This transfer requests \$4.0 million Federal TANF authorization for the Michigan Tuition Grant and \$4.5 million Federal TANF authorization for the Tuition Incentive Program to support higher than anticipated demand for student financial aid. These funds are available from the State Competitive Scholarship as a result of lower-than-anticipated costs to fund the program. The transfer is necessary to make the third quarter payments to institutions that have accepted financial aid awards for their students under these programs.
