-year allocation of DSH payments in Michigan across various types. As the DSH audits have not yet been completed for any state plan rate year after FY 2018-2019, the amounts and allocations are considered preliminary estimates from the Michigan State Budget Office.



Analysis of DSH Payments in Michigan

The Federal Medicaid and CHIP Payment and Access Commission (MACPAC) has been conducting annual analyses of national DSH payments and presenting its findings in reports to Congress since 2016. Congress has tasked MACPAC with examining the allocation of DSH payments and assessing the



relationship between DSH allotments and three key factors: the number of uninsured individuals, the magnitude and sources of UCC incurred by hospitals, and the presence of hospitals that bear a significant burden of uncompensated care while also providing essential community services to low-income, uninsured, and vulnerable populations.¹⁴ The Commission's continued findings indicate that there is little significant correlation between DSH allotments and these three factors. In Michigan, it is worth noting that the uninsured rate is not tracked on a hospital-specific basis, making it challenging to assess this relationship for individual hospitals.

Since the implementation of the HMP, the uninsured rate in Michigan has seen a decline, as illustrated in Table 2. In calendar year 2005, the estimated non-elderly uninsured rate in Michigan stood at 11.4%, equivalent to 1.1 million individuals. By 2021, this rate had decreased to 5.8%, representing approximately 561,600 people. The introduction of the HMP has led to a notable reduction of nearly 51% in the uninsured population. Consequently, with more adults becoming eligible for health insurance, both Medicaid payments and the overall Medicaid cost of care have increased in DSH hospitals.

The third variable in MACPAC's analysis pertains to hospitals with high levels of uncompensated care while also serving as access points for essential community services is not explicitly outlined in Federal statute. Additionally, the concept of essential community services lacks a defined framework within Medicaid statutes or regulations. Therefore, this specific relationship for Michigan-based hospitals was not considered in this analysis.¹⁵

The second variable, which pertains to the amount and sources of UCC incurred by hospitals, can be analyzed on a Michigan-specific basis. When calculating DSH hospital UCC, two categories are considered: Medicaid uncompensated care/shortfall and the unpaid costs of care for uninsured individuals^{iv}.


To explore this relationship, this section provides an overview of UCCs in Michigan, the broader hospital cost landscape, and then delves into the correlation between DSH allocations to hospitals and UCCs. It also explores whether there are other variables that exhibit a relationship that could affect decisions regarding DSH allocations.

In an American Hospital Association survey in 2020, there was a determination that 88% of Medicaid costs were paid nationally.¹⁶ The Commission analyzed the SPRY 2017-2018 (FY 2017-2018) data for DSH hospitals and determined that 86% of Medicaid costs were covered by Medicaid payments.¹⁷ For Michigan, in the five years after the implementation of the HMP, Medicaid payments were 87% of the Medicaid cost of care.


Between FY 2004-2005 and FY 2018-2019, there was a total of \$10.3 billion reported in Medicaid shortfall/UCCs submitted to CMS. Before the implementation of the HMP, there was \$4.4 billion in Medicaid UCCs incurred during the nine years leading up to the expansion (FY 2004-2005 through FY 2012-2013). In the six years following the expansion (FY 2013-2014 through FY 2018-2019), Medicaid UCCs amounted to \$5.9 billion.

During the same period, from FY 2004-2005 to FY 2018-2019, there were \$6.5 billion in uninsured UCCs reported to CMS. Prior to the implementation of the HMP, the nine years preceding the expansion saw \$4.7 billion in Medicaid UCC, while the six years after the expansion saw these costs reduced to \$1.8 billion.



The data seem to indicate that through HMP, costs that had previously been uncompensated were now covered under Medicaid. After the implementation of the HMP, there was a two-year period in which Medicaid costs increased faster than Medicaid payments rose, but this was offset by the continuing decrease in the uninsured uncompensated costs. In absolute terms, the total average annual UCCs rose from \$1.0 billion to \$1.3 billion.





In relative terms, there was a decrease in the average percentage of UCC, which declined from an average of 23% of the total cost of care in the nine years before the expansion to an average of 16% in the six years following the implementation of HMP. This relative decline in UCC can be attributed to the overall growth in compensated care outpacing the increase in UCCs.

For context, in FY 2004-2005, total Medicaid payments accounted for 65% of the total cost of care for DSH hospitals. However, by FY 2018-2019, this figure had risen to 93%. It is important to recognize that measuring the cost of care against payments may provide an incomplete picture, as cost-based payments may not always incentivize efficiency. Additionally, variations in accounting methodologies for provider contributions, such as provider taxes or local government contributions as a non-Federal portion of Medicaid payments, can lead to an overestimation of the extent to which Medicaid and DSH payments truly offset hospital costs.

As depicted in [Figure 5](#), between FY 2004-2005 to FY 2018-2019, the total costs of care increased by 152%, whereas total payments surged by 260%. Within this timeframe, hospital costs experienced a 50% growth, coinciding with a 50% decrease in the uninsured rate among individuals aged 18-65. The notable variance in the growth rates of Medicaid payments and the actual costs of care is the primary factor driving the decline in uncompensated care as a percentage of total healthcare costs.



In addition to considering the cost of care within hospitals, it is valuable to assess DSH payments in relation to the overall operational expenses of DSH hospitals. Throughout the data period, the average uncompensated care cost as a percentage of total hospital costs stood at 2.0%, reaching its highest point at 2.5% in FY 2004-2005 and reaching a low of 1.7% in FY 2015-2016 and FY 2016-2017 as shown in [Table 4](#). As DSH payments have stayed relatively flat, but hospital costs have increased, hospital costs offset by DSH payments have declined.

Since Congress has tasked MACPAC with analyzing the factors influencing the allocation of DSH payments by states, another approach to assess DSH payment amounts is by examining the correlation coefficients between total DSH payments and various variables.^v The variables employed for the analysis of DSH payment allocation in Michigan encompass total eligible UCCs (encompassing both Medicaid and uninsured uncompensated care), the average MIUR, and total hospital costs. [Table 5](#) displays the correlation coefficients, with results presented for DSH hospitals excluding IMDs and all DSH hospitals.

The relationship between DSH payments and total UCCs is the only relationship that is strengthened when IMDs are included. This enhancement is primarily because IMDs have significantly lower UCCs compared to non-IMD hospitals (comprising only 12% of overall UCC). Consequently, the inclusion of IMDs does not substantially alter the calculation, and the correlation coefficient maintains a moderate relationship in each scenario.

However, when IMDs are excluded, the correlation between overall hospital costs and DSH payments exhibits a strong relationship. Conversely, when IMDs are included, this relationship weakens. Compared to non-IMD hospitals, IMD hospitals in Michigan have lower costs for those included as DSHs. The average annual cost of a non-IMD hospital during the data period was \$143.7 million, while the average cost of an IMD hospital was \$44.6 million. However, the average DSH payment to a non-IMD hospital was \$2.5 million, whereas the average DSH payment to an IMD hospital was \$20.6 million.

Another observation is that the correlation between the MIUR and DSH payments is relatively weak. Without IMDs included, the coefficient is 0.20, indicating that over the 15-year data period, there has not been a strong connection between a hospital's MIUR and the DSH payments it receives. Furthermore, when IMDs are included, the relationship between the variables further weakens to a coefficient of 0.15. This is influenced by the fact that IMDs in Michigan receive DSH payments allocation that somewhat deviates from their underlying cost of care and patient base, even though the MIUR is higher in IMD facilities (averaging 40%) compared to non-IMD facilities (averaging 26%).

Analyzing the relationship between DSH payments and individual hospital circumstances provides insights into the state's allocation decisions. However, it is important to note that on a national scale, DSH payments have remained relatively stable since the 1990s. As a percentage of overall Medicaid expenditures, they have declined from a peak of 15.2% in FY 1991-1992 to approximately 4.0% by FY 2015-2016.¹⁸ In Michigan, from FY 2004-2005 to FY 2023-2024, there has been a significant decrease in DSH payments as a percentage of total net Medicaid expenditures, dropping from 5.1% to 1.5%. Moreover, over the same period, DSH payments as a percentage of total Medicaid payments to DSH hospitals in Michigan have declined from 22.7% to 6.5%.

Similar to MACPAC's analysis, one takeaway from this analysis is an absence of a strong relationship between some common factors used to allocate DSH payments to hospitals serving a high proportion of Medicaid beneficiaries and other low-income patients. Notably,



some of these variables were incorporated by Congress as factors in determining long-delayed DSH payment reductions.

DSH Allotment Reductions

Disproportionate share hospital payment reductions have been scheduled multiple times since the passage of the ACA, driven by the expectation that increased Medicaid enrollment would reduce UCCs. As of February 2021, these potential DSH payment reductions have been postponed or modified in statute on 13 occasions.¹⁹

On November 18, 2023, nationwide DSH reductions of \$8.0 billion in Federal funds per year for four fiscal years are set to take effect.²⁰ While the allotment reduction will not necessarily eliminate the state-funded portion of DSH payments, many state-funded portions rely on a provider tax funding method that becomes significantly less valuable without the Federal share.

States are categorized into two groups for reductions: low DSH states and non-low DSH states.^{vi} Low DSH states will get a lower reduction than non-low DSH states. Low DSH states will experience smaller reductions, receiving about 1.25% of the total reduction. The non-low DSH state cuts are approximately \$7.9 billion in Federal reductions. Three key factors determine these reductions: states with lower uninsured rates face larger reductions (50% of the reduction calculation), states not targeting DSH payments to hospitals with high MIUR will have larger reductions (25% of the calculation), and states not targeting DSH payments to hospitals with high levels of uncompensated care will also experience larger reductions (25% of the calculation).²¹

According to an analysis by MACPAC, Michigan could see the largest percentage loss in DSH payment allocations among all states, with an 87.7% reduction, resulting in a decrease of the total State and Federal allotment from \$553.7 million to \$68.0 million. As mentioned earlier, Michigan's uninsured rate has notably decreased, and the current DSH allocation methodology does not seem to prioritize hospitals with higher MIUR or greater levels of uncompensated care.²²

It is worth noting that DSH allotment reductions have been postponed several times since the ACA's enactment, so it remains uncertain whether these reductions will take effect in FY 2023-2024 or at all. However, considering the current criteria for allocating DSH reductions, it is possible that Michigan's DSH methodology may undergo changes to mitigate potential future reductions.

Conclusion

The landscape of DSH payments in Michigan reflects a complex interplay of federal regulations, state-specific policies, and the evolving healthcare landscape. The data presented in this analysis reveals several important trends and challenges. One notable trend is the impact of the HMP, which has substantially reduced the uninsured rate in the state and increased Medicaid payments to hospitals. This has led to a shift in the reliance of DSH-eligible hospitals on DSH payments, as they now receive compensation for treating Medicaid-eligible patients.

The after-effects of the COVID-19 pandemic on hospital costs and potential DSH allotment reductions will be monitored in the coming years as potential risks to Michigan's state budget.
